BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- After two Big 12 matchups last week, the remaining six teams will open league play on Oct. 1. Two of the games feature undefeated squads as Baylor travels to Kansas State and Texas visits Iowa State. Kansas will host unbeaten Texas Tech in the third Big 12 contest.
- The Big 12 continues with the nation's best non-conference record at 26-2 (.929). Both losses have come on the road where the Big 12 has an impressive 6-2 record.
- The 26-2 non-conference record is also the Big 12's best tally in the month of September.
- Regardless of the outcome in this week's two non-conference tilts, the Big 12 will post its best regular season non-conference win percentage in league history.
- Every Big 12 team will complete the regular season non-conference slate with a winning record for the just the second time. It also occurred in 2004.
- The Big 12 also continues to lead the nation with seven undefeated teams.
- Oklahoma remained the nation's top-ranked team in the USA Today coaches poll for the fifth consecutive week and is No. 2 in the Associated Press poll. Other ratings are No. 6/5 Oklahoma State, No. 13/14 Texas A&M, No. 16/15 Baylor and No. 17/17 Texas.
- The Big 12's five teams in the top 17 of both polls is more than any other conference.
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to: offense: Brandon Weeden (Oklahoma State), defense: Trey Walker (Kansas State) and special teams: Ben McRoy (Texas Tech).
- Weeden also captured the Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week and Davey O'Brien Quarterback of the Week honors.

Big 12 Players of the Week

A Big 12 offensive, defensive and special teams player of the week will be announced each Monday, except for the first week of the season when the announcement will be made on Tuesday. Nominees are forwarded by each institution's media relations department and selected by a panel of media voters who cover the league on a regular basis.

Postseason Awards

Big 12 postseason football awards will be announced at the conclusion of regular season play.

BCS Sightings

The 2010 season marked the Conference's 18th BCS game in the 13-year history of the structure. The Big 12 is 8-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08).

Television Partners

ABC begins its 16th season as the Conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FOX Sports for its cable rights after a new 13-year agreement that will take effect in 2012.

Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma extended its nation-leading home win streak to 38 games. The Sooners next home date is Saturday against Ball State.

Big 12 Success

Examples of recent success of Big 12 football programs.

- BU:** No. 15 AP ranking is its highest since the week of Oct. 7, 1991 when the Bears were ranked eighth.... Notched first win over a ranked team (TCU) since 2004...Played in a bowl game last season for the first time since 1994.
- ISU:** In his first three seasons as ISU's coach, Paul Rhoads has victories at Nebraska, at Texas and versus Iowa...Squad is currently 3-0.
- KU:** Scored 87 points combined in first two games of the season - the most since tallying 87 in back-to-back games in November of 2008...24-2 in non-conference home games dating back to 2003... Won its last three bowl appearances.
- MU:** 48-19 record over the past five years is best stretch in school history...6th winningest team in the nation since 2007.
- OU:** 110-24 record from 2000-09, topped the mark of 102-13-3 in the decade of the 1970s...Added a 12-2-0 record in 2010... Eight appearances in BCS games since 1999, including a national title, and seven Big 12 Championships.
- OSU:** 30-10 record over last three seasons is program's best and tied for 10th nationally in wins...Has gone to five consecutive bowl games...11-2 finish in 2010 marked just the third 10-win season since 1901.
- UT:** Posted 10 wins in nine consecutive seasons (2001-09) - the second-longest streak in NCAA history...133 wins over the previous 13 seasons were the third-most in the nation...Won seven of its last nine bowl games, including a BCS National Championship.
- TAMU:** Played in 10 bowl games since 1996...Has been ranked in the top 25 in 11 straight editions of the AP and coaches polls dating back to Nov. 7, 2010...Had a 1,000-yard rusher and 1,000-yard receiver for the first time in school history in 2010.
- TTU:** Has an 18-year stretch of bowl eligibility that only four other teams nationally have exceeded or matched...45-20 record over previous three seasons is best in school history...16 consecutive winning seasons and 11 straight bowl appearances.

