BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- The first two conference games of the season highlight Week 3 competition. On Saturday, Iowa State meets up with Kansas State in Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium for an 11:00 a.m. CT FSN telecast. No. 4/6 Texas travels to Texas Tech for a 7:00 p.m. CT ABC broadcast.
 - UT and TTU also kicked off the Big 12 season last year in Week 3 on Sept. 19. This week's Sept. 18 date is the earliest for a conference game since Nebraska hosted Oklahoma State on Aug. 30, 2003.
 - The other eight Big 12 squads continue with non-conference play, beginning with Kansas' visit to Southern Mississippi on Friday. No. 8/8 Nebraska is also on the road at Washington while Baylor travels to No. 5/4 TCU. Eight of 10 contests are slated for TV coverage.
 - Big 12 teams are 21-3 (.875) through the first two weeks of non-league play - the best non-conference win percentage in the FBS.
 - Big 12 teams scored 52 touchdowns from scrimmage in last Saturday's games. Those scoring plays averaged 23.1 yards. There were 28 scoring runs that averaged 16.1 yards and 24 touchdown passes that averaged 31.2 yards.
 - Four Big 12 players registered touchdowns on long returns last week:
 - Josh Cooper, Oklahoma State 66-yard punt return
 - Dustin Harris, Texas A&M 54-yard punt return
 - DeJon Gomes, Nebraska 40-yard interception return
 - Rickey Thenarse, 47-yard interception return
- These five players had big returns that didn't result in touchdowns:
- William Powell, Kansas State 54-yard kickoff return
 - Shontrelle Johnson, Iowa State 62-yard kickoff return
 - Eric Stephens, Texas Tech 93-yard kickoff return
 - Justin Gilbert, Oklahoma State 50-yard punt return
 - Terrance Williams, Baylor 36-yard punt return
- Missouri (25) has joined Texas (4/6), Nebraska (8/8) and Oklahoma (9/7) in the coaches rankings. Kansas State, Oklahoma State, Texas A&M and Texas Tech earned votes in both polls while Baylor received a vote in the AP Poll.
 - Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to Offense: Landry Jones (Oklahoma); Defense: Justin Springer (Kansas) and Special Teams: Eric Stephens (Texas Tech).
 - Oklahoma was named the Tostitos Fiesta Bowl National Team of the Week after beating Florida State.

The Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship returns to Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas for the second consecutive year. The 2010 game takes place on Saturday, December 4, at 7:00 p.m. CT and will be nationally televised by ABC.

In 2010, the South representative will be the home team. Ticket information will be available at a later date.

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 14-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005, 2009), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

BCS Sightings

The 2009 season marked the Conference's 17th BCS game in the 12-year history of the structure. The Big 12 is 7-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08).

Television Partners

ABC begins its 15th season as the Conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2010 to ESPN.

Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma has improved its nation-leading home win streak to 32 games. Texas is tied for fifth with 16 consecutive home victories.

BAYLOR (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: at TCU

Next Week: at Rice

Robert Griffin III had a career-best 297 yards passing vs. Buffalo last week. He scored the 18th rushing touchdown of his career, which ties him with Don Trull for the school record.

The 2-0 start for Baylor is the first since 2005. The Bears have not allowed a TD in their first two games, which last happened in 1960.

TCU has won 15 consecutive-regular season games and has taken the past two meetings over BU. The all-time series is tied 49-49-7.

Baylor's last win over an opponent ranked in the top five was in 1985, a 20-13 road win at No. 3 USC. Its last victory over a ranked team came in 2004, a 35-34 win over No. 16 Texas A&M.



COLORADO (1-1, 0-0)

This Week: Hawai'i

Next Week: Idle

Colorado and Hawai'i will be meeting for the second time in history. The only other contest came on Jan. 1, 1925, a 13-0 Hawai'i win in Honolulu.

WR Scotty McKnight is eight yards shy of 2,000 career yards and has caught a pass in 39 straight games, the longest current streak in the NCAA.

In 51 games under coach Dan Hawkins, the Buffs' defense has been called for only 90 penalties with just two this season.

The Buffs surrendered five turnovers last week against Cal, the most in a game for CU since 2003 vs. Washington State.



IOWA STATE (1-1, 0-0)

This Week: vs. Kansas State (Kansas City)

Next Week: Northern Iowa

Linebacker A.J. Klein had 15 tackles in the opener and led the Cyclones with 11 tackles against Iowa. The sophomore recorded just 17 total stops last year and currently ranks seventh nationally with his average of 13.00 this season.

Freshman Shontrelle Johnson returned the first two kickoffs of his career for 37 yards and 62 yards last week.

The Cyclones lead the all-time series over the Wildcats, 49-40-4, and the two teams have split the past six meetings.

Freshman Kirby Van Der Kamp made his debut as the Cyclones' punter last week. He averaged 40.4 yards on seven punts, including a long of 52 yards.



KANSAS (1-1, 0-0)

This Week: at Southern Mississippi

Next Week: New Mexico State

Kansas looks to stop a four-game road losing streak and improve to 22-3 in its last 25 non-conference games with its first-ever game in the state of Mississippi.

RB James Sims made his collegiate debut against No. 17/15 Georgia Tech and rushed for 101 yards and one touchdown on 17 carries for just the second 100-yard rushing game by a Jayhawk freshman since 2002.

Redshirt freshman QB Jordan Webb threw three touchdown passes and completed 18-of-29 passes for 179 yards in his first Kansas start last week.

Justin Springer recorded a career-high 15 tackles with three for loss and a sack to earn Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week. His 11.0 tackles per game are second in the Big 12 and tied for 20th nationally.



