12th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

For the third time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game will be held in San Antonio. The 2007 game takes place on Saturday, December 1, at the Alamodome. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged in the Alamodome were in 1997 (64,824) and 1999 (65,035).

BAYLOR (3-3, 0-2)

This Week: at Kansas
Next Week: Texas

Running back Brandon Whitaker had 11 catches for a conference-leading 166 yards last Saturday in the loss to Colorado.

Whitaker broke Jeffrey Murray's school record for career receptions (86) by a non-receiver. His 166 yards receiving vs. Colorado were the most by a non-receiver in school history and 8th overall.

Blake Szymanski had his third 400-yard passing game of the season with 410 vs. Colorado. He had previously register 412 against Rice and 411 vs. Texas State.

Baylor's defense has forced at least one turnover in 26 of the last 29 games.



COLORADO (4-2, 2-0)

This Week: at Kansas State
Next Week: Kansas

Kevin Eberhart is the second kicker in school history to make four field goals from 40 yards or longer in a game after kicks of 54, 41, 44 and 42 yards at Baylor, in addition to a 30-yarder.

In Saturday's win at Baylor, the Buffaloes had a 100-yard rusher and receiver in the same game for the first time since accomplishing the feat three times in 2004. Hugh Charles had 20 rushes for 122 yards while Josh Smith caught two passes for 103 yards.

With 14 tackles against Baylor, Jordon Dizon reclaimed the top spot nationally with an average of 13.0 a game. Dizon has been in of 78 tackles this season, including 51 solo stops.

Colorado has scored in 228 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak.



IOWA STATE (1-5, 0-2)

This Week: Texas
Next Week: Oklahoma

Todd Blythe became ISU's all-time leading receiver during the Texas Tech game and now has 2,736 career yards. He is second on ISU's career receptions list with 156 and needs eight catches to pass Lane Danielsen (2000-03, 163) for the No. 1 spot.

Iowa State is the least penalized team in the Big 12, being flagged for a conference-low 19 infractions for an average of 27 yards per game.

Bret Meyer's first completion vs. TTU (a 9-yard toss to Todd Blythe) was the 700th of his career. Meyer ended the game with 15 completions, improving his career mark to 714, ranking third all-time in the Big 12

The Cyclone defense has forced six turnovers in the last two games.



KANSAS (5-0, 1-0)

This Week: Baylor
Next Week: at Colorado

Todd Reesing has established a Kansas sophomore record for touchdown passes thrown with 14, breaking Adam Barmann's mark of 12 set in 2004. Reesing's 14 TD passes tie for fourth-most in a single season at KU.

Reesing has thrown for 200 yards or more in five consecutive games, second most in KU history (Mike Norseth, 1984-85, with six). His five 200-yard games tie for fifth on the KU single season list.

Junior Aqib Talib has scored a touchdown in six straight games dating back to last season - one interception and five receiving. Talib has seven receptions so far this season, with four going for touchdowns.

Kansas is third in the country in both scoring (9.4) and total defense (247.6).



KANSAS STATE (3-2, 1-1)

This Week: Colorado
Next Week: at Oklahoma State

K-State has outscored its opponents 48-7 in the opening frame this season.

Josh Freeman threw for a career-best 305 yards against Kansas, surpassing his previous best of 287 against Missouri State on Sept. 15. He improved his streak of games with 20 or more completions to five, the only quarterback in school history to achieve the feat.

Jordy Nelson is the first player since Aaron Lockett in 1998 to register three straight games of 100+ yards receiving.

Ian Campbell registered five tackles, including three for a loss of 13 yards and a sack, plus one pass defensed during last Saturday's contest. Campbell now has 14 career sacks and is tied for ninth in school history with John Butler (1990-93).



MISSOURI (5-0, 1-0)

This Week: at Oklahoma
Next Week: Texas Tech

Mizzou ranks 4th nationally in total offense (556.60 ypg), and is also 5th in passing offense (357.60 ypg) and 11th in scoring offense (41.80 ppg).

The Tigers continue to lead the nation in third down conversions, improving their percentage to 59 percent after last week's game.

Jeremy Maclin leads the country in all-purpose yards with an average of 214.0 per game.

