### BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- The Big 12 enters Week 2 with all teams back in action for non-conference competition. The Conference's 11-1 record in Week 1 was a Big 12-best for opening week games. The previous two seasons the league began play at 10-2. The 11-1 mark also led all FBS leagues in Week 1.
- Nine games will be televised this week including the Top 25 matchup of No. 18/17 Florida State at No. 10/10 Oklahoma. Iowa State and Kansas also face ranked opponents this week. ISU travels to No. 9/9 Iowa while KU hosts No. 15/17 Georgia Tech.
- In addition to ISU, Colorado and Texas Tech are traveling this week in the Big 12's first three "true" road games. Two games were at neutral sites last week while Texas played Rice at Houston's Reliant Stadium.
- For just the second time in Big 12 history, three running backs gained 200-plus yards on the same day. Oklahoma State's Kendall Hunter (257 yards), Kansas State's Daniel Thomas (234) and Oklahoma's DeMarco Murray (208) all broke the 200-yard barrier in Sept. 4 games.  
  
The only other time came on Oct. 24, 1998 by Kansas' David Winbush (268), Texas' Ricky Williams (259) and Oklahoma's De'Mond Parker (220).  
  
There have been 13 instances when the Big 12 had two 200-yard rushers on the same day.
- Big 12 teams outscored opponents last week 404 (33.7) to 159 (13.3).
- Oklahoma State's 65 points ranked as tied for fifth for the highest scoring output in Big 12 season openers. The top five includes:

- Texas (4/5), Nebraska (7/6) and Oklahoma (10/10) remain ranked this week while Kansas State, Missouri, Oklahoma State, Texas A&M and Texas Tech received votes.
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to Offense: Danielle Thomas (KSU) and Kendall Hunter (OSU); Defense: Aldon Smith (MU) and Keenan Robinson (UT); and Special Teams: Anthony Cantele (KSU) and Tress Way (OU).
- Aldon Smith (Missouri) was named the Walter Camp Foundation National Defensive Player of the Week.

### 15th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship returns to Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas for the second consecutive year. The 2010 game takes place on Saturday, December 4, at 7:00 p.m. CT and will be nationally televised by ABC.

In 2010, the South representative will be the home team. Ticket information will be available at a later date.

### Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 14-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005, 2009), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

### BCS Sightings

The 2009 season marked the Conference's 17th BCS game in the 12-year history of the structure. The Big 12 is 7-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08).

### Television Partners

ABC begins its 15th season as the Conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2010 to ESPN.

### Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

### Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma has improved its nation-leading home win streak to 31 games. Texas is tied for third with 15 consecutive home victories.

### 2010 NFL Draft

This past April the Big 12 became the first conference since 1946 to be home to the first four selections in the NFL draft.

Big 12 players accounted for five of the first six picks in the 2010 NFL draft; six of the top 14; and nine overall in the first-round, all coming in the first 24 selections.

### Big 12 Bowl Partners

The Big 12 will have a new bowl lineup in 2010 with the New Era Pinstripe, Dallas Football Classic and Eagle Bank bowls joining the BCS/Fiesta, AT&T Cotton, Valero Alamo, Insight, Bridgepoint Holiday and Texas bowls.

With the new lineup, the Big 12 will be the only league that is matched up against BCS automatic qualifier opponents in each of its bowl games.

**BAYLOR (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Buffalo

**Next Week:** at TCU

Quarterback Robert Griffin III recorded three touchdowns and 301 of BU's 463 offensive yards vs. Sam Houston State. The sophomore has accounted for three or more TDs in eight of his 16 career games.

The Bears look to start the season 2-0 for the first time since 2005 after snapping a three-game home losing streak with their season-opening win against SHSU.

Kendall Wright, who has a catch in each game of his 25 career contests, is 112 yards shy of becoming the eighth player in school history with 1,500 receiving yards.

Since 2001, Baylor is 23-2 (.920) when scoring at least 30 points. Baylor has won 12 consecutive games when reaching the 30-point plateau.



**COLORADO (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at California

**Next Week:** Hawaii

The last meeting between the Buffs and Bears was 28 years ago to the day, a Cal win on Sept. 11, 1982. CU looks to snap a 13-game road losing streak.

