- ▼ The win over Nebraska was Mizzou's first this year over a ranked team, but the Tigers also own a win against upstart Illinois (5-1), which is now ranked 18th in the A.P. poll.
- ▼ Mizzou has now started 5-0 in consecutive seasons for the 1st time in school history (started 6-0 in 2006).
- ▼ Junior Chase Daniel (Southlake, Texas) had a career night, as he recorded a career-best 473 yards of total offense and four total touchdowns (two passing/two rushing) in leading 17th-ranked Mizzou to a dominating 41-6 win over 25th-ranked Nebraska, in Columbia, Mo. Saturday night. Daniel threw for a career-best 401 yards on 33-of-47 passing, and he tossed a pair of TDs, while running for a game-high 72 yards (11 carries), and running for two more scores on the night
- ▼ Up next for the Tigers is a date at sixth-ranked Oklahoma next Saturday, scheduled for a 5:30 p.m. (CT) kick on Fox Sports net. The meeting will have the most national-ranking implications (both clubs ranked 11th or higher) for the Tiger football program since No. 5 Mizzou met No. 4 Texas on Sept. 28, 1979 in Columbia (Texas won, 21-0).

- ▼ The Tigers got off to their best conference start in program history over the weekend, as they defeated Texas Tech, 2-0, Friday (Oct. 5) in Lubbock to start the Big 12 season 3-0.
- ▼ Sophomore Michelle Collins (Naperville, Ill.) and freshman Alysha Bonnick (North Gower, Ontario) each scored their eighth goals of the season in the win.
- ▼ Mizzou junior goalkeeper Mallory Forst (Ballwin, Mo.) saved 10 shots in her second shutout win of the season and sixth of her career.
- ▼ The Tigers will try to break their all-time home winning streak of five games when they host Oklahoma and No. 22 Oklahoma State Friday (Oct. 12) and Sunday (Oct. 14), respectively.

- ▼ The Tigers are coming off an impressive week, having now won three straight after winning in a five-game thriller at Colorado on Wednesday, in front of a televised audience, and in a sweep over Texas Tech on Saturday. Mizzou started the previous week in a tie for ninth in the conference standings and now sit alone in sixth.
- ▼ Freshman Weiwen "Wendy" Wang (Nanjing, China) helped the Tigers last week in averaging 5.62 points per game on the week, scoring on 4.00 kills per game, with a .527 hitting percentage, adding 2.00 blocks per game during the two matches. At Colorado, Wang toppled school records in

blocks in a match (13) and most kills without an error (19) in the Tigers five-game win over the Buffaloes. Along with Wang's 28 credited points, a season-high, Wang's .559 (19-0-34) hitting strike ranks second-best in Mizzou history among five game matches.

- ▼ Mizzou scored 24 total team blocks in the match at CU, the most by a conference team so far this Big 12 season, and also the most in Tiger history since 1987.
- ▼ Mizzou looks for four-straight on Wednesday when they will host Texas A&M in a battle for the middle-ground as the Aggies Big 12 record stands a half-match behind Mizzou for sixth (3-5). ... On Saturday, the Tigers face Baylor before the big showdown versus No. 1 Nebraska on October 17.
