BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- Eight Big 12 teams continue non-conference play in Week 4 while four squads - Colorado, Oklahoma State, Texas A&M and Texas Tech have a bye week.
- The Big 12 is 27-5 (.844) in non-conference games, has seven undefeated teams, five teams ranked in the coaches poll and three teams ranked in the top 10 in both polls.
- Oklahoma State (25) has joined Texas (4/7), Nebraska (7/6), Oklahoma (9/8) and Missouri (24) in the coaches rankings. Kansas State, Texas A&M and Texas Tech earned votes.
- There were 38 touchdowns from scrimmage last Saturday - 20 by pass, 18 by run. The 20 pass plays for touchdown averaged 27.6 yards while the 18 runs averaged 18 yards per play.
- Three interceptions were returned for touchdowns last week. Texas Tech's Jarvis Phillips (87 yards against Texas), Nebraska's Alfonzo Dennard (31 yards against Washington) and Iowa State's A.J. Klein (69 yards against Kansas State).
- There were also four other long returns. Oklahoma State's Andrew McGee (79-yard interception return against Tulsa); Texas' Curtis Brown (74-yard interception return against Texas Tech); Kansas' D.J. Beshears (56-yard kickoff return against Southern Miss) and Kansas State's William Powell (45-yard kickoff return against Iowa State).
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to Offense: Brandon Weeden (Oklahoma State); Defense: Eric Hagg (Nebraska) and Curtis Brown (Texas); and Special Teams: William Powell (Kansas State).
- Five Big 12 squads are listed in the top 25 for most passing yards per game, led by Oklahoma State ranked first with 391.67 per outing. Others are 14. Texas A&M (296.67), 16. Missouri (292.33), 18. Oklahoma (288.33) and 22. Texas Tech (275.67). On the ground, Nebraska is ranked fourth in rushing (344) while Kansas State is 11th (260.33) and Texas A&M is 27th (204.67).
- Four Conference defenses are giving up under a 100 yards a game rushing, including 1. Texas (44), 10. Texas A&M (69), 11. Colorado (71.67) and 30. Texas Tech (99.67).
- Several Big 12 coaching staffs will be wearing Coach to Cure MD patches this week to raise awareness and funding for Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy research. Fans are encouraged to donate online at www.CoachtoCureMD.org or donate \$5 by texting CURE to 90999.

The Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship returns to Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas for the second consecutive year. The 2010 game takes place on Saturday, December 4, at 7:00 p.m. CT and will be nationally televised by ABC.

In 2010, the South representative will be the home team. Ticket information will be available at a later date.

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 14-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005, 2009), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

BCS Sightings

The 2009 season marked the Conference's 17th BCS game in the 12-year history of the structure. The Big 12 is 7-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08).

Television Partners

ABC begins its 15th season as the Conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FSN for its cable rights. FSN has sublicensed select television games in 2010 to ESPN.

Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma has improved its nation-leading home win streak to 33 games. Texas is tied for fifth with 16 consecutive home victories.

BAYLOR (2-1, 0-0)

This Week: at Rice

Next Week: Kansas

Baylor looks to end a four-game road losing streak at Rice. The Bears have won the past four meetings against the Owls.

Robert Griffin III has accounted for eight of BU's nine touchdowns this season - five passing TDs and four rushing scores. Griffin III is one rushing TD away from 19 in his career, which would be the most by a QB in Bear history.

Senior Mikail Baker became Baylor's career leader in kick returns (68) and kick return yards (1,688), passing Willie Andrews in both categories.

BU has won nine of its last 12 games when leading at halftime.



COLORADO (2-1, 0-0)

This Week: Idle

Next Week: Georgia

Last week vs. Hawai'i, Rodney Stewart (22 carries, 106 yards, 2 TDs) and Brian Lockridge (14 carries, 109 yards) became the first Colorado running backs to go over 100 yards in the same game since Chris Brown (127) and Bobby Purify (174) did it in 2002 against Iowa State.

