BIG 12 NOTEBOOK

⇒ The Big 12 has three teams ranked in the Top 5 spots of the BCS Standings (Kansas-3, Oklahoma-4, Missouri-5), and is the only league with four in the Top 15 (Texas-13). This marks the third time the Big 12 has had three teams ranked in the BCS Top 5 since 2001 (Oct. 27 and Nov. 3, 2001) when Oklahoma (1), Nebraska (2) and Texas (5) were ranked. In the November 24, 2001, BCS Standings the Big 12 had four teams ranked in the Top 10 (3-Texas, 4-Nebraska, 7-Colorado, 9-Oklahoma).

⇒ The Big 12 is home to three of the nation's top four receptions per game leaders (Michael Crabtree-Texas Tech; Jordy Nelson-Kansas State; Danny Amendola-Texas Tech), the top two in receiving yards (Michael Crabtree-Texas Tech; Jordy Nelson-Kansas State), two of the top three in pass efficiency (Sam Bradford-Oklahoma; Graham Harrell-Texas Tech), and two of the top four in total offense (Graham Harrell-Texas Tech; Chase Daniel-Missouri).

⇒ Four Big 12 teams rank in the Top 7 in the country in scoring offense (Kansas-2, Oklahoma-3, Texas Tech-6, Missouri - 7).

⇒ Through 11 weeks of the season, the following national statistic leaders reside in the Big 12:

Team: passing offense - Texas Tech (480.6); total offense - Texas Tech (542.8); kickoff returns - Kansas (30.2); punt returns - Kansas State (22.1); pass efficiency - Oklahoma (180.0); turnover margin - Kansas (2.0).

Individual: pass efficiency - Sam Bradford, Oklahoma (180.4); total offense - Graham Harrell, Texas Tech (436.6); receptions per game - Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech (10.27); receiving yards per game - Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech (155.2).

For the third time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game will be held in San Antonio. The 2007 game takes place on Saturday, December 1, at the Alamodome. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged in the Alamodome were in 1997 (64,824) and 1999 (65,035).

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 11-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2007), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).



BAYLOR (3-8, 0-7)
This Week: Oklahoma State
Next Week: End of Season

Baylor has forced at least one turnover in 30 of the last 34 games, including 10 of 11 games this season.

Brandon Whitaker became the 28th player in Baylor history to rush for at least 1,000 career yards. He turned in career highs in rushing yardage (149) and all-purpose yardage (217) against Oklahoma.

Blake Szymanski established a single-season Baylor record with 2,618 passing yards. He broke Shawn Bell's previous record of 2,582 yards set last season.

David Gettis moved into second place on Baylor's single-season kickoff return yardage list. He has 733 yards in 2007, eight yards shy of Willie Andrews' 2004 record.



COLORADO (5-6, 3-4)
This Week: Open
Next Week: Nebraska (Nov. 23)

Hugh Charles moved into seventh on the all-time rushing list with 2,490 yards. He also has 3,295 all-purpose yards, good for sixth at CU.

Dusty Sprague became the ninth player in CU history to catch 100 passes, ending Saturday's game with 102 for 1,239 yards. He is 10th in all-time receiving yards.

Colorado has scored in 233 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak in the NCAA and a tie with Nebraska for the ninth-longest all-time. The Buffs have scored in 149 consecutive league games.

Jordon Dizon remains fifth in the nation and first in the Big 12 in tackles with 11.9 a game. He has 93 solo stops and 38 assisted tackles.



IOWA STATE (3-8, 2-5)
This Week: at Kansas
Next Week: End of Season

Bret Meyer has 9,396 passing yards and 10,210 total yards, both second in Big 12 career records. His 50 touchdown passes are 10th in Big 12 history.

Todd Blythe upped his career receiving yards to 3,076, passing Carlos Francis (3,007) and Wes Welker (3,069) to tie for fourth in Big 12 career annals. His 31 career TD catches are tied for third in Big 12 history.

In Saturday's win over Colorado, ISU had a 100-yard rusher and a 100-yard receiver (Stevie Hicks, 122 rushing; Todd Blythe, 214 receiving) for the first time since Oct. 29, 2005 (at Texas A&M).

Six of ISU's last seven wins, all at home, have been decided on the final play of the game (2006: Toledo, UNLV, UNI, Missouri; 2007: Iowa, Colorado).



KANSAS (10-0, 6-0)
This Week: Iowa State
Next Week: Missouri (Kansas City)

The Jayhawks are 10-0 for the first time since the 1899 team finished the season 10-0. KU and Hawaii are the only two undefeated teams in the nation.

Kansas is second in the country in scoring defense (14.9) and 12th in total defense (306.6). On the offensive side of the ball, the Jayhawks continue to rank second in scoring offense (45.9).

KU leads the nation in turnover margin at +20, the only Big 12 team with a double-digit positive margin.

The Jayhawks have trailed for 27 minutes and 15 seconds out of a possible 600 minutes through 10 games.



KANSAS STATE (5-5, 3-4)
This Week: Missouri
Next Week: at Fresno State

Jordy Nelson is second nationally in receptions (9.9) and receiving yards (134.7) per game, trailing Michael Crabtree of Texas Tech.

Nelson moved up on three of K-State's all-time receiving lists to second in career receptions with 183, second on the career yardage list with 2,563 and is now tied for third on the career touchdown receptions list with 18.

Josh Freeman improved his career passing yardage to 4,621, moving past Michael Bishop for sixth and is just 21 yards away from tying Jonathan Beasley (1996-97, 99-00; 4,642) for fifth.

