- - BIG 12 BOWL NOTEBOOK - -

Bowling

The 2007 season marked the sixth time in the last seven seasons the Big 12 has sent eight teams to bowl games. However with two teams in the BCS, the Big 12 did not fill the Texas Bowl, its eighth and final slot.

From 2000-07, Big 12 teams will have participated in 62 bowl games. For the fourth consecutive year, five teams from one division are bowl-eligible. For the second year in a row, five teams from the South Division will go bowling, preceded by five from the North in 2005 and five from the South in 2004.

All-America

Ten Big 12 players - Anthony Collins, Kansas; Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech; Jordon Dizon, Colorado; Tony Hills, Texas; Curtis Lofton, Oklahoma, Jeremy Maclin, Missouri; Jordy Nelson, Kansas State; Martin Rucker, Missouri; Duke Robinson, Oklahoma; Aqib Talib, Kansas - garnered first team All-America honors in 2007 from at least one of the five organizations used in the consensus chart (American Football Coaches Association, Associated Press, Football Writers Association of America, The Sporting News, and Walter Camp Foundation).

Consensus

An all-time high eight Big 12 players earned Consensus All-America recognition - Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech; Jordon Dizon, Colorado; Curtis Lofton, Oklahoma; Jeremy Maclin, Missouri; Jordy Nelson, Kansas State; Martin Rucker, Missouri; Duke Robinson, Oklahoma and Aqib Talib, Kansas. The previous high-water mark was 2003 when six Conference players gained Consensus All-America.

Attendance

For the second consecutive year total attendance in the Big 12 surpassed 4.6 million fans. This season, 4,652,267 people attended league stadiums. In the past two years an all-time high 9,333,306 have passed through the turnstiles of Big 12 stadiums, the highest two-year mark in league history.

Stadiums in the Big 12 were filled to 96.6 percent of capacity this season, the ninth straight year over 90 percent.

Average attendance in 2007 was 60,419, the highest in league history and first time to average over 60,000.

Big 12 BCS Success

From 2000-05 teams from the Big 12 played in the BCS National Championship Game five times during the six-year span. Since the inception of the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship Game. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

National Title Appearances

The Big 12 leads all conferences with five appearances in the BCS National Championship Game.

BCS Sightings

This marks the fourth time the Big 12 has advanced two teams to BCS games in the same season (2001, '03, '04). Including this season, Big 12 teams have played in 14 BCS games in the 10-year history of the structure, posting a 5-7 mark thus far.

Scoring

Four Big 12 teams rank in the Top 7 in the country in scoring offense (Kansas-2, Oklahoma-3, Texas Tech-6, Missouri-7), and five in the Top 20 (Texas-19).

Getting Offensive

The Big 12 leads all conferences with seven teams ranked in the NCAA Top 20 for total offense (Texas Tech-2, Missouri-5, Kansas-6, Oklahoma State-9, Nebraska-11, Texas-13, Oklahoma-18).

Individually Speaking

The Big 12 is home to three of the nations's Top 5 receptions per game leaders (Michael Crabtree-Texas Tech, Jordy Nelson-Kansas State, Danny Amendola-Texas Tech), the Top 2 in receiving yards (Michael Crabtree-Texas Tech, Jordy Nelson-Kansas State), and two of the Top 4 in total offense (Graham Harrell-Texas Tech, Chase Daniel-Missouri).

Working Overtime

The 2007 season was a low-water mark for overtime games in the Big 12. Last season, an all-time high nine games went to overtime.

12th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

Oklahoma won the 12th annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship 38-17 over Missouri in front of a crowd of 62,585. The game was played for the third time in conference history at San Antonio's Alamodome. The Sooners lead the league with five conference crowns (2007, '06, '04, '02, '00) and six appearances (2007, '06, '04, '03, '02, '00). Oklahoma became the first team in conference history to win back-to-back conference titles. Alltime there have been six different winners of the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Game - Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

Big 12 Media Preseason Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in four of the last six seasons (OU/NU-06; UT/CU-05; OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Overall, including this season, the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 14-of-24 times. End of Season

Art Briles has been named the 25th head football coach in BU history. Briles was 34-28 in five seasons as head coach at Houston.

