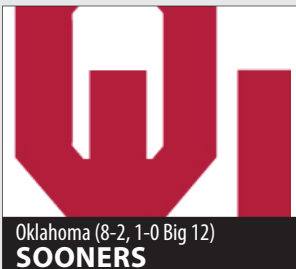

SOONERS OPEN HOME SLATE AGAINST MISSOURI

Oklahoma opens the home portion of the 2009 schedule on Saturday morning, taking on the Missouri Tigers in an 11:30 a.m. CT contest from McCasland Field House. Admission to the match is free on Fan Appreciation Day and Sooner Nation members receive double points for attending.

SOONERS REWIND: OKLAHOMA OUTLASTS KSU, 3-1

In true Big 12 fashion, defense was the star of the match as Oklahoma faced Kansas State Wednesday evening at Ahearn Field House. A match that featured a combined 194 digs, 17 blocks and several long rallies saw the Sooners open the conference season with a 3-1 [26-24, 24-26, 25-21, 25-15] victory over the Wildcats.

BOULAVSKY GETTING IT DONE IN THE FRONT ROW

Sophomore **Suzy Boulavsky** was OU's X-factor in the win over Kansas State. Boulavsky added 12 kills, marking the fourth match this season she has had 10 or more. Boulavsky also tallied a career high with seven block assists.

EKWEREKWU CONTINUES TO COME THROUGH

Junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** led the Sooners with 13 kills against the Wildcats. It was her fifth 10+ kill performance and third straight this season. Ekwerekwu currently leads the Sooners in kills per set (2.66) and points per set (3.45).

ALVA COMES UP BIG ON DEFENSE FOR OKLAHOMA

Sophomore **Danielle Alva** saw time in all four sets Wednesday night at Kansas State. Alva's 14 digs were a career high, she added a service ace and assist in the win.

SIDING ON THE RIGHT

Oklahoma has produced a sideout percentage of 100 during two sets this season. The rare feat was accomplished against North Carolina and UT-Arlington. It has only been done six times under head coach Santiago Restrepo.

FREUDENRICH: A ONE-WOMAN WRECKING CREW

Junior **Sarah Freudenrich** is causing havoc in most matches she has played in this season. Freudenrich is averaging 2.49 kills per set and hitting a team-best .349. In nine matches played this season, she has had 10 kills in four of those contests. Considering her offensive power is potent, what really makes her a valuable commodity is her blocking. She already has 42 blocks on the year, a 1.20 per set average. With four block solos and 38 block assists, Freudenrich is a responsible for 110 of the Sooners' 621.5 points so far this season.

EKWEREKWU HAS GRAND HOMECOMING

Junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** had a stellar performance at the UT-Arlington Invitational, earning Most Valuable Player honors. In her return to her hometown, Ekwerekwu led OU with 3.12 kills per set and a .327 hitting percentage. She also recorded nine blocks (1.12/set), including one block solo. Her three service aces and seven digs also contributed to OU winning the tournament with a 2-0 mark.

HOME SWEET HOME

Oklahoma finally gets to return to the friendly confines of the Howard McCasland Field House. Having already played 10 matches this season, the Sooners have been on the road for all 10 of those contests. The last time OU played a home opener that late was in 2003. The Sooners opened their home slate on Sept. 24 against Texas.

OFF TO A BETTER START THIS TIME AROUND

Compared to a year ago, Oklahoma ended ahead in the stats category in 2009 as compared to 2008. With a 7-2 record, the Sooners finished ahead of their 4-4 mark last season. Oklahoma also fared better in on both sides of the ball. The Sooners' attack percentage this year was .225 compared to .173 in 2008 and digs per set was 17.2 in 2009 compared to 15.2 a year ago.

PLEDGE FOR A CURE

Head coach **Santiago Restrepo's** youngest son, Javier, passed away in July at the age of four after a three-year battle with leukemia. On Wednesday, Sept. 30, the Sooner volleyball program will honor the life of little Javi. FERNANDA OFF TO A GREAT START

Already this season, freshman **María Fernanda** has started every match at libero. She's getting the job done on the back row, averaging 4.68 digs per set. She set her season high against North Carolina with 23 defensive helpers. Fernanda has had 20 or more digs in five matches this season.

HIGGINS GETS BACK IN HER GROOVE

Sophomore **Caitlin Higgins** had an excellent match against UT-Arlington. Higgins recorded her second double-double of the season with 13 kills and a career-high 23 digs.

SOONERS OUT-HITTING OPPONENTS

Oklahoma fares quite well in out-hitting opponents. The Sooners have hit .217 as team in the first 10 matches of the season. They have held opponents to a .123 clip.

OKLAHOMA AGAINST THE BIG 12

Oklahoma owns a winning series against four Big 12 opponents (Baylor, Kansas, Kansas State and Missouri) but has just an 84-177 mark in conference play.

DOUBLE VISION

Sophomore **Brianne Barker** and senior **Bridget Laplante** lead OU in double-doubles this season. Barker had three double-doubles in the first weekend, while Laplante had one. Barker followed up with two more double-doubles at the Best Western Shocker Classic and Laplante added

one more to her tally. Barker got her sixth of the season against UT-Arlington and seventh against Kansas State. For good measure, sophomores **Kylie Cowan** and **Caitlin Higgins** each had their first double-doubles of the season in Wichita. Higgins added another against UTA.