Chase Daniel had a career-high 473 yards offense in Saturday's win over Nebraska with 401 yards and two touchdowns passing along with 72 yards and two touchdowns rushing. The 473 all-purpose yards rank second all-time in Missouri history, behind only former Mizzou quarterback Brad Smith, who accumulated 480 all-purpose yards against Nebraska in 2005.



NEBRASKA (4-2, 1-1)

This Week: Oklahoma State
Next Week: Texas A&M

Bo Ruud made 10 tackles vs. Missouri to top the 200-tackle mark in his career. Ruud's total of 203 surpasses his dad, Tom, in career tackles by one.

Lance Brandenburg also had 10 tackles, which was a career-high, bettering his seven tackles last season against Texas.

Sam Keller's 223 yards against Missouri moved his season total to 1,720, good for seventh place on the Husker season passing chart. Keller is more than halfway to the Nebraska season passing record of 3,197 yards set by Zac Taylor last season.

Marlon Lucky moved into the top 10 on the Nebraska career receptions list with 69 to rank ninth.



OKLAHOMA (5-1, 1-1)

This Week: Missouri
Next Week: at Iowa State

Redshirt freshman QB Sam Bradford continues to lead the country in passing efficiency at 187.0.

Malcolm Kelly's touchdown reception against Texas last Saturday was the 20th of his career. The junior is 11 shy of Mark Clayton's OU record.

The Sooner defense leads the Big 12 with 22 sacks for 164 yards. The OU 'D' is also holding opponents to a conference-low 25.5 percent third down conversion rate.

Tight end Jermaine Gresham has five touchdowns this season on 16 receptions after recording one during his freshman campaign.



OKLAHOMA STATE (3-3, 1-1)

This Week: at Nebraska
Next Week: Kansas State

Adarius Bowman has 18 touchdown receptions in 19 games as a Cowboy. He has reached the 100-yard receiving mark three times this season and five in his OSU career.

OSU compiled 259 yards passing and 200 yards rushing at Texas A&M. It was the fourth time in the last five games that the Cowboys have reached the 200-200 mark.

With 11 points against Texas A&M, kicker Jason Ricks moved up to 10th place on the OSU career scoring list with 195 points.

Senior running back Dantrell Savage completed his first-career pass on a 29-yard scoring strike to Adarius Bowman in Saturday's game. He became the fourth different player to throw a TD pass this season.



TEXAS (4-2, 0-2)

This Week: at Iowa State
Next Week: at Baylor

Jermichael Finley is the first tight end in school history to log two or more receptions of 50-plus yards in a game, season and career.

Colt McCoy became the seventh player in school history to reach the 4,000-yard plateau in career passing yards and now has 4,148.

Limas Sweed has caught at least one pass in 24 consecutive games and 40 of 43 career games.

Quan Cosby is in fourth place on UT's list for career kickoff return yardage with 864 yards.

Jamaal Charles has rushed for 70 or more yards in all six games in 2007.



TEXAS A&M (5-1, 2-0)

This Week: at Texas Tech
Next Week: at Nebraska

A&M's 17-point second-half comeback in Saturday's win over Oklahoma State matched the largest in school history. The Aggies also rallied from a 17-0 deficit (17-0 after the first quarter) to beat Baylor, 31-30, at Kyle Field in 1986.

Running back Jorvorskie Lane is 3-of-4 for 128 yards (42.6 average) and a touchdown passing the ball. After the first TD catch of his career in the OSU game, Lane now has TDs as a rusher (36), passer (1) and receiver (1).

Martellus Bennett has at least one catch in 24 straight games, which is two away from the school record of 26 consecutive games by Terrence Murphy from 2002-04.

Mark Dodge has averaged 9.7 tackles in his last nine starts.



TEXAS TECH (5-1, 1-1)

This Week: Texas A&M
Next Week: at Missouri

Redshirt freshman Michael Crabtree leads the country in receptions (11.7), receiving yards (179.0), and scoring (17.0 ppg).

Crabtree became the NCAA's all-time leading touchdown receptions leader for a freshman and now has 17 to tie for the Big 12 lead in single-season touchdown catches with Rashaun Woods (Oklahoma State) who had 17 in 2002.

Graham Harrell is the NCAA leader in total offense with 450.2 yards a game. He also leads the Big 12 in passing yards with 454.3.

Alex Trlica added to his NCAA record with 209 consecutive point-after-attempts. He has never missed a PAT during his Tech career.

The Tech defense has held opponents to an average of 202.5 yards over the last two games.
