⇒ Hotel and credential information for media planning to cover the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship game in San Antonio is available at www.Big12Sports.com. Click on the "Media Center" tab at the top of the home page, followed by the "Postseason Credentials" heading to register. The hotel and application deadline is MONDAY, NOV. 26.

⇒ Three Big 12 teams rank in the NCAA's Top 5 for schedule strength led by Oklahoma State with the nation's toughest schedule and followed by Texas A&M-3 and Nebraska-5.

⇒ The Big 12 leads all conferences with seven teams ranked in the NCAA top 20 for total offense: Texas Tech-2, Missouri-4, Oklahoma State-6, Kansas-7, Texas-12, Nebraska-16 and Oklahoma-17. The WAC is second with three teams.

⇒ The Big 12 is home to three of the nation's top four receptions per game leaders (Michael Crabtree-Texas Tech; Jordy Nelson-Kansas State; Danny Amendola-Texas Tech), the top two in receiving yards (Michael Crabtree-Texas Tech; Jordy Nelson-Kansas State), and two of the top four in total offense (Graham Harrell-Texas Tech; Chase Daniel-Missouri).

⇒ Four Big 12 teams rank in the Top 7 in the country in scoring offense (Kansas-2, Oklahoma-3, Texas Tech-6, Missouri - 7), and six in the Top 20 (Texas-15, Kansas State-17).

⇒ Through 12 weeks of the season, the following national statistic leaders reside in the Big 12:

Team: passing offense - Texas Tech (475.6); kickoff returns - Kansas (29.6); punt returns - Kansas State (22.5); turnover margin - Kansas (1.91).

Individual: pass efficiency - Sam Bradford, Oklahoma (179.4); total offense - Graham Harrell, Texas Tech (436.2); receptions per game - Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech (10.42); receiving yards per game - Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech (155.1).

12th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

For the third time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game will be held in San Antonio. The 2007 game takes place on Saturday, December 1, at the Alamodome. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged in the Alamodome were in 1997 (64,824) and 1999 (65,035).

General public tickets are priced at \$99, \$79, \$69, \$59, \$39, plus fees. Tickets are available through Ticketmaster outlets, ticketmaster.com or (800) 676-5488 in addition to in-person at the Alamodome South East Box Office or by phone (210) 224-9600.

Tiebreak

The winner of the Kansas/Missouri game will represent the North Division in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship.

In the South Division, Oklahoma advances if it beats Oklahoma State. Texas can reach the championship game with a win over Texas A&M coupled with an OU loss.

If OSU beats OU and Texas loses to Texas A&M, all three are 5-3 in the conference. The first tiebreak is head-to-head, and OU, OSU and UT are 1-1 against each other. The second tiebreak is record against teams from within the division with all three posting identical 3-2 records against South Division foes.

The next tiebreak would be the teams' records against the fourth-place team in the division, where Texas Tech and Texas A&M would be tied at 4-4 and 3-2 in the division.

OU, UT and OSU are all 1-1 against Tech and A&M. Baylor occupies the next and final place in the South Division standings and all three teams beat Baylor.

The next tiebreak is common opponents from the other division. Since OU, OSU and UT have no common opponents from the North, the next step in the Big 12 tiebreak procedure is to break the tie using the BCS Standings. The South Division representative would be the highest ranked team in the BCS Standings following completion of the regular-season (for the 2007 season this would be the November 25 BCS Standings).

Big 12 Bowl Partner

Again this season, the Big 12 has eight bowl slots guaranteed. The Conference is partnered with nine bowls, with the the Gator Bowl and Sun Bowl taking a Big 12 team twice over a four-year period beginning with the 2006 season. In the two years in which the Gator does not select a Big 12 team, the Sun Bowl will. Following is the selection order:

Big 12 Media Preseason Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in four of the last five seasons (OU/NU-06; UT/CU-05; OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Last year the media accurately predicted Oklahoma to win the South and Nebraska to capture the North. Overall the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 13-of-22 times. Following are this season's projections.

BAYLOR (3-9, 0-8)
End of Season

Baylor has forced at least one turnover in 30 of the last 35 games, including 10 of 12 games in 2007.

Five Baylor players recorded at least 30 receptions each in 2007 for the first time in school history. The five 30-catch receivers were Justin Akers, David Gettis, Brad Taylor, Brandon Whitaker and Thomas White.

