### 12th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

For the third time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game will be held in San Antonio. The 2007 game takes place on Saturday, December 1, at the Alamodome. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged in the Alamodome were in 1997 (64,824) and 1999 (65,035).

**BAYLOR (3-7, 0-6)**  
This Week: at Oklahoma  
Next Week: Oklahoma State

Baylor has forced at least one turnover in 29 of the last 33 games, including nine of 10 games this season.

RB Brandon Whitaker became the seventh player in Baylor history with at least 100 career receptions.

QB Blake Szymanski moved into second place on Baylor's single-season passing yards list with 2,338 this season.

Szymanski moved into second place on Baylor's single-season completions list with 210 in 2007.

FS Jordan Lake recorded double figures in tackles for the third consecutive game and the fifth time this season with 15 stops against Texas Tech.



**COLORADO (5-5, 3-3)**  
This Week: at Iowa State  
Next Week: Open

Cody Hawkins' consecutive games streak with at least one touchdown pass came to an end at nine, leaving him tied with Koy Detmer for the school record. Hawkins ranks 14th on CU's career list with 2,190 yards passing.

Hugh Charles moved into eighth on the CU all-time rushing list with 2,407 career yards.

Jordan Dizon is fifth in the nation and first in the Big 12 in tackles with 11.9 a game. He has 85 solo stops and 34 assisted tackles.

Colorado has scored in 232 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak in the NCAA and the 11th-longest all-time.



**IOWA STATE (2-8, 1-5)**  
This Week: Colorado  
Next Week: at Kansas

Bret Meyer is the third player in Big 12 history to amass 10,000 yards of total offense with 10,136 in his career.

Chris Singleton intercepted two Kansas State passes, becoming the first Cyclone to accomplish that feat since Oct. 22, 2005, when LaMarcus Hicks had two interceptions against Oklahoma State.

Bret Culbertson scored seven points (4 PAT, 1 FG) Saturday to become the seventh Cyclone to cross the 200-point mark for a career (206). His 95 career extra points are second to Jamie Kohl's 106 (1995-98).

Alexander Robinson tallied career highs in receptions (five) and receiving yardage (75) in Saturday's win. Robinson nearly doubled his season output, as he entered the game with eight receptions for 71 yards.



**KANSAS (9-0, 5-0)**  
This Week: at Oklahoma State  
Next Week: Iowa State

Kansas is second in the country in scoring defense (13.4) and seventh in total defense (288.3). On the offensive side of the ball, the Jayhawks jumped three places to second in scoring offense (46.2).

KU is second in the nation in turnover margin at +16, the only Big 12 team with a double-digit positive margin.

Marcus Herford is averaging 31.8 yards per kick return to rank fifth nationally.

Todd Reesing moved into third on the KU single-season completions list with 180. His 2,339 passing yards this season rank fourth-best in school history, 46 shy from third. Reesing's 2,542 yards total offense in 2007 moved him into fourth on the KU season chart.



**KANSAS STATE (5-4, 3-3)**  
This Week: at Nebraska  
Next Week: Missouri

Jordy Nelson is second nationally in receptions (9.9) and receiving yards (133.6) per game, trailing Michael Crabtree of Texas Tech. Nelson has 2,418 yards in his career to move past Aaron Lockett (1998-01) for third on the KSU career list, and is 39 yards from tying Michael Smith (1988-91) for second.

The 2007 K-State team has a school record 242 completions this season, breaking the record of the 1998 squad, who finished the season with 227 completions.

The Wildcat defense has picked off 14 passes over the last six games, including four by Chris Carney and three by Justin McKinney.

Josh Freeman has 4,301 career passing yards, which ranks seventh in school history. His 2,521 passing yards this season rank seventh on the school's single-season list.



**MISSOURI (8-1, 4-1)**  
This Week: Texas A&M  
Next Week: at Kansas State

Mizzou ranks 7th nationally in total offense (509.7 ypg), and is also 5th in passing offense (337.6 ypg) and 6th in scoring offense (42.0 ppg).

Chase Daniel is second in the Big 12 and fifth nationally, averaging 354.1 yards of total offense.

Jeremy Maclin gained 187 all-purpose yards vs. Colorado to set the single-season school record with 1,682. He ranks first in the conference and 10th nationally.

The Mizzou defense has forced a turnover in 15 consecutive games.

Chase Coffman's three TDs last week gave him 19 for his three-year career, surpassing the school record of 18 set by wide receiver Justin Gage from 1999-2002.



