### 12th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

For the third time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game will be held in San Antonio. The 2007 game takes place on Saturday, December 1, at the Alamodome. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged in the Alamodome were in 1997 (64,824) and 1999 (65,035).

### Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 11-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2007), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).



**BAYLOR (3-6, 0-5)**

**This Week:** Texas Tech  
**Next Week:** at Oklahoma

Baylor has forced at least one turnover in 28 of the last 32 games, including 19 games with at least two turnovers.

WR Thomas White recorded his first career 100-yard receiving game Saturday against Kansas State. It was Baylor's second 100-yard receiving game this season (Brandon Whitaker, 166 vs. Colorado) and the first by a non-back since last season's Texas A&M game (Dominique Zeigler, 180.)

QB Blake Szymanski moved into second place on Baylor's single-season touchdown passes list. He now has 17 on the season, two shy of Shawn Bell's school record from last season.

Szymanski became the fifth player in school history to pass for at least 2,000 yards in a season. Szymanski has 2,147 yards passing in 2007, fifth all-time at Baylor.



**COLORADO (5-4, 3-2)**

**This Week:** Missouri  
**Next Week:** at Iowa State

Cody Hawkins tied a school record by throwing a touchdown pass in his ninth consecutive game. The last CU quarterback to do that was Koy Detmer in 1996. Hawkins has thrown for 2,090 yards, the 12th 2,000-yard passing season in CU history but the first from a freshman.

Jordon Dizon is third in the nation and first in the Big 12 in tackles with 12.2 a game. He has 76 solo stops and 34 assisted tackles.

Colorado has scored in 231 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak in the NCAA and the 11th-longest all-time.

In addition to grabbing three interceptions at Texas Tech, Terrence Wheatley had 82 return yards to give him 1,242 in his career to rank second at CU behind Ben Kelly. His 14 career picks tie for third.



**IOWA STATE (1-8, 0-5)**

**This Week:** Kansas State  
**Next Week:** Colorado

With six receptions at Missouri, Todd Blythe became the ISU all-time record holder for career catches with 168, passing Lane Danielsen (163). Blythe now has 2,861 career receiving yards, moving him ahead of Texas Tech's Jarrett Hicks for sixth place in Big 12 history.

Devin McDowell's 25-yard interception return for a touchdown vs. Missouri was Iowa State's first interception return for a TD since Brent Curvey vs. Colorado on Nov. 12, 2005.

Bret Meyer joined former Texas Tech QB Kliff Kingsbury (12,249 – 1999-02) as the second Big 12 QB to eclipse the 9,000-yard mark in career passing yards. Meyer now has 9,149 career passing yards.

Meyer is tied with Missouri's Chase Daniel for 10th place in Big 12 career touchdown passes at 47.



**KANSAS (8-0, 4-0)**

**This Week:** Nebraska  
**Next Week:** at Oklahoma State

KU has an 8-0 record for the first time since 1909.

The Jayhawk defense held its fourth straight opponent (all Big 12 foes) under 100 yards rushing. Opponents are averaging 60.25 yards on the ground in that span.

Brandon McAnderson rushed for a career-high 183 yards at Texas A&M to give him his third 100-yard rushing game of the season.

Todd Reesing moved up the KU single season passing yards chart to ninth place with 1,985 yards.

Kansas is second in the country in scoring defense (10.2) and fifth in total defense (263.9). On the offensive side of the ball, the Jayhawks are fifth in scoring offense (42.5).



**KANSAS STATE (5-3, 3-2)**

**This Week:** at Iowa State  
**Next Week:** at Nebraska

K-State is 60-33 all-time in Big 12 play, the fourth team in league history to surpass the 60-win plateau (Texas, Oklahoma and Nebraska).

Jordy Nelson moved into fourth in school history with 2,224 career receiving yards and is currently second in the nation in receptions (9.5).

Nelson's 92-yard punt return for touchdown Saturday vs. Baylor was the sixth-longest in school history and his second punt return for a TD this season. His first came on an 89-yarder at Texas.

K-State has 58 non-offensive touchdowns since 1990, to rank third in the nation.

KSU's defense has 13 interceptions in the last five games. Entering this five-game stretch, K-State had just two interceptions, both at Auburn in the season-opener.



**MISSOURI (7-1, 3-1)**

**This Week:** at Colorado  
**Next Week:** Texas A&M

Mizzou ranks 7th nationally in total offense (498.6 ypg), and is also 5th in passing offense (326.1 ypg) and 8th in scoring offense (40.4 ppg).

Jeremy Maclin is ninth in the country in all-purpose yards with an average of 186.9 per game. He has 10 touchdowns this season, four rushing, four receiving and two on returns.

Chase Daniel is second in the Big 12 and fifth nationally, averaging 342.8 yards of total offense.