FS Jordan Lake recorded six double-digit tackle games in 2007. He had 120 tackles, the most by a Baylor player since Maurice Lane had 129 in 2003.

QB Blake Szymanski established a Baylor single-season record for touchdowns responsibility with 23 (22 passing, 1 rushing).



COLORADO (5-6, 3-4)
This Week: Nebraska (Nov. 23)
End of Regular Season

Hugh Charles ranks seventh on Colorado's all-time rushing list with 2,490 yards. He also has 3,295 all-purpose yards, good for sixth at CU.

Dusty Sprague became the ninth player in CU history to catch 100 passes, ending the ISU game with 102 for 1,239 yards. He ranks 10th in all-time receiving yards.

Colorado has scored in 233 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak in the NCAA and a tie with Nebraska for the ninth-longest all-time. The Buffs have scored in 149 consecutive league games.

Jordon Dizon moved back up to third in the nation and first in the Big 12 in tackles with 11.9 a game. He has 93 solo stops and 38 assisted tackles.



IOWA STATE (3-9, 2-6)
End of Season

Bret Meyer ends his career ranked third all-time on the Big 12 career charts in total offense (10,422), total plays (1,923) and passing yards (9,499).

Wide receiver Todd Blythe finishes his career with three of the 10 top single season totals in school history. Blythe's 31 career TD catches ties for third in Big 12 history. Blythe completed his career with 176 catches for 3,096 yards, both school records.

Bret Culbertson closed his career 100-for-100 in PATs and became the second player in ISU history with 100 career PATs. Culbertson's 214 career points ties for fifth all-time at Iowa State.

R.J. Sumrall moved into ninth place on the Iowa State career chart with 99 receptions.



KANSAS (11-0, 7-0)
This Week: Missouri (Kansas City)
Next: Big 12 Championship or Bowl

Kansas has won 11 games and is 11-0 in a season for the first time in school history.

KU's defense has held its opponent to under 100 yards rushing in 10 games this season and is second nationally in scoring, allowing 14.2 points a game.

Sophomore QB Todd Reesing set the Kansas single-season completion record, currently at 228. Reesing has 2,910 passing yards in 2007 and is 85 shy of the school record of 2,995 by Mike Norseth in 1985.

Reesing has 205 consecutive pass attempts without an interception and is tied for second in the NCAA in touchdowns with 30 with MU's Chase Daniel and Kentucky's Andre Woodson. He's thrown four interceptions in 2007.



KANSAS STATE (5-6, 3-5)
This Week: at Fresno State
End of Regular Season

Jordy Nelson is second nationally in receptions (9.7) and receiving yards (131.0) per game, trailing Michael Crabtree of Texas Tech.

With 1,441 receiving yards in 2007, Nelson set the Big 12 record for yardage by a senior.

Josh Freeman is the single-season record holder for passing yards with 3,097 and is the only quarterback in school history to throw for 3,000 yards in a season. Freeman is fifth in career passing yardage with 4,877 yards.

Running back James Johnson carded 22 carries for a career-high 172 yards and one touchdown Saturday vs. Missouri. He finished with 224 all-purpose yards (172 rushing, 21 receiving and 31 in return yardage) and became K-State's first 1,000-yard rusher since Darren Sproles had 1,318 yards in the 2004 season.



MISSOURI (10-1, 6-1)
This Week: Kansas (Kansas City)
Next: Big 12 Championship or Bowl

Mizzou has won 10 games (on the field) in the regular season for the first time in school history. The 1960 squad is officially credited with a 10-0 regular season, but one of those wins was due to a forfeit.

Freshman WR Jeremy Maclin set the MU school and Football Bowl Subdivision freshman single-game all-purpose yardage record with 360 all-purpose yards vs. K-State. He had 143 receiving yards and two touchdowns on nine catches, two rushes for eight yards, six kickoff returns for 194 yards and a touchdown, and two punt returns for 15 yards.

Mizzou remained fourth nationally in total offense (506.3 ypg), and is fifth in passing offense (334.0 ypg) and sixth in scoring offense (42.5 ppg).

Chase Daniel is second in the Big 12 and fourth nationally, averaging 349.3 yards of total offense.



