BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- Oklahoma remained the nation's top ranked team in both the USA Today coaches and Associated Press polls for the third consecutive week. Other ratings are 7/8. Oklahoma State, 9/9. Texas A&M, 21/24. Texas and 24/19. Baylor. Missouri received votes in both polls while Iowa State is among the vote-getters in the coaches poll.
- The Sooners reached a milestone in the Associated Press poll as they became the first team to hold the top ranking 100 times since the poll began in 1936.
- The Big 12 is 14-1 for a .933 win percentage after two weeks of play vs. non-conference opposition. The non-conference win percentage is the best among all FBS leagues and the Big 12 is the only conference with just one loss.
- ESPN Stats and Info Conference Power Ratings has the Big 12 closing in as the best conference in college football. The Big 12's score of 97.5 is just below the SEC's 98.1, and well ahead of the Big Ten's third-place tally of 81.7. The Big 12 is No. 1 in computer rankings and No. 2 in human polls.
- After playing just one road game in the first two weeks, six Big 12 squads will hit the road in Week 3.
- The Conference played in two overtime games last week after playing in a combined total of two over the previous three seasons - both of those in Big 12 play. Iowa State beat Iowa 44-41 in the league's first 3OT contest since 2007 while Missouri fell at No. 23 Arizona 37-30 in one extra period.
- Big 12 Players of the Week were awarded to: offense: Steele Jantz (Iowa State), defense: Zaviar Gooden (Missouri) and special teams: D.J. Beshears (Kansas).

Big 12 Players of the Week

A Big 12 offensive, defensive and special teams player of the week will be announced each Monday, except for the first week of the season when the announcement will be made on Tuesday. Nominees are forwarded by each institution's media relations department and selected by a panel of media voters who cover the league on a regular basis.

Postseason Awards

Big 12 postseason football awards will be announced at the conclusion of regular season play.

BCS Sightings

The 2010 season marked the Conference's 18th BCS game in the 13-year history of the structure. The Big 12 is 8-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08).

Television Partners

ABC begins its 16th season as the Conference's national network television partner. The Big 12 also continues its long-standing relationship with FOX Sports for its cable rights after a new 13-year agreement that will take effect in 2012.

Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

Home Win Streaks

Oklahoma extended its nation-leading home win streak to 37 games. The Sooners next home date is against Missouri on Sept. 24.

Big 12 Success

Examples of recent success of Big 12 football programs.

- BU:** No. 19 AP ranking is its highest ranking since the week of Oct. 14, 1991... Notched first win over a ranked team (TCU) since 2004... Played in a bowl game last season for the first time since 1994.
- ISU:** In his first three seasons as ISU's coach, Paul Rhoads has victories at Nebraska, at Texas and versus Iowa in a three-overtime thriller... Won the 2009 Insight Bowl.
- KU:** Has scored 87 points combined in first two games - the most since tallying 87 in back-to-back games in November of 2008... 24-2 in non-conference home games dating back to 2003... Won its last three bowl appearances.
- MU:** 48-19 record over the past five years is best stretch in school history... 6th winningest team in the nation since 2007.
- OU:** 110-24 record from 2000-09, topped the mark of 102-13-3 in the decade of the 1970s... Added a 12-2-0 record in 2010... Eight appearances in BCS games since 1999, including a national title, and seven Big 12 Championships.
- OSU:** 30-10 record over last three seasons is program's best and tied for 10th nationally in wins... Has gone to five consecutive bowl games... 11-2 finish in 2010 marked just the third 10-win season since 1901.
- UT:** Posted 10 wins in nine consecutive seasons (2001-09) - the second-longest streak in NCAA history... 133 wins over the previous 13 seasons were the third-most in the nation... Won seven of its last nine bowl games, including a BCS National Championship.
- TAMU:** Played in 10 bowl games since 1996... Has been ranked in the top 25 in nine straight editions of the AP and coaches polls dating back to Nov. 7, 2010... Had a 1,000-yard rusher and 1,000-yard receiver for the first time in school history in 2010... Ranked in final 2010 polls for first time since 1999.
- TTU:** Has an 18-year stretch of bowl eligibility that only four other teams nationally have exceeded or matched... 45-20 record over previous three seasons is best in school history... 16 consecutive winning seasons and 11 straight bowl appearances.