The Mizzou defense has forced a turnover in 14 consecutive games.

Tight end Martin Rucker's 14 career touchdowns ties for all-time touchdowns in a career with Mel Gray, who played from 1968-70.



**NEBRASKA (4-5, 1-4)**

**This Week:** at Kansas  
**Next Week:** Kansas State

Nate Swift's 12 career touchdown catches place him in a tie for sixth on the NU career list. His 96 career receptions moved him past Matt Davison (93 catches) into third place on the Husker career receiving chart.

Marlon Lucky rushed 24 times for 111 yards vs. Texas, his fourth 100-yard game of the season and the seventh of his Husker career.

Lucky pushed his season receptions total to 54, trailing only Johnny Rodgers' school-record reception total of 55 catches in 1972.

Punter Dan Titchener averaged 42.6 yards on eight punts at Texas and had four punts downed inside the 20-yard line.



**OKLAHOMA (7-1, 3-1)**

**This Week:** Texas A&M  
**Next Week:** Baylor

Redshirt freshman QB Sam Bradford is second in the country in passing efficiency at 170.9 while leading OU to second nationally in scoring offense at 44.5.

The Sooner defense leads the Big 12 with 26 sacks for 194 yards. The OU 'D' is also leading the league in rushing defense and is third nationally, allowing only 68.9 yards per game.

Oklahoma's opponents are converting 29.6% (37-125) of their third downs, second in the league and 13th in NCAA stats.

Running back Chris Brown has scored all five of his touchdowns on the season in the last two games.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (5-3, 3-1)**

**This Week:** Texas  
**Next Week:** Kansas

OSU's 329 rushing yards vs. Kansas State marked the second-straight game and the third this season the Cowboys have rushed for 300-plus yards.

Perrish Cox's 98-yard kickoff return against Kansas State was the longest of his career and tied for the fourth-longest kickoff return in OSU history.

Dantrell Savage leads the Big 12 and is 10th nationally in rushing with 124.3 ypg. He is one of only two conference players (Jamaal Charles, UT) to average over 100 yards a game on the ground.

Zac Robinson's 109 rushing yards against Kansas State marked his second 100-yard rushing effort this season (116 vs. Texas Tech). The last OSU quarterback to rush for 100-or-more yards twice in the same season was Tony Lindsay in 1996.



**TEXAS (7-2, 3-2)**

**This Week:** at Oklahoma State  
**Next Week:** Texas Tech

Jamaal Charles' 216 rushing yards in a quarter (fourth) Saturday against Nebraska was six yards shy of the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision record of 222 set by Corey Dillon of Washington against San Jose State in 1996. His 237 rushing yards in a half (second) was four shy of the Texas school record of 241 by Hodges Mitchell against Kansas in 2000.

Charles 290 rushing yards vs. Nebraska ties for fourth-best in school history, trailing two efforts by Ricky Williams (350 vs. Iowa State, 1998; 318 vs. Rice 1998) and Roosevelt Leaks (342 vs. SMU 1973).

Quan Cosby moved to within 24 kickoff return yards of becoming the second player in school history to log over 1,000 receiving yards and 1,000 kickoff return yards in a career. With 1,267 receiving yards and 976 kickoff return yards, he would join Mike Adams with 3,032 receiving yards and 1,591 kickoff return yards.



**TEXAS A&M (6-3, 3-2)**

**This Week:** at Oklahoma  
**Next Week:** at Missouri

Tight end Martellus Bennett's 26-game reception streak matches the school record set by A&M's all-time leading receiver Terrence Murphy from 2003-05.

Bennett finished the Kansas game with 8 catches for 91 yards, a career high for receptions and his second most receiving yards of the year (98 vs. Louisiana-Monroe).

Stephen McGee completed 24-of-44 passes for 244 yards Saturday against Kansas, setting season highs for completions, attempts and yards. He was one completion and attempt shy of matching his career bests (25-of-45 last year at Kansas).

Jorvorskis Lane is second in the Big 12 and sixth nationally in scoring with 10.9 points a game.



**TEXAS TECH (6-3, 2-3)**

**This Week:** at Baylor  
**Next Week:** at Texas

Redshirt freshman Michael Crabtree leads the country in receptions (11.1) and receiving yards (161.2), and is second in scoring (12.0 ppg).

With 18 touchdown catches, Crabtree set the Big 12 single season mark. Crabtree already held the NCAA freshman record for TD catches and during the Colorado game, set the NCAA rookie mark for receptions with 100 on the season.

Graham Harrell is the NCAA leader in total offense with 434.3 yards a game. He also leads the Big 12 in passing yards with 442.1.

Alex Trlica added to his NCAA record with 217 consecutive point-after-attempts. He has never missed a PAT during his Tech career.