The Buffs held Hawai'i to just seven net rushing yards on 13 carries, which ties for the second fewest rushing plays against CU in its history.

Senior WR Scotty McKnight had 65 yards receiving last weekend, becoming the seventh player in school history to pass the 2,000-yard mark in receiving yards.

Last weekend's 73-yard touchdown pass from Tyler Hansen to Toney Clemons was the longest play in the Dan Hawkins Era.



IOWA STATE (1-2, 0-1)

This Week: Northern Iowa

Next Week: Texas Tech

The Cyclones lead the all-time series against UNI 18-4-3 with the last meeting against the Panthers coming in 2007 in front of a record Jack Trice crowd of 56,795. Last year's loss snapped a string of five straight wins by the Cyclones.

Sophomore A.J. Klein, who ranks seventh nationally and first in the league with 12.0 tackles per game, gave ISU its first defensive TD since Aug. 28, 2008, returning his first career interception 69 yards for a touchdown last weekend.

Jake Knott matched a career-high with nine tackles last week, giving him 24 total on the season to go with his two interceptions.

Iowa State is 8-0 under head coach Paul Rhoads when holding teams under 24 points.



KANSAS (1-2, 0-0)

This Week: New Mexico State

Next Week: at Baylor

KU has not lost to a WAC team since 1988. The last time Kansas lost more non-conference games than it won in the regular season was 1993 when the Jayhawks were 1-3 in non-league play.

WR Johnathan Wilson (1,190 yards) needs just 10 receiving yards to become the 20th player in school history with 1,200 career receiving yards.

Running back Deshaun Sands scored his first career touchdown on an eight-yard run in the third quarter against Southern Miss last week. Four Jayhawks have scored their first career TDs this season.

KU ranks 23rd in the NCAA in kickoff return average at 25.33 per return while D.J. Beshears is 18th individually with a 30.00 average.



KANSAS STATE (3-0, 1-0)

This Week: Central Florida

Next Week: Idle

The Wildcats look to open the season 4-0 for the first time since 2003 when KSU finished 11-4 overall and appeared in the Fiesta Bowl.

RB Daniel Thomas ranks second nationally with an average of 184 yards per game, while KSU as a team checks in at 11th. Thomas had a career-high 34 carries last week, the first 30-carry game by a Wildcat since 2003.

From 1992 to the present under Bill Snyder, K-State is 47-5 (.904) in games played during the month of September.

Kansas State holds the 10th-longest scoring streak in the nation with 167 consecutive games since it was last shut out by an opponent.

Former walk-on running back/kick returner William Powell was named Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week after he averaged 29 yards on four kick returns in last week's win over Iowa State.



MISSOURI (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: Miami (Ohio)

Next Week: Idle

T.J. Moe's 68-yard TD catch with 51 seconds remaining gave MU a 27-24 win over San Diego State last week, extending its non-conference winning streak to 20 games. It was the Tiger's first last-minute TD for a victory since 1976.

Senior punter Matt Grabner averaged 45.4 yards on eight punts last week. He has had a punt downed at the opponent's 1-yard line in all three games this year.

QB Blaine Gabbert ranks second nationally in passing, completing an average of 29.33 per game, while T.J. Moe is third in the NCAA ranks with 10.00 receptions per game and Michael Egnew fourth with a 9.67 average.

The Tigers have won nine-straight games in which they have been +1 on turnovers. MU ranks eighth nationally with 10 turnovers gained on the season.



NEBRASKA (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: South Dakota State

Next Week: Idle

First-year QB Taylor Martinez was named the Rivals.com National Freshman of the Week after leading the NU offense to its highest point total in a non-conference road game since 1986.

Nebraska had three players (Taylor Martinez, Roy Helu, Rex Burkhead) rush for more than 100 yards -- the fifth time in school history that's happened, and the first time since 2001.

