## **ISU FACES OU FOR HOMECOMING**

Iowa State faces No. 4/4 Oklahoma a week after losing 56-3 to the Sooners' Red River rival, Texas last week in Ames ... it is Homecoming at Iowa State ... Iowa State is 36-52-6 in Homecoming games ... Iowa State quarterback Bret Meyer will make his 44th straight start ... Meyer is the all-time Iowa State leader in passing (8,738) and total offense (9,466), ranking third among all-time Big 12 signal callers ... after being sacked 105 times in his first three seasons, Meyer has been sacked just 10 times in seven games ... 2006 first-team all-Big 12 linebacker Alvin "Ace" Bowen has 249 career tackles heading into Saturday's game ... the last time Iowa State played Oklahoma on Homecoming was in 1984 ... the game ended with a 12-10 OU victory that went down to the wire before a nationally televised ESPN audience in the first night game in Jack Trice Stadium history.

## **6-1 OKLAHOMA IS RANKED NO. 4**

Oklahoma running back Chris Brown ran for three second-half touchdowns, Curtis Lofton returned a fumble for a score and the Sooners knocked No. 11 Missouri from the ranks of the unbeaten with a 41-31 win in Norman last weekend ... the win improved Oklahoma's record to 6-1 overall and 2-1 in Big 12 play ... Missouri could generate only 57 yards rushing against OU after the Tigers had posted at least 195 rushing yards in their previous four games ... Oklahoma QB Sam Bradford leads the nation in passing efficiency, completing 128-of-181 passes for 1,689 yards and 20 TDs with just four interceptions ... the Sooners rank fourth nationally in scoring offense (48.43) and in rushing defense at 65.14 yards per game.

- ▶ Last Meeting (10-14-06 in Norman): Iowa State held No. 22 Oklahoma to just a field goal on the Sooners' first six possessions of the second half, and tallied a safety, but OU still prevailed 34-9 ... it was a costly game for both teams as Iowa State co-captain and cornerback De Andre Jackson suffered a career-ending knee injury on a kickoff return and OU TB and Heisman Trophy hopeful Adrian Peterson broke his collarbone on a TD run.

## **STAT OF THE WEEK**

**159** Iowa State WR Todd Blythe needs just five catches to pass Lane Danielsen (163, 2000-03) as the all-time ISU career receptions leader ... Blythe is already the all-time ISU receiving yards leader with 2,773 career yards.

## THE TOP 15 STORY LINES

**1. WHEN IOWA STATE HEAD COACH GENE CHIZIK** tasted victory for the first time as a head coach Sept. 15, in a 15-13 win over intrastate rival Iowa, he became the first Cyclone head coach to win his first Iowa State-Iowa game since Clyde Williams in 1907.

**2. ISU QUARTERBACK BRET MEYER** makes his 44th straight start in this week's game. Meyer is second among active NCAA signal-callers in total offense (9,572 yards) and his 1,746 career offensive plays make him, by far, the busiest collegiate football player of the last four years (second/Colt Brennan, Hawai'i 1,587). Despite this, and being sacked 115 times, he has never missed a game because of injury. He passed Vince Young of Texas (9,176, 2003-05) Sept. 29 to move into third place on the all-time Big 12 total offense list. The same day Meyer passed Major Applewhite of Texas (8,353 1998-2001) to move into third place on the all-time Big 12 passing yards list with 8,738.

**3. UNDER ATHLETICS DIRECTOR JAMIE POLLARD**, Iowa State has crushed previous records, selling more than 36,000 season tickets. This, after the Cyclones posted their previous two largest crowds in school history in 2006: 55,518 vs. Northern Iowa and 55,338 vs. Nebraska. On Sept. 8, ISU topped those crowds with an all-time record of 56,795 fans against Northern Iowa. Iowa State has averaged 51,421 fans for its first four home games.