Senior WR Scotty McKnight became Colorado's career receptions leader when he caught a 27-yard touchdown pass against Colorado State last week. The TD reception gave him 168 career catches.

Travon Patterson, a transfer from USC, returned four punts for 46 yards against the Rams, including a 25-yard return. The Buffs were last in the Big 12 last season, averaging 3.3 yards per punt return.

The CU defense has recorded a sack in 20 straight games. The Buffs held Colorado State to just 49 rush yards in the season opener.



**IOWA STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at Iowa

**Next Week:** vs. Kansas State (Kansas City)

Iowa and Iowa State will meet up for the 58th time with the Hawkeyes leading the all-time series with a 38-19 mark. The Cyclones have won seven of the last 12 meetings, but fell in last season's contest with six turnovers.

Iowa is the second of eight 2009 bowl teams on the Cyclones' schedule. ISU's 2010 opponents were a combined 97-56 (.634) last season, ranking its schedule third among 120 Division I schools.

In his first career start, sophomore A.J. Klein had 15 tackles to lead ISU last week over Northern Illinois. The linebacker recorded just 17 stops all of last season.

QB Austen Arnaud is second in Cyclone history with 5,339 career passing yards, 6,364 yards in total offense and 472 completions.



**KANSAS (0-1, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Georgia Tech

**Next Week:** at Southern Mississippi

Kansas and Georgia Tech will be meeting for just the second time in history. The only other contest came in the 1948 Orange Bowl, which Georgia Tech won 20-14 in KU's first bowl game.

Georgia Tech is the first non-conference ranked opponent to play at KU since 2001. The Jayhawks have not started the season 0-2 since 2002, but have lost their last three home games.

DE Jake Laptad (16.5 sacks) needs just half a sack to move into KU's top 5 sack leaders.

The six points allowed by the Jayhawks in their 6-3 loss to NDSU were the fewest allowed in a KU loss since Sept. 22, 1962. The last time Kansas scored just three points in a game was Oct. 15, 2005.



**KANSAS STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Missouri State

**Next Week:** vs. Iowa State (Kansas City)

The Wildcats rushed for 313 yards in their season-opener against UCLA, the most in a game since 2004. Daniel Thomas accounted for 234 of those, a career-high rushing mark, and the fifth-most ever by a KSU running back.

Thomas was named Big 12 Co-Offensive Player of the Week while PK Anthony Cantele was named Co-Special Teams Player of the Week.

This marks the second meeting between KSU and Missouri State after the Wildcats defeated the Bears 61-10 in 2007.

The KSU defense limited UCLA to just 9-of-26 on passing attempts and forced three turnovers. DE Brandon Harold recorded five tackles, one sack, a forced fumble and a pass breakup.

Kansas State is 55-3 (.948) in its last 58 non-conference games at home.



**MISSOURI (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** McNeese State

**Next Week:** San Diego State

Aldon Smith was named the Walter Camp Foundation National Defensive Player of the Week and Big 12 Co-Player of the Week. The sophomore defensive end recorded a team-high 10 tackles, including three for losses, in the Tigers' come-from-behind win over Illinois. He also had two sacks and a quarterback hurry.

MU's second half comeback over Illinois marked only the second time the Tigers have trailed at half and shutout their opponent in the second half to win. Missouri completed the feat in 1978 against Ohio State.

The Tigers have won 18 straight non-conference games and haven't lost a regular-season non-conference game since 2005.

Quarterback Blaine Gabbert threw for 281 yards against Illinois, his sixth consecutive 200-yard passing contest and 10th of his career. Gabbert connected with WR T.J. Moe, who recorded 101 yards on 13 receptions.



**NEBRASKA (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Idaho

**Next Week:** at Washington

Nebraska's 49-10 victory over Western Kentucky last weekend marked its 25th straight win in a season opener, a nation-leading streak. Nebraska has won each of the games by at least 10 or more points.

Freshman quarterback Taylor Martinez rushed for 127 yards against Western Kentucky. The last freshman quarterback to rush for more than 100 yards in a game was Eric Crouch, who went on to win the Heisman Trophy in 2001.