BAYLOR (3-0, 0-0)
Last Week: W, 56-31 vs. Rice
This Week: Kansas State
Next Week: Iowa State

Baylor earned its sixth straight win over Rice, while improving to 3-0 for the 15th time in school history and the first time since 2005. The Bears have now scored 40 or more points in three straight outings for the first time in program history.

Against the Owls, Robert Griffin III set a BU single-game record for completion percentage (min. 30 attempts) -- 87.9 percent (29-of-33). RG3 continues to have more touchdown passes (13) than incompletions (12). Through three games, his passing efficiency rating is 236.23.

A week after becoming BU's all-time leader in receiving yards, WR Kendall Wright caught the 20th TD pass of his career, another school record.

The Bears will take their highest Associated Press ranking since 1991 (No. 15) into their first road contest of 2011 as they face Kansas State on Saturday at 2:30 p.m. on ABC.



IOWA STATE (3-0, 0-0)
Last Week: Open
This Week: Texas
Next Week: at Baylor

After achieving its first 3-0 start since 2005, Iowa State will look to open 4-0 for the first since 2000 when it faces Texas. The Cyclones have trailed in the fourth quarter in each game this season, but have rallied to win each by a combined nine points.

In three games this season, QB Steele Jantz has thrown for six touchdowns and run for two scores. Jantz has completed passes to 10 different receivers, including 14 to former JUCO teammate Aaron Horne.

Linebacker Jake Knott leads the Cyclones with 11 tackles per game. He has also forced and recovered a fumble this season.

In the last meeting, ISU beat UT for the first time in school history, winning 28-21 in Austin last October. It was Iowa State's first road win over a ranked opponent since beating Oklahoma in 1990.



KANSAS (2-1, 0-0)

Coming off a bye week, KU will look to move to 3-0 at home as the Jayhawks face Texas Tech in each team's Big 12 opener. Kansas is 3-1 in its last four Big 12 Conference openers and 6-9 all-time.

QB Jordan Webb ranks second in the Big 12 and fifth nationally in passing efficiency. He has completed 39-of-59 passes on the season, good for 575 yards and six TDs. Additionally, Webb has yet to throw an interception, giving him a quarterback rating of 181.5.

WR D.J. Beshears leads the Big 12 and ranks ninth nationally in all-purpose yardage. He has three rushes for 29 yards, 12 receptions for 135 yards and 18 kickoff returns for 387 yards.

LB Steven Johnson has tallied double digit tackles in two of the three games this season, and with 10.3 tackles per game, he ranks second in the Big 12 and 18th in the NCAA.



KANSAS STATE (3-0, 0-0)
Last Week: W, 28-24 vs. Miami (Fla.)
This Week: Baylor
Next Week: Missouri

Kansas State's victory over Miami improved the Wildcats to 62-7 versus regular season non-conference openers since 1990 under Bill Snyder.

Against the Hurricanes, quarterback Collin Klein had career highs for passing yards (133) and touchdown passes (two), while running back John Hubert had 18 carries for a career-high 166 yards plus a career-long 47-yard run.

The Kansas State defense is in the top 12 in four different categories (scoring defense, pass defense, pass efficiency defense and total defense).

The matchup against the Bears will be the first time since 2008 that the Wildcats have opened up conference play at home against a ranked opponent.



MISSOURI (2-2, 0-1)
Last Week: L, 28-38 vs. Oklahoma

Next Week: at Kansas State

Missouri's 532 yards of total offense were the second-most for a Tiger team against Oklahoma. MU had 559 in a 44-10 victory in 1969 in Columbia.

QB James Franklin racked up 394 yards in total offense including a career-high 103 rushing yards against the Sooners. In his last three games (two on the road vs. ranked teams), he has completed 60-of-100 passes for 856 yards, with 6 TDs and no interceptions.

Against OU, RB Henry Josey had 133 yards rushing and one TD. He has tallied 490 yards rushing over the last three games. Josey leads the Big 12 and is sixth in the NCAA with 133.2 yards per game. Overall, MU is first in the Big 12 and 12th nationally in rushing with 253.3 ypg.