**4. IOWA STATE WIDE RECEIVER TODD BLYTHE** has averaged 17.4 yards per reception, third among active NCAA receivers with at least 100 career catches. At Texas Tech, he passed Lane Danielsen (2000-03/2,690), and is the school record-holder in receiving yards with 2,773 yards. Blythe's 29 touchdown catches are a school record, second is Ed Williams (1994-97) and Keith Krepfle (1971-73) with 15. His 29 TD receptions rank him fifth on the all-time Big 12 Conference list. Texas Tech's Jarrett Hicks (2003-06) is fourth with 30 TD receptions.

**5. R.J. SUMRALL ISU'S NO. 2 RECEIVER** The junior has 33 catches for 322 yards. He has figured large in Iowa State's plan to spread out the passing game. Sumrall caught a career-high seven passes against UNI and Iowa. He had a 41-yard kickoff return against Kent State and UNI. He is averaging 22.2 yards per kickoff return and is a Drake Relays champion hurdler.

### 6. HAMILTON GETTING IN THE WR ACTION

Hamilton, a sophomore, has good size at 6-3, 217. He is third on the team with 23 receptions for 245 yards.

### 7. IOWA STATE PLACEKICKER BRET CULBERTSON WAS BIG 12 SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

after having the biggest day of his career against Iowa Sept. 15, hitting on field-goal attempts of 21, 33, 42, 40 and 28 yards in six attempts. His last field goal came with one second left in the game to give the Cyclones a 15-13 victory. Culbertson's five field goals equalled the school record. The 42- and 40-yard field goals were kicked into a stiff breeze. He had a 47-yard attempt that hit the left upright. He is among the most accurate placekickers in school history, hitting on 36-of-51 career field-goal attempts. The former walk-on has made all of his 86 PAT tries. The Des Moines-Lincoln graduate is 29-of-35 inside 40 yards and had a career-long

52-yard three-pointer against Texas Tech last season. Culbertson ranks eighth in all-time ISU career scoring with 194 points. Tailback Blaise Bryant (1989-90) is seventh with 198 points.

### 8. LAST SECOND HEROICS RARE AT ISU

Culbertson's winning field goal with one second left against Iowa marked only the second time in school history that Iowa State has won with a second or less remaining. Marc Bachrodt drilled a 47-yard field goal as time expired to beat Kansas 38-35 on Oct. 8, 1983 in Ames.

**9. LINEBACKER ALVIN "ACE" BOWEN** led the nation with 12.91 tackles per game last season. He began 2007 as a consensus first-team all-Big 12 selection. He had his biggest game at Texas Tech, making 15 tackles and forcing a fumble. He owns 249 career tackles in his third collegiate season.

### 10. TURNOVERS HURTING THE CYCLONES

Gene Chizik, a former defensive coordinator at Auburn and Texas, has put a premium on turnovers this season. It is easy to see why. In ISU's 2005 Houston Bowl season (7-5), the Cyclones outscored opponents off turnovers, 119-57 (+62). Last season, opponents outscored Iowa State, 67-30, off turnovers in a 4-8 season. In the first seven weeks of 2007, 19 ISU turnovers have cost the Cyclones dearly, leading to 79 oppo-

ment points. ISU has tallied 13 points on nine opponent turnovers (-66). ISU ranks 111th nationally and last in the Big 12 in turnover margin. Iowa State has yet to play a turnover-free game this fall.

### 11. IOWA STATE'S SMITH & SMITH ARE IOWANS MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Free safety James Smith has made 46 tackles in seven games. He had earned a starting spot in fall camp in 2006 but the Council Bluffs (across the river from Omaha) native suffered a broken ankle that kept him from playing until the eighth game of last season. Middle linebacker Jesse Smith is a former walk on from Altoona, Iowa who played at Southeast Polk High School (same school as Chicago Bears QB Kyle Orton). He has 36 tackles.

