REMEMBERING JAVI: SOONER VOLLEYBALL TO HONOR RESTREPO'S SON



When the Oklahoma volleyball team takes the court Wednesday night, they will continue their year-long mission to honor the son of their head coach, Santiago Restrepo. On Wednesday, they will share Javi's story with a national audience. Throughout the evening, fans attending the match and those at home have a chance to make a difference through monetary donations to the Jimmy Everest Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders at the Children's Hospital at the OU Medical Center. Sooner fans can pledge any amount of their choice for every kill, dig, ace and/or block OU records on the evening. Pledge forms are available at the door and online at SoonerSports.com. Head football coach Bob Stoops and women's basketball coach Sherri Coale will sign autographs at the match from 6:00-6:30 p.m. A minimum charitable donation of \$10 is required and fans are allowed to bring one item per coach to be signed.

OKLAHOMA WELCOMES 10TH-RANKED NEBRASKA

The Oklahoma Sooners return home on Wednesday, Sept. 30 for a 6 p.m. CT against the 10th-ranked Nebraska Cornhuskers. Beth Mowins and Cathy Nelson call the action for ESPNU. Live stats are available at SoonerSports.com. Oklahoma seeks its first win against the Huskers in 12 years. The Sooners last defeated Nebraska on Oct. 10, 1997 in Norman.

SOONERS REWIND: OU MAKES QUICK WORK OF BUFFS

The University of Oklahoma volleyball team dominated through the entire match to sweep the Colorado Buffaloes, 3-0 [25-17, 25-16, 25-14], Saturday evening at the Coors Events Center. The Sooners only trailed twice during the entire match. Junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** recorded 11 kills and four block assists and matched her career high with a .526 hitting percentage.

OKLAHOMA'S DEFENSE ONE OF NATION'S BEST

Oklahoma leads the Big 12 in digs per set with 17.84, a mark that is seventh in the nation. National leader NJIT averages 21.17 per set. Freshman **María Fernanda** ranks second in the league in digs per set and 38th in the nation with 4.80 per set. Senior **Bridget Laplante** (194th, 3.74) also ranks in the top 250 nationally in digs per set.

FREUDENRICH RANKED IN TOP 100 NATIONALLY

Junior **Sarah Freudenrich** ranks in the top 100 nationally in blocks per set (76th, 1.15/set) and hitting percentage (142nd, .324). The top 250 student-athletes nationally were ranked in each category.

RESTREPO NINE WINS SHY OF #100

Oklahoma head coach Santiago Restrepo is nine wins shy of his 100th victory at the school. In six seasons overseeing the Sooner program, Restrepo owns a mark of 91-74.

LAPLANTE'S CAREER ACCOMPLISHMENT

Senior **Bridget Laplante** recently reached the 1,000/1,000 mark for her career. Laplante becomes just the second Sooner under Restrepo to reach the plateau after Joanna Schmitt accomplished the feat from 2003-06 with 1,730 career kills and 1,177 career digs.

SATURDAY'S CONTEST MOVED TO 3 P.M. CT

Saturday's contest against Texas Tech has been moved to 3 p.m. CT.

SIDING ON THE RIGHT

Oklahoma has produced a sideout percentage of 100 percent during two sets this season. The rare feat was accomplished against North Carolina and UT-Arlington. It has only been done six times under head coach Santiago Restrepo.

FERNANDA NAMED BIG 12 DEFENSIVE POW

University of Oklahoma freshman libero **María Fernanda** was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 20. Fernanda is the first Sooner to be named Defensive Player of the Week since Mariana Blum earned the honor on Sept. 10, 2007. Fernanda joins teammates **Sarah Freudenrich** (Rookie of the Week; Oct. 22, 2008) and **Caitlin Higgins** (Offensive Player of the Week; Nov. 3, 2008) as current Sooners with weekly award honors.

EKWEREKWU LEADING OU'S OFFENSE

Junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** currently leads OU offensively with 2.84 kills per set and is second on the team with 11 service aces. She averages 1.00 blocks per set. Ekwerekwu has played in 44 sets this year and leads Oklahoma with 3.67 points per set. Colorado was her eighth 10+ kill performance and fifth straight this season.

EARNING AN A IN SERVING

Sophomore **Brianna Barker** leads the Sooners with 12 service aces on the year. Junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** is second on the team with 11. Ekwerekwu is consistently in the service rotation for the first time in her career. She previously only had one service attempt in 2008 at Southern California.

SOONERS HIT WELL AGAINST RICE

As a team, Oklahoma hit .347 against Rice on Aug. 28. The last time the Sooners produced a match with a better percentage was against Seton Hall on Aug. 25, 2007.