Saturday's game will mark the second meeting with SDSU. Nebraska won the first meeting, 58-7, in 1963. The game will mark NU's first meeting with an FCS team since Nicholls State in 2006.

Eric Hagg intercepted Jake Locker's first pass of the day and returned it 11 yards to set up Nebraska's first touchdown in the win over Washington - garnering Big 12 Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors.



OKLAHOMA (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Cincinnati

Next Week: vs. Texas (Dallas)

OU and Cincinnati have both held their opponents to an average of 21.67 points per game. The Sooners are averaging 422 yards of total offense compared to Cincinnati's 337.33 yards of total offense.

Oklahoma and Cincinnati met for the first time in 2008, with the Sooners winning 52-26.

Ryan Broyles has 31 catches for 382 yards and three touchdowns through three games. His streak of six straight games with at least 100 receiving yards is the nation's longest.

Two Sooners have recorded 10+ tackles in a game this season, including Jamell Fleming with two and Travis Lewis with one.



OKLAHOMA STATE (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: Idle

Next Week: Texas A&M (Thursday)

QB Brandon Weeden has produced two games with 300+ passing yards, including 409 yards against Tulsa. He was named Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week.

Through a 3-0 start, Oklahoma State is averaging 596 yards and 57 points, while converting all 16 of its red-zone opportunities, with 12 touchdowns.

For the first time this year, OSU is ranked in the top 25 nationally. The Cowboys are No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches Poll. The team continues to receive votes in the Associated Press poll.

The Cowboy defense produced three interceptions against Tulsa last week. OSU entered the game with no picks in its previous two outings.



TEXAS (3-0, 1-0)

This Week: UCLA

Next Week: vs. Oklahoma (Dallas)

The last time Texas and UCLA met, the two teams were ranked in the top-25 nationally. No. 6 UCLA tied the overall series, 2-2, with a 49-31 win over No. 23 Texas.

The Longhorns have won 33 of their last 36 games played in August/September.

UT's defense held Texas Tech to 144 total yards, the fewest allowed to the Red Raiders since giving up 134 yards in 1982. CB Curtis Brown was named Big 12 Co-Defensive Player of the Week after his interception and two pass breakups vs. TTU.

Freshman receiver Mike Davis has 13 receptions in his last two games. That's one off the school record for freshmen in consecutive games. B.J. Johnson had 14 (9 vs. Baylor and 5 vs. Texas Tech) in 2000.



TEXAS A&M (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: Idle

Next Week: at Oklahoma State (Thursday)

Sophomore running back Christine Michael gained at least 100 yards rushing for the third straight game. He had 119 yards on 21 carries. Michael is the first Aggie with three straight 100-yard rushing games since 1998 when Danté Hall did it against Kansas (36-177), Nebraska (32-113) and Baylor (17-137).

QB Jerrod Johnson leads the nation with at least one passing touchdown in the last 21 games.

Texas A&M's defense allowed FIU to convert only 3 of 18 third downs as FIU had four possessions that produced minus yards and six others that netted less than 10 yards.

Through three games, freshman Damontre Moore has notched three sacks, forced three fumbles and notched a fumble recovery as Von Miller's backup.



TEXAS TECH (2-1, 0-1)

This Week: Idle

Next Week: at Iowa State

The Texas Tech secondary forced three interceptions and three sacks against Texas last weekend. QB Garrett Gilbert had not thrown an interception or been sacked in either of Texas' first two games.

Against Texas, DB Jarvis Phillips had two interceptions and returned one 87 yards for a touchdown, while DE Scott Smith had two sacks, a forced fumble and six total tackles.

The Texas Tech vs. Texas game attracted the largest crowd in the history of Jones AT&T Stadium. The sellout crowd of 60,454, broke the previous stadium record attendance of 57,733 set against Texas A&M last year.

Coach Tommy Tuberville now holds a 2-1 record in games played on his birthday. As head coach at Auburn, he won two games played on Sept. 18 - both against LSU.