**12. IOWA STATE RB JASON SCALES** has stepped up the last three weeks. When previous starter J.J. Bass could not play at Nebraska. Scales, who rushed for more than 6,000 yards in high school but had been hampered by injuries in his collegiate career, rushed 31 times for a career-high 115 yards and two touchdowns. At Texas Tech, he rushed for 82 yards on 22 carries and then tallied 77 yards on 19 carries last weekend against Texas.

**13. IOWA STATE RB J.J. BASS** rushed for a season-high 134 yards on 34 carries and two TDs at Toledo, his second game over 100 yards rushing. Bass' 34 carries at Toledo were the most rushing attempts by a Cyclone since Nov. 17, 2001.

### 14. TIME OF POSSESSION

Iowa State has been able to sustain drives even if it does not all end up with points. Iowa State's time of possession average of 32:29 leads the Big 12 Conference. The Cyclones have held a time of possession edge in the last four games. ISU ran off a school-record 102 plays at Texas Tech. At Nebraska, the Cyclones held the ball for 39:12 to 20:48 for the Huskers.

### 15. PLAYING BY THE RULES

Through seven games, Iowa State is the least penalized team in the Big 12 Conference, having been flagged just 23 times for 200 yards -- both league lows.

# MEDIA INFORMATION

## Credentials

### Media Credentials and Parking

All requests for credentials must be made on-line at cyclones.com. Questions should be directed to Kendra Smith in the ISU Athletics Communications Office at kendras@iastate.edu or (515) 294-3372. Parking passes should be requested when requesting credentials. Credentials will either be mailed to the address indicated on the request or may be picked up on game day at Media Will Call. Credentials will be granted to the media on assignment from daily newspapers, ISU network radio affiliates (as space permits), originating radio stations and television stations. Misuse of these credentials will result in expulsion from the game and denial of credentials to future ISU athletic activities. Credentials are non-transferrable.

### Photo Credentials

Photo credentials must be requested in the same manner as media credentials. For sideline armbands, photo credentials must be presented prior to the game in the press box in accordance with Big 12 Conference rules. Misuse of photo credentials will result in expulsion from the game. An affiliation photo ID must be shown on gamedays to obtain an armband for field admittance.

### Radio Originations

A radio booth is provided for the visiting team's designated station. Additional originations may be arranged through Tom Kroeschell. Auxiliary booths (outside the press box) are used for additional stations. Telephone arrangements should be made through Iowa State University Telecommunications at (515) 294-8556.

### Telephones & Ethernet

Iowa State provides four courtesy phone lines and one ethernet hub in the main press box area for media use on a first-come, first-served basis, as well as a wireless internet connection. Media requiring their own phone lines or ethernet should contact ISU Telecommunications at (515) 294-8556.

## Gameday Operations

### Parking

Media parking is located in the South Lot (S-2) of Jack Trice Stadium. Parking passes should be requested when requesting credentials.

### Press Tower

The Jack Trice Stadium press tower is located on the west side of the stadium and is accessed through the press tower elevator. Admission is by media credential only. The press tower is a three-level facility with separate donor, media and radio-television decks. As per the instructions of the State Fire Marshal, smoking is not permitted in the press tower. Athletics Communications personnel will staff the press box for three hours following the game.

## Services

Complete play-by-play copy, halftime stats, final team and individual stats, tackle charts and quotes from coaches and players are provided.

## Photo Deck

A photo deck is located directly under the press tower directly below the donor (first) level. Arrangements to secure a spot should be made with the Athletics Communications office.

## Interview Policies

In addition to weekly press conferences, interviews shall be conducted between 6:30-9 p.m. CST on Sunday through Wednesday. **MEDIA WISHING TO INTERVIEW IOWA STATE PLAYERS SHOULD CALL THE IOWA STATE ATHLETICS COMMUNICATIONS OFFICE BETWEEN 1-4 P.M. ON SUNDAYS WITH THEIR INTERVIEW REQUESTS.** All player interviews must be coordinated through the Communications office.