TRIO NAMED ALL-TOURNAMENT

Sophomore setter **Brianne Barker** was named the Most Valuable Player of the 2009 Mizuno Invitational hosted by Rice. Freshman LB **Maria Fernanda** was named to the team as was senior OH **Bridget Laplante**. Barker averaged 9.85 assists per set and 3.31 digs. Fernanda led OU with 4.23 digs per set and Laplante led the team in kills with 34.

A TALE OF TWO SEASONS

When Oklahoma began the 2008 season, the Sooners returned just two starters. What a difference a year makes. To start the 2009 season, Oklahoma returns all six position starters. Of those six, one is a senior (OH **Bridget Laplante**). The team's only other senior is OH **Jackie Fotu**.

Entering his sixth season as the head coach at the University of Oklahoma, Santiago Restrepo has brought the program to new heights in just five seasons at the helm of the program. Pairing his international recruiting with his hard-working, blue collar coaching style, Restrepo has made a name for Oklahoma within the volleyball community.

The program felt Restrepo's impact as soon as he arrived on campus from his previous coaching stop at Southern Mississippi. In his first season at the helm of the Sooner program, he led the 2004 OU squad to a 12-17 record. No Sooner squad had produced a better record since the 1997 squad that reached the NCAA Tournament.

While the 2004 season caught many people's eye, nobody would predict what would happen two years later as Restrepo led the Sooners to the best season in school history. The 2006 season broke plenty of OU records and sparked momentum for the 2007 season.

Restrepo earned Big 12 and Regional Coach of the Year honors and was recognized by CVU.com as its National Coach of the Year as he led the Sooners to the best one-year turnaround in Big 12 history. Behind Restrepo's leadership, the Sooners recorded the best winning percentage in school history with a 28-6 record (.824) and finished a program-best second in the Big 12 Conference race (17-3).

Restrepo's successful 2006 season included OU's first-ever win over Texas in the series history as well as entry into the 2006 NCAA Tournament for only the fourth time in school history and the program's second Sweet 16 trip. Oklahoma finished the season as one of the best in the country with a No. 12 final ranking, its highest in history.

The Oklahoma players also felt the presence of Restrepo, individually, as all five seniors of the 2006 class earned All-Big 12 recognition while Joanna Schmitt and Eliane Santos became the second and third All-Americans in school history.

OU did not disappoint in 2007, either. After being picked ninth in the preseason coaches' poll, the Sooners advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive season. It also marked the second time in OU history that the Sooners made back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

Senior outside hitter Sarah Weiland represented OU on the All-Big 12 honorable mention team, while freshman Francie Ekwerekwu was named to the All-Big 12 freshman team. For their efforts in the classroom, five Sooners earned Academic All-Big 12 honors and three were named Academic All-District.

The history-making 2006 and 2007 seasons were remarkable, considering they followed a 2005 season that saw the Sooners finish 7-22.

However, Restrepo was getting his tools in place in 2005 for the historic next year as his recruiting skills shined with the addition of juco transfer Santos. In her junior season, Santos made her mark on Big 12 volleyball, finishing in the top five in the conference in blocks and kills and was named one of Collegiate Volleyball Update's top-five blockers in the country.

In 2008, he coached Brienne Barker and Caitlin Higgins to All-Big 12 Freshman team honors. Higgins became the first Oklahoma player to earn the Sports Imports/American Volleyball Coaches Association Division I National Player of the Week on Nov. 4.

Restrepo was named the fourth head coach in OU volleyball history on January 26, 2004. During the search process, OU Athletics Director Joe Castiglione was set on making a program-changing hire that fit perfectly into the values of the university.

A former NCAA Division I All-American at East Stroudsburg, Restrepo was also a four-time all-conference selection. He earned team Most Valuable Player honors all four years and was the co-winner of the Senior Athlete Award in 1986. He was inducted into the East Stroudsburg Hall of Fame in 2004.

Following his collegiate career, Restrepo played one season professionally in France and returned to the United States where he played on the American Volleyball Players Pro Beach Tour.

He earned a 3A player rating on the AVP tour and had the opportunity to play against some of the giants of professional beach volleyball, including Karch Kiraly, Sinjin Smith, Randy Stoklos and Kent Steffes.

Highly involved in the international circuit and USA Volleyball, Restrepo served as co-head coach of one of two USA Volleyball under-22 select teams that toured Argentina in June 2005 and 2006.

Restrepo and his wife, the former Heidi Nichols, have two sons, Diego Ignacio and Javier Santiago.