This week marks the second straight first-time opponent for the Huskers. This is also Nebraska's first opponent from the state of Idaho.

Nebraska is meeting a Western Athletic Conference opponent for the third time under Bo Pelini, as the Huskers defeated both San Jose State and New Mexico State in 2008.



**OKLAHOMA (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Florida State

**Next Week:** Air Force

Oklahoma and Florida State last met at the Orange Bowl in 2001, where the two teams competed for the national championship. OU defeated FSU, 13-2, in Bob Stoops' second season with the Sooners.

With two touchdowns last weekend, DeMarco Murray moved up to eighth on the Big 12 career records list with 47. He also rushed for 218 yards, which set a school record for a home opener.

Last weekend, sophomore punter Tress Way averaged 46.6 yards on eight kicks with three downed inside the 20. His 85-yard punt was the longest in Big 12 history and third-longest in school history. He was named Big 12 Co-Special Teams Player of the Week.

Oklahoma became the seventh college program to reach 800 victories.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Troy

**Next Week:** Tulsa

OSU is looking to start a season 2-0 for the fourth time in six years under Mike Gundy. Since 1983, the Cowboys have had 13 seasons open with two straight victories.

Oklahoma State is now 16-4 in regular-season non-conference games under Mike Gundy and 8-1 in those games since 2008. OSU is 24-4 in its last 28 non-league games since the 2002 season.

Oklahoma State and Troy have played twice before. The Cowboys lost 41-23 at Troy in 2007, but defeated the Trojans in 2008 with a 55-24 victory.

In two games against Troy, Kendall Hunter has rushed for 294 yards on 40 carries with two touchdowns. Hunter came off the bench in 2007 against Troy, where he ran for 168 yards on 24 carries. He was named Big 12 Co-Offensive Player of the Week for his work vs. Washington State.



**TEXAS (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Wyoming

**Next Week:** at Texas Tech

Texas and Wyoming meet for just the fourth time in history, with UT leading the series 3-0. The series began in 1974 with a 34-7 Texas win. UT defeated the Cowboys last season, 41-10.

Linebacker Keenan Robinson was selected Big 12 Co-Defensive Player of the Week and the College Football Performance Awards FBS National Linebacker Performer of the Week. In Texas' win over Rice, Robinson recorded six tackles, one tackle for loss, one interception and one fumble recovery that was returned for a touchdown.

Freshman defensive end Jackson Jeffcoat notched three tackles in his first career game and shared a sack with Emmanuel Acho. Texas ranks third in the Big 12 in total defense after week one.

Quarterback Garret Gilbert went 14-of-23 in passing and did not throw an interception, which marks only the second time in the last six opening games that the Longhorns' offense didn't commit a turnover.



**TEXAS A&M (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Louisiana Tech

**Next Week:** Florida International

Last weekend against Stephen F. Austin, quarterback Jerrod Johnson passed for 322 yards, the ninth 300-yard passing game of his career. He was responsible for three touchdowns, including one by rush.

Wide receiver Jeff Fuller has 18 career touchdown receptions. His total is only one shy of Bob Long's career record of 19, set from 1966-68.

Wide receiver Ryan Tannehill produced one catch for nine yards. It extended his consecutive-game streak with a reception to 25 games, which is four behind the school record of 29 set by Martellus Bennett.

Due to Von Miller's sprained ankle, linebacker Demontre Moore saw early action with five tackles and the Aggies' lone sack in his debut.



**TEXAS TECH (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at New Mexico

**Next Week:** Texas

Saturday's match-up will mark the 42nd all-time meeting between Texas Tech and New Mexico with TTU leading the series 33-6-2. The series is the seventh most played in school history for the Red Raiders.

Tech's defense had five sacks against SMU, including a game-decisive sack by Brian Duncan of SMU backup quarterback J.J. McDermott. Duncan had three sacks in the game.

The TTU defense also produced three interceptions and forced three three-and-outs on SMU's first five possessions.

Texas Tech ranks first in the Big 12 in passing offense after week one. Taylor Potts completed 34-of-53 and had four touchdowns.