## Post-game Interviews

ISU's locker room is closed. Following a "cooling off" period after the game, head coach Gene Chizik will conduct a press conference in the Jacobson Athletic Building's Hunziker Auditorium (second floor). Media must enter the Jacobson Athletic Building through the facility's northwest door. Iowa State players requested by media personnel will be escorted from the locker room to the auditorium after Coach Chizik is finished. Opposing media can attend the visitor's press conference in the meeting room directly opposite the visiting locker room in the Olsen Building.

# HEAD COACH GENE CHIZIK



## CHIZIK UP CLOSE

Born in Tarpon Springs, Fla. Family moved to Clearwater, Fla. when Gene was six years old. Clearwater is part of the Tampa-St. Petersburg metropolitan area.

Chizik taught third grade for two years at Bauder Elementary School in Seminole, Fla. After school, he walked across the street to help coach football at Seminole HS.

Gene has three older sisters.

Gene was a Miami Dolphins fan until the Tampa Bay Buccaneers franchise was formed. He backed the Bucs even when the team lost its first 26 games in 1976-77.

Gene was a high school linebacker at Clearwater High School. He was also a member of the chess club.

His first job was washing cars.

His father, Gene, earned a bronze star on Okinawa during the battle of Sugar Loaf Hill in May 1945. Gene Chizik Sr., coached high school football while getting a graduate degree and went on to be principal at Tarpon High School and Largo High School. The best advice Iowa State's head coach got from his father was "don't tell me, show me."

Gene's favorite hobbies include fishing and chess. He loves chess because of the all the different strategy that is involved. His fishing highlight came two years ago when his son, Cally, caught his first fish, a bass, while on vacation.

He has an eclectic love of music. Likes country and ABBA.

Gene Chizik was the man. From the moment Iowa State athletics director Jamie Pollard began a search for a new head football coach, Chizik was at the top of Pollard's list of potential candidates. He wasn't alone. Everyone wanted Gene Chizik. It was easy to see why. Chizik had the perfect résumé.

He had been assistant head coach and defensive coordinator on Texas' 2005 national championship team. Before that, three years as defensive coordinator at Auburn, where in the midst of 30 wins in three seasons he earned the Frank Broyles Award as the nation's top assistant coach. Because of his experience as a defensive coordinator on conference title teams in three different BCS conferences, Chizik was mentioned as a candidate for the most high profile head coaching jobs.

Chizik's track record of preparing players for college football and beyond is unassailable. Amazingly, the new ISU head coach has tutored the last three winners of the Jim Thorpe Award (Carlos Rogers, Michael Huff, Aaron Ross). The honor is given annually to the nation's top collegiate defensive back.

As defensive coordinator, Chizik learned from the best head coaches in the nation's top collegiate programs while making tremendous contributions toward the enhancement of their national head coaching reputations. The national championship won by Texas in 2005 was the school's first since 1970. When Auburn won the 2004 SEC Championship game, it was the Tigers' first league crown since 1989.

Chizik's defense loomed large in Texas' 2005 national championship season under head coach Mack Brown. The Longhorns ranked eighth nationally in scoring defense, 10th in total defense and fourth in pass efficiency defense. UT allowed opponents to reach 300 yards of total offense only five times in 2005 and held the remaining eight opponents to less than 267 yards. Ten UT defenders were all-Big 12 Conference selections.

At Auburn, Chizik's defenses were unforgiving and set a standard for the rest of the country. In 2004, the Tigers gave up a national low 11.3 points per game en route to an undefeated season. Overall, the Tigers gave up an average of just 277.62 yards of total offense per contest, ranking fifth nationally for the second straight season. The 2003 Auburn defense was fifth nationally in total defense, allowing just 281.6 yards per game, the best total by a Tiger defense in more than a decade.