NEBRASKA (5-6, 2-5)
This Week: at Colorado (Nov. 23)
End of Regular Season

Joe Ganz' 510 passing yards vs. Kansas State set a school record, bettering the 438 yards by Sam Keller earlier this season against Ball State.

Ganz threw for 405 yards the previous week at Kansas, marking the first time in school history a player has posted back-to-back 400-yard passing efforts.

Ganz' seven touchdown passes also set a Nebraska school record, bettering the previous mark of five.

The Huskers amassed 702 yards of total offense vs. K-State, the most since totaling 776 against Iowa State in 1995.



OKLAHOMA (9-2, 5-2)
This Week: Oklahoma State
Next: Big 12 Championship or Bowl

With 11 tackles at Texas Tech, junior linebacker Curtis Lofton recorded his eighth double-digit tackle game of the season to set a Sooner record.

Redshirt freshman QB Sam Bradford remains first nationally in passing efficiency at 179.4. He missed all but one series of the Texas Tech game due to injury.

Juaquin Iglesias set the OU record for most kick return yards in a season with 551 yards. He had 115 at Texas Tech.

The Sooner defense has five touchdowns this season (3 INT, 2 FR) to tie the OU record with the 1956, 2000 and 2001 squads.



OKLAHOMA STATE (6-5, 4-3)
This Week: at Oklahoma
Next: Bowl Eligible

Senior running back Dantrell Savage rushed for 109 yards at Baylor to go over the 1,000-yard mark for the season. He currently stands at 1,064 rushing yards.

Sophomore quarterback Zac Robinson holds the school's single-season record for total yards with 3,122. The previous record was held by Josh Fields, who compiled 3,073 yards in 2002.

Senior defensive lineman Nathan Peterson had three quarterback sacks Saturday vs. Baylor, moving him into sole possession of fourth place on the school's all-time list with 20.5.

OSU leads the Big 12 and is eighth nationally in rushing offense at 250.5. Savage is second in the league and 17th in the country with 118.2 rushing yards.



TEXAS (9-2, 5-2)
This Week: at Texas A&M (Nov. 23)
Next: Big 12 Championship or Bowl

Colt McCoy recorded 319 yards of total offense and accounted for six touchdowns in Texas' win over Texas Tech. The six TDs accounted for match the most by any Longhorn player since Clyde Littlefield set the UT record with seven in 1915.

Texas had held three opponents to 10 yards or less rushing in 2007 (Rice - [-11], Baylor - 8, Texas Tech - 10).

Texas is the only NCAA Division I Bowl Subdivision team to win at least nine games in each of the last 10 seasons. Mack Brown is the only active NCAA Division I Bowl Subdivision head coach that has won at least nine games in each of the last 12 seasons.

For the first time in school history, the Longhorns boast three players with 40 or more receptions (Nate Jones 61, Quan Cosby 58 & Jermichael Finley 40).



TEXAS A&M (6-5, 3-4)
This Week: Texas (Nov. 23)
Next: Bowl Eligible

Jorvorskie Lane is A&M's all-time leading scorer among non-placekickers after a touchdown at Missouri. The six-pointer brought Lane's three-year, 34-game total to 272 points.

Lane also matched the school record for career rushing touchdowns and total touchdowns with 44 (Darren Lewis, 1987-90) and 45 (Lewis and Rodney Thomas, 1991-94), respectively.

Against MU, tight end Martellus Bennett became the first Aggie with multiple touchdown catches in a game since he did it against Baylor last season. Bennett also extended his school record for consecutive games with at least one catch to 28.

The Aggies are second in the Big 12 and 14th nationally in rushing offense with 219.6 yards.



TEXAS TECH (8-4, 4-4)
Next: Bowl Game

Redshirt freshman Michael Crabtree leads the country in receptions (10.4) and receiving yards (155.1), and is sixth in scoring (10.5 ppg).

Tech's win over third-ranked Oklahoma matches the highest ranked opponent that Tech has defeated in school history. The Raiders beat No. 3-ranked Texas in 2002.

Graham Harrell became the second quarterback in Tech history to throw for 5,000-plus yards in a single season as he now has 5,298. Only six quarterbacks in NCAA history have reached the 5,000 yard mark in a single season.

Alex Trlica set the NCAA career record for extra points made with 227. Trlica also holds the NCAA mark for career extra points without a miss.