SHOCKER CLASSIC ALL-TOURNEY

Freshman **María Fernanda** was named to the all-tournament for the Best Western Shocker Classic. It marks the second straight weekend the rookie was named among the best at an event. She was previously named to the all-tournament team at the Mizuno Invitational in Houston.

SOONERS TAKEN TO LIMIT

After breezing through the opening weekend with three three-set matches and one that went four, the Sooners played back-to-back five setters to open the Best Western Shocker Classic. OU dropped Grambling State in five before winning the first two against North Carolina and falling to the Tar Heels in five.

BOULAVSKY NETS CAREER HIGH

Sophomore **Suzu Boulavsky** netted a career-high 15 kills against Central Arkansas.

GETTING A LITTLE PLAYING TIME

Every Sooner on the 2009 roster has seen playing time this year.

TRIO NAMED ALL-TOURNAMENT

Sophomore setter **Brianne Barker** was named the Most Valuable Player of the 2009 Mizuno Invitational hosted by Rice. Freshman LB **María Fernanda** was named to the team as was senior OH **Bridget Laplante**. Barker averaged 9.85 assists per set and 3.31 digs. Fernanda led OU with 4.23 digs per set and Laplante led the team in kills with 34.

A TALE OF TWO SEASONS

When Oklahoma began the 2008 season, the Sooners returned just two starters. What a difference a year makes. To start the 2009 season, Oklahoma returns all six position starters. Of those six, one is a senior (OH **Bridget Laplante**). The team's only other senior is OH **Jackie Fotu**.

SOONERS TABBED SEVENTH

The OU women's volleyball team was selected to finish in seventh place, based on votes by the conference coaches. Voting coaches were not allowed to vote for their own teams.

Entering his sixth season as the head coach at the University of Oklahoma, Santiago Restrepo has brought the program to new heights in just five seasons at the helm of the program. Pairing his international recruiting with his hard-working, blue collar coaching style, Restrepo has made a name for Oklahoma within the volleyball community.

The program felt Restrepo's impact as soon as he arrived on campus from his previous coaching stop at Southern Mississippi. In his first season at the helm of the Sooner program, he led the 2004 OU squad to a 12-17 record. No Sooner squad had produced a better record since the 1997 squad that reached the NCAA Tournament.

While the 2004 season caught many people's eye, nobody would predict what would happen two years later as Restrepo led the Sooners to the best season in school history. The 2006 season broke plenty of OU records and sparked momentum for the 2007 season.

Restrepo earned Big 12 and Regional Coach of the Year honors and was recognized by CVU.com as its National Coach of the Year as he led the Sooners to the best one-year turnaround in Big 12 history. Behind Restrepo's leadership, the Sooners recorded the best winning percentage in school history with a 28-6 record (.824) and finished a program-best second in the Big 12 Conference race (17-3).

Restrepo's successful 2006 season included OU's first-ever win over Texas in the series history as well as entry into the 2006 NCAA Tournament for only the fourth time in school history and the program's second Sweet 16 trip. Oklahoma finished the season as one of the best in the country with a No. 12 final ranking, its highest in history.

The Oklahoma players also felt the presence of Restrepo, individually, as all five seniors of the 2006 class earned All-Big 12 recognition while Joanna Schmitt and Eliane Santos became the second and third All-Americans in school history.

OU did not disappoint in 2007, either. After being picked ninth in the preseason coaches' poll, the Sooners advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive season. It also marked the second time in OU history that the Sooners made back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

Senior outside hitter Sarah Weiland represented OU on the All-Big 12 honorable mention team, while freshman Francie Ekwerekwu was named to the All-Big 12 freshman team. For their efforts in the classroom, five Sooners earned Academic All-Big 12 honors and three were named Academic All-District.

The history-making 2006 and 2007 seasons were remarkable, considering they followed a 2005 season that saw the Sooners finish 7-22.

However, Restrepo was getting his tools in place in 2005 for the historic next year as his recruiting skills shined with the addition of juco transfer Santos. In her junior season, Santos made her mark on Big 12 volleyball, finishing in the top five in the conference in blocks and kills and was named one of Collegiate Volleyball Update's top-five blockers in the country.

In 2008, he coached Brienne Barker and Caitlin Higgins to All-Big 12 Freshman team honors. Higgins became the first Oklahoma player to earn the Sports Imports/American Volleyball Coaches Association Division I National Player of the Week on Nov. 4.

Restrepo was named the fourth head coach in OU volleyball history on January 26, 2004. During the search process, OU Athletics Director Joe Castiglione was set on making a program-changing hire that fit perfectly into the values of the university.

A former NCAA Division I All-American at East Stroudsburg, Restrepo was also a four-time all-conference selection. He earned team Most Valuable Player honors all four years and was the co-winner of the Senior Athlete Award in 1986. He was inducted into the East Stroudsburg Hall of Fame in 2004.

Following his collegiate career, Restrepo played one season professionally in France and returned to the United States where he played on the American Volleyball Players Pro Beach Tour.

He earned a 3A player rating on the AVP tour and had the opportunity to play against some of the giants of professional beach volleyball, including Karch Kiraly, Sinjin Smith, Randy Stoklos and Kent Steffes.

Highly involved in the international circuit and USA Volleyball, Restrepo served as co-head coach of one of two USA Volleyball under-22 select teams that toured Argentina in June 2005 and 2006.

Restrepo and his wife, the former Heidi Nichols, have two sons, Diego Ignacio and Javier Santiago.
