⇒ After the first three weeks of the season, the Big 12 is home to the following national statistical leaders: scoring offense - Oklahoma (61.3); total offense - Graham Harrell, Texas Tech (432.7); receptions per game - Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech (12.67); tackles per game - Jordon Dizon, Colorado (16.3).

⇒ A check of this week's polls finds a season-high five Big 12 teams ranked (#4/4 Oklahoma, #6/7 Texas, #16/20 Texas A&M, #22/24 Nebraska and #25/25 Missouri).

⇒ Week 4 finds Iowa State, Oklahoma and Texas A&M hitting the road for the first time this season, leaving Kansas as the only Big 12 team to have not played a road game.

⇒ Jamaal Charles (Texas) and Michael Crabtree (Texas Tech) turned in conference-leading performances for the second consecutive week in rushing and receiving yards, respectively, while Graham Harrell's (Texas Tech) passing yards led the league for the third straight week.

⇒ Missouri and Texas A&M have scored points on every red zone penetration this season.

⇒ Texas Tech's Michael Crabtree set a Big 12 freshman record with 244 receiving yards in Saturday's win at Rice, while Oklahoma's Demarco Murray's 92-yard touchdown run against Utah State was also a Big 12 freshman record.

12th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

For the third time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship game will be held in San Antonio. The 2007 game takes place on Saturday, December 1, at the Alamodome. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged in the Alamodome were in 1997 (64,824) and 1999 (65,035).

Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship Winners

In the 11-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004, 2007), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).



BAYLOR (2-1, 0-0)
This Week: at Buffalo
Next Week: at Texas A&M

Blake Szymanski became the first Bear to record five-plus touchdown passes twice, having accomplished it the last two weeks. His 411 passing yards vs. Texas State was one short of the school record he set the week before.

Baylor has held its opponent without a first-quarter offensive touchdown in 16 of the last 25 games with 13 first-quarter shutouts in that span.

The Bears' defense has forced at least one turnover in 23 of the last 26 games.

BU is averaging over 50 pass attempts per game, and has totaled over 400 yards offense in each of the last two contests.



COLORADO (1-2, 0-0)
This Week: Miami (Ohio)
Next Week: Oklahoma

Colorado's 34 pass completions vs. Florida State were the second-highest and the 54 pass attempts tied for the second-most in school history.

The Buffaloes' five starting offensive linemen have played all 212 snaps on the season.

CU's defense limited Florida State to 221 yards of offense, the fewest yards by an opponent since holding New Mexico State to 181 in 2005.

Jordon Dizon leads the nation in tackles with 16.3 per game.

Colorado has scored in 225 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak in the NCAA and 11th-longest all-time.



IOWA STATE (1-2, 0-0)
This Week: at Toledo
Next Week: at Nebraska

Bret Culbertson tied a school record with five field goals in the win over Iowa. His game-winner marked only the second time in school history that a game was decided with one or less seconds left on the clock.

In the win over Iowa, Alvin Bowen had a team-high seven tackles, including a sack and a tackle for loss in addition to a forced fumble.

The last time the Cyclones won a game without the benefit of a touchdown (offense, defense, or special teams) was in 1948, when Iowa State beat Drake 2-0.

Iowa State held Iowa to 233 yards of total offense, marking the best defensive effort for ISU since 2005 vs. Kansas State (also 233 yards).



KANSAS (3-0, 0-0)
This Week: Florida International
Next Week: Idle

Kansas' 557 yards of total offense were the most since amassing 586 against Colorado in 2003 and marked the third straight game this season of 500-plus total offense yards.

In Saturday's win over Toledo Marcus Henry had seven receptions for 133 yards to tie a Kansas record with three consecutive 100-yard receiving games.

Since sharing time on the offensive side of the ball, defensive back Aqib Talib has six career receptions with four going for touchdowns. He has scored a TD in each of his last four games.

The Jayhawks' defense has allowed one individual 100-yard rushing performance since the 2004 season (Leon Patton, Kansas State, Game 11, 2006).



KANSAS STATE (2-1, 0-0)
This Week: Idle
Next Week: at Texas

Kansas State's 61 points scored vs. Missouri State were the highest total in the Ron Prince era and the most since scoring 64 at Kansas in 2002.

The KSU defense registered five sacks Saturday to increase its season total to a Big 12-leading 13. The Cats have recorded three or more sacks in every game this season.

Senior wide receiver Jordy Nelson set school single-game records for receptions (15) and receiving yards (209) in the win over Missouri State. He finished with 291 all-purpose yards, to rank 10th in school annals.

Josh Freeman threw for a career-high 287 yards against Missouri State. It was the sixth 200-yard effort in his last seven games and the seventh of his career.