Five Baylor players recorded at least 30 receptions each in 2007 for the first time in school history. The five 30-catch receivers were Justin Akers, David Gettis, Brad Taylor, Brandon Whitaker and Thomas White.

FS Jordan Lake recorded six double-digit tackle games in 2007. He had 120 tackles, the most by a Baylor player since Maurice Lane had 129 in 2003.

QB Blake Szymanski established a Baylor single-season record for touchdowns with 23 (22 passing, 1 rushing).



COLORADO (6-6, 4-4)
PetroSun Independence Bowl
vs. Alabama

Colorado will make its first appearance in the PetroSun Independence Bowl and play in its 28th bowl game all-time.

CU has scored in 234 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak in the NCAA and the ninth-longest all-time. The Buffs have scored in 150 consecutive league games.

Jordon Dizon is second in the nation and first in the Big 12 in tackles with 12.4 a game.

Cody Hawkins' 424 pass attempts this season set a school record and his 239 completions are the second-most in school history. His 2,693 passing yards are tied for third-most at CU. He has a current streak of 70 pass attempts without an interception.



IOWA STATE (3-9, 2-6)
End of Season

QB Bret Meyer ends his career ranked third all-time on the Big 12 career charts in total offense (10,422), total plays (1,923) and passing yards (9,499).

Wide receiver Todd Blythe finishes his career with three of the 10 top single season receiving yard totals in school history. Blythe's 31 career TD catches ties for third in Big 12 history. Blythe completed his career with 176 catches for 3,096 yards, both school records.

Bret Culbertson closed his career 100-for-100 in PATs and became the second player in ISU history with 100 career PATs. Culbertson's 214 career points ties for fifth all-time at Iowa State.

R.J. Sumrall moved into ninth place on the Iowa State career chart with 99 receptions.



KANSAS (11-1, 7-1)
FedEx Orange Bowl
vs. Virginia Tech

Kansas will make its first appearance in a BCS bowl game and travels to the FedEx Orange Bowl for the third time, first since 1969.

KU has 11 wins in a season for the first time in school history and claimed a share of its first Big 12 North Division title.

Todd Reesing set the Kansas single-season record for passing yards, currently at 3,259. Reesing is tied atop the KU career touchdown passes list with 35. He is tied with David Jaynes who had 35 from 1971-73.

The Jayhawks are second nationally in scoring offense (44.3) and fifth in scoring defense (16.0). KU is sixth in total offense (491.1).

Jordy Nelson is second nationally in receptions (10.7) and receiving yards (133.8) per game, trailing Michael Crabtree of Texas Tech.

Nelson concluded his K-State career second in career receptions (206), second in career receiving yards (2,822) and third in touchdown receptions (20).

Josh Freeman finished his sophomore campaign with a K-State single-season record 3,353 yards of total offense. Freeman's 5,133 career passing yards is fourth in school history. He is one of just five KSU quarterbacks to top the 5,000-yard passing mark in a career.

James Johnson rushed for 1,106 yards in 2007, the first Wildcat to run for 1,000 yards since 2004.

K-State has scored in 140 consecutive games.



MISSOURI (11-2, 7-1)
AT&T Cotton Bowl Classic
vs. Arkansas

The Tigers are making their second appearance in the AT&T Cotton Bowl Classic and are playing in a New Year's Day bowl for the 10th time in school history.

Missouri claimed a share of its first Big 12 North division title and made its first appearance in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship.

Chase Daniel broke his own school record for total offense in a season with 4,454 yards in 2007. He also extended his own MU records for passing yards (4,170) and touchdown passes (33) in a season.

Daniel is second in the Big 12 and fourth nationally, averaging 342.6 yards of total offense.

Mizzou is fifth nationally in total offense (492.7 ypg), seventh in passing offense (327.8 ypg) and seventh in scoring offense (40.0 ppg).



NEBRASKA (5-7, 2-6)
End of Season

Bo Pelini was named NU's 28th head football coach. He previously served as the Huskers' defensive coordinator in 2003 before stops at Oklahoma and LSU.

