#### 12th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

For the third time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game will be held in San Antonio. The 2007 game takes place on Saturday, December 1, at the Alamodome. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged in the Alamodome were in 1997 (64,824) and 1999 (65,035).

**BAYLOR (3-4, 0-3)**  
This Week: Texas  
Next Week: at Kansas State

David Gettis' 97-yard kickoff return for a touchdown Saturday at Kansas was Baylor's first since Shaun Rochon's return against Oklahoma in 2005. It was the seventh-longest in school history.

Brandon Whitaker moved into eighth place on Baylor's career receptions list (93).

Blake Szymanski moved into seventh place on Baylor's single-season passing yardage list (1,934) and into fifth place on Baylor's single-season passing completions list (170).

Baylor's defense has forced at least one turnover in 26 of the last 30 games.



**COLORADO (4-3, 2-1)**  
This Week: Kansas  
Next Week: at Texas Tech

With 11 tackles against K-State, Jordon Dizon moved into the top five all-time at Colorado with 375. He continues to lead the nation in tackles with 12.7 a game.

Hugh Charles had the ninth 100-yard rushing game of his career and his fourth in a row with a career-high 171 yards against Kansas State.

Terrence Wheatley became the fifth player in CU history to record 1,000 kickoff return yards. He had 128 vs. KSU to give him 1,065 for his career.

Colorado has scored in 229 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak in the NCAA and the 11th-longest all-time.



**IOWA STATE (1-6, 0-3)**  
This Week: Oklahoma  
Next Week: at Missouri

Todd Blythe's three catches vs. Texas leave him four short of Lane Danielsen's (2000-03) school record 163 career receptions.

For his career Brett Meyer ranks third all-time in the Big 12 for total offense (9,572), passing yards (8,738), completions (731), attempts (1,270), and plays (1,746). He also ranks 10th in passing touchdowns (46).

Place kicker Bret Culbertson's 189 career points place him ninth on the all-time ISU chart.

Iowa State quarterback Bret Meyer has 43 straight starts, ranking first among active NCAA signal callers.



**KANSAS (6-0, 2-0)**  
This Week: at Colorado  
Next Week: at Texas A&M

Kansas is second in the country in scoring defense (9.5) and fourth in total defense (240.0). On the offensive side of the ball, the Jayhawks are second in scoring offense (50.3).

Kansas has recorded three or more interceptions in the last two games and at least two INTs in each of the last four.

Todd Reesing has 16 touchdown passes this season which is second on the school's single-season list, two shy of Bill Whittemore's record (18) established in 2003.

Marcus Herford's 88-yard kick return for a touchdown was his second of the season, which ties a Big 12 record (Ben Kelly, Colorado in 1999 and Robert Quioga, Baylor in 2003).



**KANSAS STATE (4-2, 2-1)**  
This Week: Colorado  
Next Week: at Oklahoma State

Josh Freeman is three completions away from tying Dennis Morrison (1970-72) for seventh in school history for career completions. He is 29 attempts (515 in his career) from tying Jonathan Beasley (1996-97, 99-00) for eighth in career attempts.

Jordy Nelson moved past Aaron Lockett (1998-01) for third in school history in career receptions with 140. He is 39 catches shy of tying Michael Smith (1988-91) for second place.

James Johnson carded 20 carries for a career-high 159 yards and two touchdowns vs. Colorado.

Justin McKinney led the Wildcats in tackles against CU with 12 stops, including 10 solo efforts. McKinney also set up a K-State field goal with his second interception of the season, which he returned 32 yards, and tallied two pass breakups.



**MISSOURI (5-1, 1-1)**  
This Week: at Oklahoma  
Next Week: Texas Tech

Mizzou ranks 5th nationally in total offense (533.5 ypg), and is also 5th in passing offense (358.2 ypg) and 10th in scoring offense (40.0 ppg).

The Tigers continue to lead the nation in third down conversions with a 58.5 percent success rate.

Jeremy Maclin is fourth in the country in all-purpose yards with an average of 209.8 per game.

Chase Daniel is second in the Big 12 and fifth nationally, averaging 376.7 yards of total offense.

Chase Coffman had a career-high nine catches for 95 yards at Oklahoma to break his previous best of eight set in the 2005 Independence Bowl vs. South Carolina.