Chizik was also defensive coordinator for four seasons (1998-2001) at Central Florida. He improved a unit that ranked 81st nationally in total defense before his arrival to one that rated 16th in 2001. Chizik coached both linebackers (1998) and the secondary (1999-2001) at UCF. During his tenure with the Golden Knights, Chizik made frequent trips from Orlando to Tampa to study defensive concepts with Buccaneers head coach Tony Dungy and defensive coordinator Monte Kiffin.

Chizik also coached at Stephen F. Austin University, tutoring linebackers (1992-94) and the secondary (1995-97). He was SFA's defensive coordinator in 1996 and 1997. Philadelphia Eagle Jeremiah Trotter was his star with the Lumberjacks.

He stepped into college coaching at Clemson University (1988-89) as a graduate assistant for a pair of 10-win teams and then worked at Middle Tennessee State (1990-91) as a full-time assistant. The Blue Raiders made the NCAA Division I-AA playoffs in both of his seasons and were conference champions in 1990.

Chizik, a native of Clearwater, Fla., and his wife (Jonna) have identical twin daughters (Landry Grace and Kennedy Danielle) and one son, Cally.

**Ames, Iowa (Clyde Williams Field/18,000)**

With just three days to go before the U.S. presidential election pitting John F. Kennedy vs. Richard Nixon, Iowa State fans directed their attention to All-American quarterback Dave Hoppmann and his teammates who were trying to do something that an ISU football team hadn't done since its first ever game against Oklahoma in 1928, beat the Sooners in Ames ... Oklahoma led 6-0 at halftime ... Hoppmann then got the Cyclones going ... a third-quarter 38-yard field goal by Larry Schreiber put Iowa State on the board ... Hoppmann then took over the game, rushing for a total of 152 yards on 29 carries ... ISU took advantage of three Sooner turnovers on a total of five OU fumbles ... Oklahoma back Ronnie Hartline rushed for 144 yards on 22 carries but the Sooners could not get into the endzone in the second half, despite outgaining Iowa State, 231-206 ... ISU actually fumbled the ball six times but lost only one loose ball to Oklahoma.

## Kent State 23 Iowa State 14

### Aug. 30 • Jack Trice Stadium • Ames, Iowa

AMES, Iowa -- Kent State quarterback Julian Edleman totalled 236 yards of total offense, throwing for one TD and running for another as the Golden Flashes controlled the tempo in the second half to beat Iowa State ... ISU was playing for the first time under coach Gene Chizik ... Iowa State had gone ahead 7-6 after a 13-yard TD run by running back J.J. Bass with just 1:12 left in the first half ... the junior college transfer rushed for 133 yards, 106 in the first half for the best debut by an Iowa State tailback since Blaise Bryant rushed for 213 yards in the 1989 season opener ... Kent State's Jack Williams returned the ensuing kickoff 57 yards to the Cyclone 32 ... Kent State drove quickly to the ISU 7-yard line before PK Nate Reed connected on a 24-yard field goal with 2 seconds left for a 9-7 halftime advantage ... Iowa State came out smoking in the second half ... ISU's Allen Bell returned the opening kickoff 40 yards to the Cyclone 42 ... Iowa State QB Bret Meyer drove the Cyclones 58 yards in five plays, including three passes to WR Todd Blythe ... the last Meyer to Blythe pass was a 16-yard TD pass play that put Iowa State up 14-9 ... Kent State answered with a 12-play 56-yard drive with RB Eugene Jarvis scoring from 2 yards out for a 16-14 Kent State lead with 3:26 left in the third quarter ... Jarvis rushed for 113 yards on 25 carries as the Golden Flashes ran up 202 team rushing yards ... a Brian Lainhart interception of a Bret Meyer pass on Iowa State's next possession gave Kent State first-and-goal at the Iowa State 8-yard line ... Jarvis scored from 2 yards out moments later for a 23-14 lead that was never relinquished ... Kent State out gained ISU 179-89 in the second half ... Iowa State had a time of possession advantage of 17:26-12:34 in the first half but Kent State had a 18:02-11:58 lead in the second half ... Iowa State sophomore MLB Jessie Smith, a former walk-on, led Cyclones in his first start with 12 tackles and also forced a fumble ... ## Iowa 13

