## BIG 12 FOOTBALL QUICK HITS

- Eight Big 12 teams are in action during Week 2 with TCU playing its season opener.
- Oklahoma, West Virginia, Texas, Oklahoma State, TCU and K-State are ranked nationally for the second week in both the coaches and media polls. Baylor received votes in both polls while Texas Tech picked up votes in the coaches edition.
- Big 12 teams are off to a 9-0 start. Since last season, the league is 36-3 in non-conference games (.923 win percentage), and is 42-5 (.893) including bowl games.
- The Big 12 is the only FBS league without a loss after Week 1 games.
- Big 12 teams outscored their opponents 437-137 (average score, 48.5 to 15.2) during opening weekend.
- Big 12 teams combined to run 703 offensive plays and gain 4,679 yards for an average of 519.8 yards per game and 6.7 yards per play.
- The Big 12 has three of the longest FBS streaks of scoring at least 30 points: *Oklahoma State* (19), *Oregon* (14), *USC* (9), *TCU* (7) and *Baylor* (7).
- Big 12 teams are ranked in the top three for longest win streaks - 1. TCU (W8), 2. Baylor (W7) and T3. West Virginia (W5).
- Ten Big 12 players rushed for over 100 yards in Week 1 games, including two each from Kansas and Oklahoma State.
- QB Geno Smith (West Virginia), LB Isaiah Bruce (West Virginia) and P Kirby Van Der Kamp (Iowa State) were selected the season's first Big 12 Players of the Week.
- Geno Smith (West Virginia) was named the Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week.

### Big 12 Players of the Week

A Big 12 offensive, defensive and special teams player of the week will be announced each Monday, except for the first week of the season when the announcement will be made on Tuesday. Nominees are forwarded by each institution's media relations department and selected by a panel of media voters who cover the league on a regular basis.

### Postseason Awards

Big 12 postseason football awards will be announced at the conclusion of regular season play.

### BCS Sightings

The Big 12 has made 19 appearances in a BCS game in the 14-year history of the structure. The Conference has placed at least one team in the top four of the final BCS Standings in 11 of 14 years. The Big 12 is 9-10 all-time in BCS games and has advanced two teams in the same season five times (2001, '03, '04, '07, '08). The Conference ranks second with seven appearances in the BCS national championship game.

### Heisman Trophy Winners

The Big 12 had produced five Heisman Trophy winners since the inception of the league in 1996, which leads all conferences during this time span. The Big 12 has had a Heisman finalist (top four in the final voting) 11 out of 16 seasons.

In a compilation of Heisman voting since 1996 (based on the top four finishers assigning four points for first, three for second, etc.), the Big 12 has had the most Heisman success with 45 points, outdistancing the SEC in second with 35 points and the Pacific-12 in third with 32 points.

### Consensus All-America

The Big 12 leads the country with 95 football consensus All-America selections.

### Television Selections

Television selections will be announced on either a 12-day or six-day advance by the Conference office. The 12-day advances will be released on Mondays while the six-day will be available on Sunday's prior to that week's games.

**BAYLOR (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Open  
**Next Week:** Sam Houston State

Baylor has the nations second-longest winning streak at seven games, trailing only TCU who has won eight straight.

The Bears have scored 30-plus points in seven consecutive games, tied for the fourth-longest active streak nationally. The Bears have also scored over 40 points in five consecutive games.



**IOWA STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at Iowa  
**Next Week:** Western Illinois

Last week's crowd of 54,931 was the largest crowd to see an Iowa State home opener.

QB Steele Jantz threw for a career-high 281 yards and RB Shontrelle Johnson rushed for a career-high 120 yards as Iowa State downed Tulsa last Saturday. Punter Kirby Van Der Kamp was named Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week.



**KANSAS (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Rice  
**Next Week:** TCU

Running backs Taylor Cox and Tony Pierson each ran for over 100 yards in last week's win over SDSU, marking the first time Kansas has featured a pair of 100-plus yard rushers in the same game since 2007.

The Jayhawks notched four interceptions in last week's win, another first since 2007.



**KANSAS STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Miami (Fla.)  
**Next Week:** North Texas

K-State extended its scoring streak to 191 games, the longest such streak in the Big 12 and 10th-longest in the nation.

Tramaine Thompson's 89-yard punt return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter was the longest for K-State since Jordy Nelson's 92-yarder on Oct. 28, 2007.



**OKLAHOMA (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Florida A&M  
**Next Week:** Open

QB Landry Jones' 222 passing yards in last week's win over UTEP moved him into 14th place in FBS history with 12,601.

OU's defense held the UTEP offense scoreless in the return of Mike Stoops as defensive coordinator. It marked the first time OU has shut out an opposing offense since 2010. UTEP's lone score was on special teams from a blocked punt.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at Arizona  
**Next Week:** UL-Lafayette

Over the last two seasons, Oklahoma State's two wins over Arizona have been by a combined score of 73-24.

Over the last three seasons, OSU is 11-2 on the road, including 10 wins in the last 11 road games. Those totals do not include two neutral-site bowl wins. OSU's 10 road wins over the last two years are tied for the most in the country.



**TCU (0-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Grambling State  
**Next Week:** at Kansas

Gary Patterson needs one win to become the Horned Frogs' all-time winningest coach. His 109 victories are currently tied for the top spot with Dutch Meyer (1934-52).

TCU is the only school in the nation to win at least 11 games in six of the last seven seasons. The Horned Frogs have won at least 10 games eight times in the last 10 years, including seven campaigns with at least 11 victories. TCU is first nationally with an eight-game win streak.



**TEXAS (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** New Mexico  
**Next Week:** at Mississippi

Sophomore running backs Malcolm Brown and Joe Bergeron each recorded 100-plus yard rushing games in the season opener. It is the second time the tandem has registered 100 yards or more in the same game.

UT is now 100-17-3 in season openers, including victories in the last 13. Mack Brown is 14-1 in season openers at Texas.



**TEXAS TECH (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** at Texas State  
**Next Week:** New Mexico

Texas Tech held Northwestern State to just six points, marking the fewest points given up since the Red Raiders held SMU to three points during the 2006 season opener.

Tommy Tuberville is the first Texas Tech coach to win his first three season openers since Steve Sloan (1975-77).



**WEST VIRGINIA (1-0, 0-0)**

**This Week:** Open  
**Next Week:** James Madison (Landover, Md.)

Quarterback Geno Smith completed 32-36 passes for 323 yards and four touchdowns against Marshall and was named Walter Camp Football Foundation National Offensive Player of the Week and Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week. Linebacker Isaiah Bruce was named Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week

West Virginia's 69 points were the most scored by the Mountaineers in a season-opener, topping the 66 scored against Richmond to begin the 1958 season.

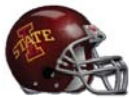