BAYLOR (1-0, 0-0)

Last Week: Open
This Week: Stephen F. Austin
Next Week: Rice

Saturday will mark only the fourth series meeting between the Bears and Stephen F. Austin, and the first in nearly 64 years (last was Sept. 19, 1947). Baylor leads the series, 3-0, and has held the Lumberjacks scoreless in the three previous meetings (153-0).

Baylor is ranked in both the AP and USA TODAY Coaches Top 25 polls for the first time since the week of Oct. 31, 2010, when it was No. 22 in both polls. Baylor is 1-1 as a ranked team in the Art Briles era.

QB Robert Griffin III leads the nation in passing efficiency and ranks fourth in total offense. Griffin III owns a 12.5 TD-INT ratio in 13 career non-conference games, tossing 25 TDs and only two INTs.

IR Kendall Wright, who has a catch in all 38 career games, needs 122 receiving yards to become Baylor's career leader. He ranks second nationally in receiving yards and fourth in receptions.



IOWA STATE (2-0, 0-0)

Last Week: W, 44-41 (3OT) vs. Iowa
This Week: Connecticut
Next Week: Open

The Cyclones' 44 points in their win over Iowa were the most ISU has scored against the Hawkeyes in the 59-game series. The attendance of 56,085 at the game was the second-highest in Jack Trice Stadium history.

Junior QB Steele Jantz finished 25-for-37 for 279 yards and four touchdown passes against Iowa. He also had 42 rushing yards en route to being named Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week.

Jantz's 57-yard completion to Aaron Horne was ISU's longest pass play since Bret Meyer connected with Todd Blythe for 63 yards on Oct. 29, 2005.

Iowa State will face Connecticut for just the second time. UCONN defeated the Cyclones, 37-20, at Jack Trice Stadium in 2002. The Cyclones are 1-2-1 all-time against the Big East.



KANSAS (2-0, 0-0)

Last Week: W, 45-42 vs. Northern Illinois
This Week: Georgia Tech
Next Week: Open

With its win over NIU, Kansas won back-to-back games for the first time in the Turner Gill era, and improved to 24-2 in non-conference home games dating back to 2003.

Kansas has scored 87 points (42 and 45) in its first two games of the 2011 season. Last season, the Jayhawks scored 89 points in their first four games.

D.J. Beshears, who caught the game-winning touchdown pass against NIU, had career highs in catches (seven) and yards (70). Beshears also had a career-high 197 kickoff return yards, the second-highest in school history. He was named the Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week.

KU and Georgia Tech are tied 1-1 in the series with the Jayhawks claiming a 28-25 upset victory against then-No. 15 Georgia Tech last season.



KANSAS STATE (1-0, 0-0)

Last Week: Open
This Week: Kent State
Next Week: Miami (Fla.)

Head coach Bill Snyder picked up the 150th victory of his career two weeks ago against Eastern Kentucky. He joined Joe Paterno (Penn State), Frank Beamer (Virginia Tech), Steve Spurrier (South Carolina), Mack Brown (Texas) and Gary Pinkel (Missouri) as active coaches with 150 wins at FBS schools.

Kansas State currently leads the Big 12 and is third nationally in time of possession, after holding the ball for 36 minutes and 43 seconds in week one against Eastern Kentucky. K-State is also first in the nation in total defense, after giving up only 129 yards in its season opener.

Wildcat QB Collin Klein recorded his third career game with at least 75 rushing yards after picking up 78 yards on the ground against Eastern Kentucky. Klein's 206 yards of total offense ranks ninth in the Big 12, while he is tops among Big 12 quarterbacks in rushing yards per game.



MISSOURI (1-1, 0-0)

Last Week: L, 37-30 (OT) vs. Arizona State
This Week: Western Illinois
Next Week: Oklahoma

The loss to Arizona State ended a string of 22 straight wins in the month of September for Missouri, dating back to a 2005 loss to New Mexico.

Six Tiger starters were sidelined for the ASU game, due to injuries, as LT Elvis Fisher, C Travis Ruth, WR Jerrell Jackson and TB Kendial Lawrence were out on offense, and DE Jacquies Smith and LB Will Ebner were out on defense.