### Iowa State 15

#### Sept. 15 • Jack Trice Stadium • Ames, Iowa

It was Shaggy's day ... Iowa State placekicker Bret Culbertson, whose nickname was founded in his resemblance to the Scooby-Doo cartoon character, kicked a school-record tying five field goals in six attempts, the last from 28 yards with one second left as ISU defeated heavily-favored and previously unbeaten Iowa, 15-13 in Jack Trice Stadium ... Culbertson earned Big 12 Special Teams Player-of-the-Week honors for his performance ... Culbertson's field goals of 21, 33, 42, 40 yards before hitting the game winner complemented a tenacious defensive effort that held Iowa to only 233 yards of total offense ... Iowa State began the game with the wind at its back and the result was three touchbacks by Culbertson that forced Iowa to start its first three drives at its own 20 ... each time the Cyclone defense held, each time the ISU offense followed with drives of 53, 49 and 27 yards to set up Culbertson's first three field goals ... Culbertson's 42- and 40-yard efforts were into a stiff wind ... Iowa's kickoffs with the wind did not produce a single touchback ... up 12-0 at halftime, Iowa State started the second half with the ball ... ISU QB Bret Meyer fumbled on the third play from scrimmage, Iowa recovered and Hawkeye QB Jay Christensen scored on a bootleg from 11 yards out to close the gap to 12-7 ... Iowa's first fourth-quarter drive ended with the second-biggest non-scoring play of the day ... Iowa's Austin Signor's 33-yard field-goal attempt was blocked by ISU's Christopher Lyle ... but Iowa State went three-and-out on its ensuing drive and Signor responded with a 41-yard field goal that put the Hawkeyes into the lead for the first time, 13-12 with 3:38 left in the game ... it was put-up or shut-up time for senior quarterback Bret Meyer and his team ... Iowa State faced 2nd-and-13 at the ISU 46 with 1:30 to go ... the Cyclones needed a big play and got one that was literally drawn up on the Iowa State sideline ... Iowa State lined up true freshman quarterback Phillip Bates wide to the left side of the field ... seeing Hawk linebacker Mike Klinkenborg assigned to cover the speedy Bates, Meyer called the play as drawn and hit Bates with a 38-yard reception that set up Culbertson's winning field goal.

Bass scored on a 1-yard run, the Cyclones led Toledo 35-24 in the Glass Bowl ... the Cyclones had held the upper hand in the game, running 28 more plays and owning a decided advantage in time of possession ... it came undone quickly ... Toledo's Jalen Parmele broke a host of Cyclone tackles, returning the ensuing kickoff after Bass' score 82 yards for a touchdown and suddenly it was 35-30 after the Cyclones denied a two-point conversion try with 5:08 remaining ... Iowa State went three-and-out on its next series ... ## Iowa State 17 Nebraska 35

Sept. 29 • Memorial Stadium • Lincoln, Neb.

Iowa State ran a school record 102 plays and tallied 415 total yards, the second-most total offensive yards ever by a Cyclone team in Lincoln, Neb. ... ISU had the ball 39:12 to Nebraska's 20:48 ... Iowa State TB Jason Scales rushed for a career-high 115 yards and two TDs ... but despite the numbers, Nebraska won the game 35-17 in Memorial Stadium as the Huskers countered the Cyclone effort by making the big plays at the right time ... it was not always a pretty game ... the teams committed a combined total of seven turnovers ... it was Nebraska turnovers that helped Iowa State take an early lead ... the Cyclones stopped Nebraska at the 1-yard line when ISU forced Nebraska's RB Marlon Lucky to fumble midway through the first quarter ... Iowa State DB Allen Bell scooped up the ball returned it 34 yards to the Cyclone 35 ...when the ensuing Iowa State drive stalled, a Nebraska defender was whistled for offsides on a 4th-and-4 punting situation ... with new life, the Cyclones drove to the Nebraska 13-yard line, where placekicker Bret Culbertson hit on a 30-yard field goal attempt for a 3-0 ISU lead with