MISSOURI (3-0, 0-0)
This Week: Illinois State
Next Week: Idle

Freshman Jeremy Maclin's 275 all-purpose yards vs. Western Michigan were a career-high and rank 5th in Mizzou single-game history. He had 7 receptions for 96 yards and 1 TD, rushed 6 times for 52 yards and 1 TD, returned 2 punts for 31 yards and 5 kickoffs for 96 yards.

Linebacker Brock Christopher registered 10 tackles, broke up 2 passes, had 1 tackle for loss and grabbed his second career interception last Saturday.

Martin Rucker leads the nation's tight ends with 25 catches through three games, and his yardage total of 259 is second-best nationally among TEs.

Mizzou ranks 7th nationally in total offense (532.00 ypg), including 10th in passing offense (345.33 ypg) and 37th in rushing offense (186.67 ypg) after its season-high 272-yard rushing day against WMU.



NEBRASKA (2-1, 0-0)

This Week: Ball State
Next Week: Iowa State

Sam Keller's 389 yards passing vs. USC was the fourth-highest in Nebraska history and the most by a Husker against a ranked opponent.

Keller has attempted more than 40 passes in each of the last two games, marking just the second time in school history Nebraska has attempted 40 or more passes in consecutive weeks (vs. Missouri and Oklahoma in 2005).

USC became just the eighth school to win in Lincoln since 1986. The Trojans are only the second non-conference opponent to win in Lincoln since 1991 (Southern Miss in 2004).



OKLAHOMA (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Tulsa (Sept. 21)
Next Week: at Colorado

OU had 617 total yards vs. Utah State. The Sooners rank third nationally and second in the Big 12 with a per game average of 565.3 yards of offense.

Allen Patrick (113) and DeMarco Murray (100) became OU's first pair of 100-yard rushers in the win over Utah State since the 2004 season opener against Bowling Green when Kejuan Jones ran for 148 yards and Adrian Peterson had 100 yards. Patrick also became the 65th Sooner to reach 1,000 career rushing yards (1,057).

Malcolm Kelly's 19 career touchdown catches rank him in second place on the OU career list behind Mark Clayton, who caught 31 TDs from 2001-2004.



OKLAHOMA STATE (1-2, 0-0)

This Week: Texas Tech
Next Week: Sam Houston State

Sophomore linebacker Chris Collins had a game-high 13 tackles vs. Troy, the most by a Cowboy this season.

OSU has rushed for over 230 yards in each of the last two contests, while averaging 460 yards of offense during that span.

With two touchdowns against Troy, Julius Crosslin moved up to 19th place on the career scoring list with 110 points.

Kendall Hunter rushed for 125 yards against Troy, marking the second time an OSU freshman has run for 100 yards in a game since 2002 when Vernand Morency had 108 against Louisiana Tech. Keith Toston had 109 at Kansas State last year.



TEXAS (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: Rice
Next Week: Kansas State

Texas extended its streak of consecutive non-conference road wins to a school-record eight (previous record: 7, 1956-63).

Brandon Foster's 33-yard interception return Saturday against Central Florida was the Longhorns' 55th non-offensive touchdown since 1999, which ranks third nationally. He also became the first Longhorn to score non-offensive TDs in consecutive games since Greg Brown did it against Texas A&M and Oregon in 2000.

Quan Cosby has logged 100 or more all-purpose yards in each of UT's last four games.

Jamaal Charles joins Cedric Benson as the only UT backs to open a season with three-straight 100-yard rushing games in the last 10 years. Benson had four consecutive to open the 2004 season.



TEXAS A&M (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Miami (Fla.) (Sept. 20)
Next Week: Baylor

Stephen McGee posted the seventh 200-yard passing game of his career with 237 yards on 19-of-33 passing with one touchdown and one interception against UL-Monroe. His interception broke a string of 150 straight passes without a pick dating back to last season's Oklahoma game.

A&M did not punt in a game for the first time since 1990 against Southwestern Louisiana (a 63-14 victory).

The Aggies have scored a touchdown on the first drive of the second half in six consecutive games.

Jorvorskie Lane had two rushing touchdowns against ULM, giving him 35 for his career, which ties for No. 3 in school history.



TEXAS TECH (3-0, 0-0)

This Week: at Oklahoma State
Next Week: Northwestern State

Graham Harrell threw a career-high six touchdown passes to equal the top performance by a quarterback in Rice Stadium history. Harrell leads the nation in total offense with 432.7 yards a game.

Michael Crabtree has eight touchdowns in his first three collegiate games and caught 11 passes for a Big 12 season-high 244 yards vs. the Owls. Crabtree ranks first nationally in receptions (12.67) and second in receiving yards (179.3) per game.

Placekicker Alex Trlica added to his NCAA record with 187 consecutive point-after-attempts. He has never missed a PAT during his Tech career.

Running back Shannon Woods extended his streak to 202 career carries without a fumble.