In his three career starts, QB Joe Ganz produced three of the top five single-game passing efforts in school history and three of the four 400-yard passing games in school annals.

WR Maurice Purify had four 100-yard receiving games in 2007, tying the NU season record (Johnny Rodgers in 1971 and 1972).

Junior I-back Marlon Lucky became the first player in Nebraska history to surpass 1,000 career rushing (1,876) and receiving (1,091) yards.



OKLAHOMA (11-2, 6-2)
Tostitos Fiesta Bowl
vs. *West Virginia*

Oklahoma won its fifth league title in six appearances in 2007, both Big 12 records. The Sooners are also the first team to win consecutive Big 12 titles.

OU is making its sixth BCS bowl appearance in the last eight years and second straight trip to the Tostitos Fiesta Bowl.

Sam Bradford established an NCAA freshman record for touchdown passes with 34. Bradford remains first nationally in passing efficiency at 180.5.

Oklahoma leads the nation with its 30th 10-win season. Alabama is second with 28.



OKLAHOMA STATE (6-6, 4-4)
Insight Bowl
vs. *Indiana*

OSU will make its fifth bowl appearance in six years and play in the Insight Bowl for the first time. The Cowboys' only other appearance in an Arizona bowl was the 1974 Fiesta Bowl.

Dantrell Savage topped the 100-yard rushing mark in his last nine consecutive games. His 1,172 yards is the 12th-best single-season total in OSU history.

Zac Robinson has set an OSU single-season record with 3,299 yards of offense this season. Also, he currently ranks second on the single-season passing list with 2,522 yards.

Jacob Lacey's five interceptions in 2007 are the most by an OSU player since Darrent Williams recorded six during the 2003 season.



TEXAS (9-3, 5-3)
Pacific Life Holiday Bowl
vs. *Arizona State*

Texas is making its fourth appearance in the Pacific Life Holiday Bowl and will play Arizona State for the first time in program history.

The Longhorns are playing in a bowl game for a UT-record 10th straight season. UT has won five of its last six bowl games and has a 6-3 record in bowl contests under Mack Brown.

Jamaal Charles is fifth on UT's single-season rushing list with 1,458 yards. Charles has rushed for 3,167 yards during his career and moved past Vince Young (3,127, 2003-05) into fifth place on UT's all-time list.

Colt McCoy is the fourth QB in Texas history to throw for 3,000 yards in a season (3,129). He now stands in third place on UT's single-season passing list after moving past Vince Young (3,036, 2005).



TEXAS A&M (7-5, 4-4)
Valero Alamo Bowl
vs. *Penn State*

Mike Sherman has been named head football coach at Texas A&M after serving on the staff of the Houston Texans since 2006. In his previous two stints at Texas A&M (1989-93, 1995-96) he was a part of three conference championships.

A&M is competing in the Valero Alamo Bowl for the third time, and first since 1999. Gary Darnell will serve as interim coach for the bowl.

Texas A&M is second in the Big 12 and 13th nationally in rushing yards with 215.6 a game.

Junior Martellus Bennett set the school record for career receiving yards by an Aggie tight end. He has 1,200 yards on 101 career catches. The 101 career catches are four behind the TE school record of 105. Bennett is the seventh Aggie in school history to surpass the 100-catch plateau.



TEXAS TECH (8-4, 4-4)
Konica Minolta Gator Bowl
vs. *Virginia*

TTU's bowl appearance will be the 31st in program history and eighth straight. The Red Raiders make their fourth appearance in the Gator Bowl.

Alex Trlica set the NCAA career record for extra points made with 227. He holds the NCAA mark for career extra points without a miss, as he has made every attempt during his career.

Redshirt freshman Michael Crabtree leads the country in receptions (10.4) and receiving yards (155.1), and is sixth in scoring (10.5 ppg).

Graham Harrell became the second quarterback in Tech history to throw for 5,000-plus yards in a single season, as he now has 5,298. Only six quarterbacks in NCAA history have reached the 5,000-yard mark in a single season.