Tim Reyer boomed six punts for a 42-yard average, which included a long of 56 at Nebraska. He also dropped two of his punts inside the Husker 20-yard line. This season, Reyer has an average of 42 yards, and 18 of his punts downed inside the 20-yard line.



MISSOURI (9-1, 5-1)
This Week: at Kansas State
Next Week: Kansas (Kansas City)

Mizzou jumped three places to fourth nationally in total offense (514.2 ypg), and is fifth in passing offense (339.0 ypg) and seventh in scoring offense (41.8 ppg).

Chase Daniel is second in the Big 12 and fourth nationally, averaging 355.4 yards of total offense.

The Mizzou defense has forced a turnover in 16 consecutive games.

The 2007 Tigers are the fourth team in school history to top nine victories, and the first since 1969.

Chase Coffman has 152 career receptions, ranking him third all-time behind teammate Martin Rucker (185) and NFL receiver Justin Gage (200).



NEBRASKA (5-6, 2-5)

This Week: Open

Next Week: at Colorado (Nov. 23)

Joe Ganz' 510 passing yards set a school record, bettering the 438 yards by Sam Keller earlier this season against Ball State. Ganz threw for 405 yards last week at Kansas, marking the first time in school history a player has posted back-to-back 400-yard passing efforts.

Ganz' seven touchdown passes also set a Nebraska school record, bettering the previous mark of five.

The Huskers amassed 702 yards of total offense in Saturday's win over K-State, the most since totaling 776 against Iowa State in 1995.

Cornerback Cortney Grixby returned a kickoff 94 yards for a touchdown, giving Nebraska its first kickoff return for a touchdown since the 1998 season opener against Louisiana Tech.



OKLAHOMA (9-1, 5-1)

This Week: at Texas Tech

Next Week: Oklahoma State

With 11 tackles against Baylor, junior LB Curtis Lofton tied the OU single season record for games with double-digit tackles (7). Lofton is seventh in the country and second in the Big 12 with 11.2 tackles a game.

Freshman RB DeMarco Murray has 15 touchdowns on the season to tie the OU freshman record set by Adrian Peterson in 2004.

Redshirt freshman QB Sam Bradford moved up to first nationally in passing efficiency at 180.4 while leading OU to third nationally in scoring offense at 45.0.

WR Manuel Johnson had a career-high 126 yards and two touchdowns on four catches vs. Baylor.



OKLAHOMA STATE (5-5, 3-3)

This Week: at Baylor

Next Week: at Oklahoma

With 276 passing yards vs. Kansas, Zac Robinson increased his season total to 2,215, to become the fourth quarterback in OSU history to pass for 2,000 yards in a single season.

Dantrell Savage rushed for 106 yards Saturday against Kansas, his seventh consecutive 100-yard rushing game since returning from injury. Savage rushed for more yards than any back who has faced the Jayhawks this year.

Freshman receiver Dez Bryant established an Oklahoma State freshman record with 155 yards receiving Saturday.

OSU leads the Big 12 and is eighth nationally in rushing offense at 241.2. Savage is second in the league and 13th in the country with 119.4 rushing yards.



TEXAS (9-2, 5-2)

This Week: Open

Next Week: at Texas A&M (Nov. 23)

Colt McCoy recorded 319 yards of total offense and accounted for six touchdowns in Texas' win over Texas Tech. The six TDs accounted for match the most by any Longhorn player since Clyde Littlefield set the UT record with seven in 1915.

Texas held an opponent to 10 yards or less rushing for the third time in 2007 (Rice - -11), Baylor - 8, Texas Tech - 10).

Texas became the only NCAA Division I Bowl Subdivision team to win at least nine games in each of the last 10 seasons. Mack Brown is the only active NCAA Division I Bowl Subdivision head coach that has won at least nine games in each of the last 12 seasons.

For the first time in school history, the Longhorns boast three players with 40 or more receptions (Nate Jones 61, Quan Cosby 58 & Jermichael Finley 40).



TEXAS A&M (6-5, 3-4)

This Week: Open

Next Week: Texas (Nov. 23)

Jorvorskie Lane became A&M's all-time leading scorer among non-placekickers with a touchdown at Missouri. The six-pointer brought Lane's three-year, 34-game total to 272 points.

Lane also matched the school record for career rushing touchdowns and total touchdowns with 44 (Darren Lewis, 1987-90) and 45 (Lewis and Rodney Thomas, 1991-94), respectively.

Tight end Martellus Bennett became the first Aggie with multiple touchdown catches in a game since he did it against Baylor last season. Bennett also extended his school record for consecutive games with at least one catch to 28.

The Aggies are second in the Big 12 and 14th nationally in rushing offense with 219.6 yards.



TEXAS TECH (7-4, 3-4)

This Week: Oklahoma

Next Week: End of Regular Season

Redshirt freshman Michael Crabtree leads the country in receptions (10.3) and receiving yards (155.2), and is fourth in scoring (10.9 ppg).

Tech leads the nation in passing offense (480.6) and total offense (542.8) and is sixth in scoring offense (42.5).

Graham Harrell is the NCAA leader in total offense with 436.6 yards a game and is third in pass efficiency at 165.8.

Alex Trlica added to his NCAA record with 225 consecutive point-after-attempts. Trlica kicked his 44th and 45th career field goals last week to set the school record.

Freshman DT Colby Whitlock had a team-high 10 tackles vs. UT,, including four stops for loss.