2:05 left in the first quarter ... Scales tallied 63 yards on 18 first-half carries, including several on a 48-yard, six-play drive that was capped by his 3-yard TD run to put the Cyclones up 10-0 with 7:47 left in the first half ... ## Iowa State 17 Texas Tech 42

Oct. 6 • Jones Stadium • Lubbock, Texas

The Iowa State defense did its job, "holding" Texas Tech to season lows in total offense (489) and points (42) despite being on the field because the Cyclone offense struggled to get going ... it was the lack of offensive punch that repeatedly pinned Iowa State in its own territory ... the Cyclone defense, led by 15 tackles from all-Big 12 linebacker Alvin "Ace" Bowen, stopped the Red Raiders on their first drive, the first time that Texas Tech had not scored a TD on its initial drive ... Texas Tech moved out to a 21-0 lead as Iowa State's offense could muster only two first downs in the first half ... its was 28-3 at the break ... turnovers again were key ... after ISU recovered a fumble with 5:20 to go in the first half, Cyclone RB JJ. Bass fumbled away the football on the next play and Red Raider Darcel McBath ran the ball in for a TD ... another Texas Tech score was set up by a high snap over Bret Meyer's head that was recovered by the Red Raiders deep in ISU territory ... the Cyclones notched their first touchdown late in the game on a 5-yard keeper by Meyer to cap off an 11-play, 80-yard drive that cut the lead to 42-10 ... Meyer then hooked up with Todd Blythe for a 38-yard strike to make it a 42-17 game ... it was Blythe's third TD catch of the season and his school-record 29th of his career ... Blythe finished the game with eight catches for 128 yards and became Iowa State's all-time career leader with 2,736 receiving yards, passing Lane Danielsen (2,690/2000-03) ... Blythe also moved by Tracey Henderson into second place on the all-time career receptions list ... No. 22 Texas scored on five of its first six possessions and never looked back, dispatching Iowa State 56-3 on Family Weekend in Ames ... Texas scored on a 58-yard pass from QB Colt McCoy to WR Jordan Shipley on the Longhorns' first play from scrimmage ... after a missed Iowa State field goal attempt, McCoy drove Texas 80 yards in 10 plays with his 6-yard pass to Quan Cosby giving the Longhorns a 14-0 advantage with 26 seconds left in the first quarter ... Bret Culbertson capped a 12-play, 67-yard Iowa State drive with a 25-yard field goal that closed the gap to 14-3 with 11:15 remaining in the first half ... the Cyclones only crossed mid-field once in the second half as turnovers again plagued the ISU effort ... a trio of turnovers led to two Texas touchdowns, including Brandon Foster's 39-yard interception return of a Bret Meyer pass that gave the Longhorns a 42-3 advantage with 10:21 left in the third quarter ... the elusive McCoy hit on 23-of-30 passes for 298 yards and four touchdowns ... he also scrambled away from several ISU defenders on a 44-yard touchdown run .... Iowa State's Jason Scales rushed 19 times for 77 yards ... Meyer was 17-of-33 for 111 yards with two interceptions ... Iowa State's biggest play was a flea flicker in which WR Todd Blythe hit Meyer with a 21-yard pass on the Cyclones' only scoring drive ... Texas' 514 yards of total offense marked the first time Iowa State had given up more than 500 yards in 45 games, ending the fifth-longest streak nationally ... Blythe had three catches for 37 yards and WR Marquis Hamilton had three catches for 23 yards ...