KANSAS STATE (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: vs. Iowa State (Kansas City)

Next Week: vs. Central Florida

The Wildcats have won 16 of the last 20 meetings over the Cyclones. In last year's matchup, Emmanuel Lamur blocked the tying extra-point with 32 seconds remaining as KSU earned a 24-23 victory.

Senior QB Carson Coffman recorded his sixth career start last Saturday and finished 18-of-26 for a career-high 280 yards while setting a career-best with three touchdowns.

Since 1990, the Wildcats are 124-23 when scoring first and 139-5 (.965) when leading at the half.

In two games, Kansas State running backs Daniel Thomas and William Powell have combined to gain 492 yards on 59 carries (8.3 yards per attempt).



MISSOURI (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: San Diego State

Next Week: Miami (Ohio)

Missouri has picked off six passes in two games. In 13 games last year the Tigers had just eight total picks. Including fumbles Missouri's defense is tied for tops in the nation with nine total turnovers and boasts a +6 turnover margin.

QB Blaine Gabbert set the MU school record for completion percentage in a game against McNeese State. He was 26-of-31 for an 83.9 percentage. Gabbert completed his first 15 passes and notched his seventh straight 200-yard passing performance.

Freshman Henry Joesy scored Missouri's first three TDs in his home debut, including a 62-yard score, finishing the day with seven carries for 112 yards. He is the first freshman to gain 100 yards & score three TDs since 1995.

Two of MU's receivers rank in the top 10 nationally for receptions per game, T.J. Moe's 11.50 catches per contest ranks first while Michael Egnew's 8.00 average is tied for ninth.



NEBRASKA (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Washington
Next Week: South Dakota State

NU and Washington meet for the eighth time in history, with the series tied at 3-3-1. Nebraska won the last meeting, 55-7.

QB Taylor Martinez ranks seventh in the nation in rushing with 284 yards on 21 attempts. Washington ranks 62nd nationally in rushing defense.

Nebraska returned two of five interceptions for touchdowns against Idaho. Jared Crick had two of Nebraska's seven sacks.

In two games, sophomore I-back Rex Burhead has 134 yards on 14 carries (9.6 yards per carry) and has caught eight passes for 129 yards (16.1 yards per catch).



OKLAHOMA (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: Air Force
Next Week: at Cincinnati

OU, which ranks third in the Big 12 in rushing defense, will face a unique Air Force triple-option offense this weekend. The Falcons currently lead the country in rushing with 423.0 ypg.

The two teams meet for just the second time in history. OU defeated the Falcons 44-3 on Sept. 1, 2001.

QB Landry Jones earned Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week honors for his performance against FSU. He completed 30-of-40 passes for 380 yards, including 22-of-28 for 321 yards in the first half. Only Sam Bradford (350 vs. North Texas) had a bigger half in program history.

Senior DeMarco Murray joined George "Buster" Rhymes as the second OU player to go over 1,000 yards in three statistical categories. Murray has 2,740 rushing yards, 1,029 receiving yards and 1,251 return yards during his career.



OKLAHOMA STATE (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: Tulsa
Next Week: Idle

OSU running back Kendall Hunter ranks second in the nation in rushing with 414 yards on 49 carries.

In-state rivals OSU and Tulsa have played 70 times with the Cowboys holding a 38-27-5 series advantage. Oklahoma State has played TU more than any other opponent except for Oklahoma.

OSU is trying to start a season 3-0 for the 19th time in school history and for the fourth time in six years under Mike Gundy. The Cowboys 18 previous 3-0 starts have eventually resulted in 16 winning records and 10 teams that eventually appeared in a bowl game.

Two Cowboys lead the nation in scoring, including Hunter and receiver Justin Blackmon, who have six touchdowns each. The OSU duo shares the national scoring lead with Oregon running back Kenjon Barner.



TEXAS (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Texas Tech
Next Week: UCLA

Texas holds a 43-15 lead in the series against Texas Tech. The teams met last year in Austin, where the Longhorns prevailed, 34-24.

Against Wyoming last weekend, Sam Acho made his first career start at defensive tackle. The move proved productive, as Acho made five tackles, including three for loss and a sack, as well as three quarterback hurries.

Last weekend's game was played in front of a crowd of 101,339 at Memorial Stadium, the second-largest crowd in stadium history. The game marked the 60th consecutive home sellout for the Longhorns.

Sophomore quarterback Garrett Gilbert had career highs for passing yards (222), completions (22) and touchdown pass (45 yards) last week.



TEXAS A&M (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: Florida International
Next Week: Idle

QB Jerrod Johnson passed for 349 yards last week, his fourth-straight 300-yard passing game. He also threw four touchdown passes, matching his career high, which he had accomplished three times previously.

A&M gained 565 yards against Louisiana Tech, surpassing the 500-yard barrier for the second consecutive game and 11th time in three seasons under coach Mike Sherman.

TAMU's defense allowed Louisiana Tech's spread offense to convert only 7 of 21 third-down plays. LB Garrick Williams led the team in tackles for a second straight week.

Dustin Harris' 54-yard punt return for a touchdown was the first punt return for a TD by the Aggies since Jason Webster went 55 yards against Oklahoma in 1998 – a span of 13 seasons and 140 games.



TEXAS TECH (2-0, 0-0)

This Week: Texas
Next Week: Idle

Tech's special teams produced two blocked punts that led to touchdowns and a career-best 93-yard kickoff return by Eric Stephens that led to another TD against New Mexico last weekend. Stephens was selected Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week.

Senior quarterback Taylor Potts is looking for his sixth-consecutive game with at least two touchdown passes against Texas this weekend.

Texas Tech piled up 36 carries against New Mexico, the most for TTU since 37 carries in a 56-17 victory over Texas A&M in 2005.

Senior wide receiver Lyle Leong recorded the sixth multiple touchdown game of his career. He had three in the season opener and two against New Mexico.