Mizzou is 10-0 all-time against FCS opponents, with one of those coming against Western Illinois (W, 50-20 in 2000). MU Coach Gary Pinkel is 7-0 against FCS foes in his time at Missouri, with the average score being 45.1-to-7.3 in favor of the Tigers.

Senior TE Michael Egnew caught the 100th pass of his career, and ended the ASU game with 3 catches for 27 yards, including a key 3-yard TD reception that tied the game at 30-30 with 2:50 to play.



OKLAHOMA (1-0, 0-0)

Last Week: Open
This Week: Florida State
Next Week: Missouri

For the 100th time, Oklahoma is ranked No. 1 in The Associated Press college football poll. The Sooners became the first team to hold the top ranking 100 times since the poll began in 1936. The squad has been ranked first in all three polls this season, including the preseason poll.

The Sooners bring their No. 1 ranking into one of the biggest non-conference games of the season, as the team travels to Seminole country Saturday to take on fifth-ranked Florida State. Oklahoma heads into the series leading 5-1.

After only one game, Landry Jones and Ryan Broyles rank nationally for the Sooners. Jones ranks second nationally in passing, averaging 35 completions per game and fourth nationally in passing yards per game with 375. With 14 catches per game, Broyles ranks first in the country.



OKLAHOMA STATE (2-0, 0-0)

Last Week: W, 37-14 vs. Arizona
This Week: Tulsa
Next Week: Texas A&M

In both games this season, the Cowboys have scored a touchdown on the first possession of the game and then forced their opponent to punt on its first possession. OSU has scored at least one touchdown in all eight quarters this season.

Senior Brandon Weeden set the single-game school record for pass completions (42) and pass attempts (53). Weeden now has 5,309 passing yards in his career, becoming just the fourth Cowboy quarterback to pass for more than 5,000 yards.

Sophomore Joseph Randle recorded his second consecutive 100-yard rushing game with his 15-carry, 121-yard performance (following last week's career-best 129-yard effort). He also established a career best with nine pass catches for 99 yards.



TEXAS (2-0, 0-0)

Last Week: W, 17-16 vs. BYU
This Week: UCLA
Next Week: Open

The Longhorns rallied from a 13-0 deficit to defeat BYU, the largest deficit UT has overcome since rallying from 21-point deficits (twice) to defeat Oklahoma State in 2007.

Texas has held its last six opponents scoreless in the fourth quarter, and has outscored its adversaries 35-6 in the second half this season.

Senior running back Cody Johnson had two rushing touchdowns, bringing his career total to 33. He's tied for seventh in school history.

D.J. Monroe had the first reception of his career (for 26 years) and had 40 rushing yards on three attempts.

UCLA leads the series with Texas 3-2, including a win last season.



TEXAS A&M (1-0, 0-0)

Last Week: Open
This Week: Idaho
Next Week: Oklahoma State

Texas A&M boasts a 13-0 record against current WAC teams. It will be the first meeting between the Aggies and Idaho.

The Aggies were idle last week, but held their spot as a Top 25 team in the AP and USA Today Coaches polls, coming in at No. 9.

Texas A&M will now play 10 straight Saturdays then a Thursday to complete the regular season, facing tough nationally-ranked opponents the next two weeks with Oklahoma State and Arkansas.

Running back Cyrus Gray ranks ninth nationally in rushing with 21 carries and 132 yards.



TEXAS TECH (1-0, 0-0)

Last Week: Open
This Week: New Mexico
Next Week: Nevada

Tech's off week in week-two of the season is the earliest for the Red Raiders since the 2001 season when Tech also took week No. 2 off.

Texas Tech heads west to face New Mexico for its first road game of the season. It will be the 43rd meeting between the two squads, with the Red Raiders owning the series 34-6-2. Tech has won 12 of the last 13 meetings.

Saturday's game against New Mexico will mark the 951st all-time contest in program history. In 87 years of football, the Red Raiders have compiled an overall record of 520-398-32 along with 53 winning seasons.

Tech is currently riding a streak of 18 consecutive winning/non-losing seasons.