Through four games, Mizzou's defense ranks 2nd in the Big 12 and 20th nationally in rushing defense, allowing an average of 87 yards per game.



OKLAHOMA (3-0, 1-0)
Last Week: W, 38-28 vs. Missouri
This Week: Ball State
Next Week: Texas

Saturday marked the ninth time in school history a Sooner quarterback has thrown for 400 yards or more. Landry Jones threw for 448 yards against Missouri (fourth in OU history) and has conquered the 400-plus yards feat on five of those nine occasions.

OU's 11-point deficit was the most the Sooners have overcome at home since OU came back from a 24-10 deficit late in the first half against Texas Tech in 2006, when the Sooners won 34-24.

With 592 total offense yards against the Tigers, Bob Stoops moved past Barry Switzer with 47 games of 500 yards or more of total offense.

The Sooners wrap up non-conference play against Ball State this Saturday. It's the first meeting of the two teams.



OKLAHOMA STATE (4-0, 1-0)

Last Week: W, 30-29 vs. Texas A&M

This Week: Open

Next Week: Kansas

Senior quarterback Brandon Weeden established school single-game records in three categories: passes completed (47), passes attempted (60) and passing yards (438), breaking his own marks.

Justin Blackmon, Josh Cooper and Hubert Anyiam all recorded at least 10 receptions against the Aggies. It marks the first time in school history the Cowboys had three players with at least 10 receptions in a game.

Oklahoma State has won seven consecutive road games, the second-longest streak in school history, as well as defeating a top-10 team for the first time since 2008.

The victory marks OSU's first-ever four-game winning streak in the series against the Aggies, and the first time the Cowboys have ever beaten A&M in consecutive games at Kyle Field.



TEXAS (3-0, 0-0)

Last Week: Open

This Week: at Iowa State

Next Week: Oklahoma

The Longhorns travel to Ames, Iowa, to open league play against the Cyclones. Both teams head into the game undefeated. Mack Brown is 7-1 all-time against Iowa State.

Texas heads into its fourth game having outgained its opponents 743-328 in the second half this season.

Mack Brown's squad has outscored its opponents by at least seven points in each quarter over the past three games, and by a 56-16 margin in the second half.

Senior Emmanuel Acho leads the Texas defense with 30 tackles on the season, tabbing 13 solo stops. He ranks third among Big 12 players.



TEXAS A&M (2-1, 0-1)

Last Week: L, 29-30 vs. Oklahoma State

This Week: Arkansas

Next Week: at Texas Tech

Quarterback Ryan Tannehill's 65-yard touchdown run was a career long and it was also A&M's longest play from scrimmage this season. Tannehill also tabbed his second straight 300-yard passing game, and the third of his career.

With a crowd of 87,358, the Aggies saw an over-capacity sellout at Kyle Field against the Cowboys. It marked A&M's third-straight sellout to open 2011. It was also Texas A&M's seventh straight home game with an 80,000-plus crowd - a school record.

Receiver Ryan Swope had 105 yards on seven catches, his second 100-yard receiving game in 2011 and the fifth of his career.

ILB Garrick Williams recorded the sixth double digit tackle game of his career with a game-high 13 tackles. It was just shy of his career-high 15 against LSU in the 2011 Cotton Bowl.



TEXAS TECH (3-0, 0-0)

Last Week: W, 35-34 vs. Nevada

This Week: at Kansas

Next Week: Texas A&M

Sophomore Ben McRoy set the single-game record for kickoff returns and yardage in Texas Tech's 35-34 come-from-behind win over Nevada. McRoy returned seven kicks for 203 yards.

Junior running back Eric Stephens rushed for a career-high 134 yards against Nevada. Stephens has now rushed over 90 yards in the last three games.

Defensive back D.J. Johnson led the defense last week, as he piled up a career-high 13 tackles against the Wolfpack. Of his 13 tackles, 10 came in the first half.

Texas Tech opens Big 12 play at Kansas this Saturday. The Red Raiders are 9-6 in Big 12 openers, and 2-0 against the Jayhawks in league openers. Tech boasts an 11-1 series record over Kansas, and has claimed the last four match ups between the squads.