**NEBRASKA (4-6, 1-5)**

**This Week:** Kansas State  
**Next Week:** Open

Senior wide receiver Maurice Purify caught seven passes for a career-high 158 yards and three touchdowns at Kansas. Purify has 74 career receptions and moved into the Nebraska Top 10 on the career receptions list. He also moved into the Top 10 on the NU career receiving yardage list with 1,200 to rank fifth.

QB Joe Ganz' 405 passing yards vs. KU are the third-most passing yards in school history and represent the third 400-yard passing game in school history.

Junior I-back Marlon Lucky's 61 receptions in 2007 are a season receptions record, bettering Johnny Rodgers' 55 catches in 1972.



**OKLAHOMA (8-1, 4-1)**

**This Week:** Baylor  
**Next Week:** at Texas Tech

Auston English's 9.5 sacks rank sixth nationally. The Sooner defense leads the Big 12 with 28 sacks for 209 yards.

Redshirt freshman QB Sam Bradford is second in the country in passing efficiency at 175.1 while leading OU to third nationally in scoring offense at 44.2.

With eight tackles Saturday against the Aggies, junior LB Curtis Lofton moved into 13th place on OU's career list with 101 stops.

With four touchdown catches against the Aggies, sophomore TE Jermaine Gresham became the Sooners' single season record holder in touchdown receptions by a tight end with 10 and is third among all receivers.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (5-4, 3-2)**

**This Week:** Kansas  
**Next Week:** at Baylor

With 594 yards of total offense vs. Texas, Oklahoma State surpassed 500 yards of total offense for the third consecutive game and the fifth time this season.

Zac Robinson threw for a school-record 430 yards against Texas, besting current Cowboy head coach Mike Gundy's mark of 429 yards set in 1989 against Kansas. Robinson's 486 yards of total offense - 430 passing, 56 rushing - also set a school record.

Adarius Bowman became the fourth player in OSU history to top the 2,000 yard-receiving mark. Bowman has 2,091 yards receiving in his two-year Cowboy career.

Dantrell Savage rushed for over 100 yards Saturday (103) for the sixth straight game.



**TEXAS (8-2, 4-2)**

**This Week:** Texas Tech  
**Next Week:** Open

Jamaal Charles has rushed for 470 yards and six TDs on 49 carries (9.6 ypc) in the last two games. He's also scored three TDs in each of the last two games, marking the first time since Ricky Williams in 1998 that a UT player has run for at least three TDs in consecutive games. On those six TDs, he's averaged 44.3 yards per scoring run.

Charles has rushed for 341 yards and five TDs on 20 carries (17.1 ypc) in the fourth quarter of the last two contests.

Ryan Bailey's 40-yard game-winning field goal against Oklahoma State as time expired was his second career game-clincher. It marked just the fourth time in UT history that the Horns won on the game's final play.

Quan Cosby became the second player in school history to log over 1,000 receiving yards and 1,000 kickoff return yards in a career with 1,314 receiving yards and 1,063 kickoff return yards.



**TEXAS A&M (6-4, 3-3)**

**This Week:** at Missouri  
**Next Week:** Open

Tight end Martellus Bennett's 27-game receptions streak set a school record. The Aggie's leading receiver has 36 catches for 430 yards in 2007.

Return specialist Kerry Franks surpassed the 1,000-yard plateau in career kickoff return yardage with two returns for 60 yards against Oklahoma. Franks now has 1,008 yards on 39 career returns.

This marks the third consecutive week A&M plays a team ranked in the Top 10 of the Coaches Poll.

The Aggies have rushed for 24 of the 29 touchdowns they have scored.

Jorvorskie Lane is second in the Big 12 and 15th nationally in scoring with 9.8 points a game.



**TEXAS TECH (7-3, 3-3)**

**This Week:** at Texas  
**Next Week:** Oklahoma

Redshirt freshman Michael Crabtree leads the country in receptions (10.4) and receiving yards (151.2), and is tied for third in scoring (12.0 ppg).

Tech leads the nation in passing offense (482.1) and total offense (549.5) and is fifth in scoring offense (42.4).

Graham Harrell is the NCAA leader in total offense with 434.4 yards a game. He became the fifth quarterback in NCAA history to reach 4,000 passing yards in back-to-back seasons. He joins Ty Detmer (BYU), Byron Leftwich (Marshall), Timmy Chang (Hawaii) and Colt Brennan (Hawaii).

Alex Trlica added to his NCAA record with 222 consecutive point-after-attempts and tied for third on the TTU career field goals list with 43.