**NEBRASKA (4-3, 1-2)**

**This Week:** Texas A&M  
**Next Week:** at Texas

Senior wide receiver Terrence Nunn caught four passes vs. Oklahoma State to give him 122 career receptions, 21 from Johnny Rodgers' school record of 143 career receptions.

Freshman running back Quentin Castille rushed 20 times for 102 yards vs. OSU, career-bests in both categories while marking his first career 100-yard rushing game.

Nebraska's 206 rushing yards were its second-most of the season behind the 413 yards in the season opener against Nevada.

Fullback Thomas Lawson has scored a touchdown on all three of his career receptions.



**OKLAHOMA (6-1, 2-1)**

**This Week:** at Iowa State  
**Next Week:** Open

Redshirt freshman QB Sam Bradford continues to lead the country in passing efficiency at 181.1.

The Sooner defense leads the Big 12 with 25 sacks for 188 yards. The OU 'D' is also leading the league in rushing defense, allowing only 65.1 yards per game.

Junior LB Curtis Lofton notched a career-high 18 tackles against Missouri, the most stops by a Sooner since Lance Mitchell recorded 19 at Missouri in 2002.

With seven catches against the Tigers, junior WR Juaquin Iglesias has 102 for his career. He became the 12th Sooner with more than 100 career catches all-time and the eighth under Bob Stoops.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (4-3, 2-1)**

**This Week:** Kansas State  
**Next Week:** Open

With its 317 rushing yards at Nebraska, OSU has rushed for 200 yards or more in six consecutive games.

OSU posted 234 passing yards and 317 rushing yards against Nebraska, giving the Cowboys their fourth consecutive game with at least 200 passing and rushing yards.

Senior running back Dantrell Savage had a career-high 212 rushing yards in Saturday's win at Nebraska to reach the century mark for the fourth consecutive game.

Against Nebraska, Adarius Bowman recorded 100 receiving yards to become the first Cowboy since D'Juan Woods in 2005 to post three consecutive 100-yard receiving games.



**TEXAS (5-2, 1-2)**

**This Week:** at Baylor  
**Next Week:** Nebraska

With 298 passing yards and 216 rushing yards, the Horns eclipsed the 200-yard plateau in rushing and passing for the third time this season (UCF and Rice).

Jamaal Charles moved into 12th place on UT's all-time rushing list with 2,375 yards.

Brandon Foster's 39-yard interception return for a touchdown marked his third TD of the season and the fourth of his career. His three defensive TDs (two INT returns, one fumble return) in 2007 is a UT single-season record.

Colt McCoy's 348 total yards vs Iowa State marked the second-best output of his career behind his 352 total yards against Oklahoma State last season.



**TEXAS A&M (5-2, 2-1)**

**This Week:** at Nebraska  
**Next Week:** Kansas

The Aggies are the only team in the nation with three players ranked among the top 100 rushers. Quarterback Stephen McGee and running backs Mike Goodson and Jorvorskie Lane combined to rush for 207 yards on 40 carries at Texas Tech.

Tight end Martellus Bennett extended his reception streak to 25 games, one behind the school record of 26 set by A&M's all-time leading receiver Terrence Murphy from 2002-04.

Running back Jorvorskie Lane scored the 40th touchdown of his career Saturday vs. Texas Tech, tying him with Leeland McElroy for third place on the Aggies' all-time total touchdowns list.

A&M has converted 6 of 9 (66.7 percent) fourth-down conversions this season.



**TEXAS TECH (6-1, 2-1)**

**This Week:** at Missouri  
**Next Week:** Colorado

Redshirt freshman Michael Crabtree leads the country in receptions (11.1), receiving yards (177.7), and scoring (14.6 ppg).

Graham Harrell is the NCAA leader in total offense with 445.7 yards a game. He also leads the Big 12 in passing yards with 450.1.

Alex Trlica added to his NCAA record with 214 consecutive point-after-attempts. He has never missed a PAT during his Tech career.

In the last three games, the Red Raider defense is holding opponents to an average of 257 yards and 10.3 points-per-game.

Texas Tech is bowl-eligible for the 15th-straight season, the only Big 12 team to be eligible every season since the inception of the conference.
