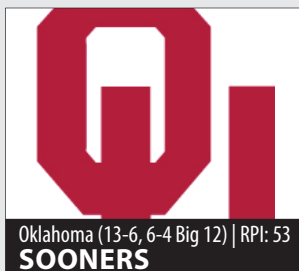

OU FACES FIFTH STRAIGHT RANKED OPPONENT

For the first time in school history, Oklahoma faces its fifth straight ranked opponent Saturday evening. First serve between the Sooners and fifth-ranked Nebraska is at 7 p.m. CT at Nebraska Coliseum.

SOONERS REWIND: SOONERS SWEET NO. 21 A&M

The University of Oklahoma volleyball team swept Texas A&M in straight sets [-23, -21, -23] on Wednesday night. Oklahoma statistically played evenly against Texas A&M but the Sooners produced a better hitting percentage at .257 to the Aggies' .185 clip. The match lasted just one hour, 32 minutes – aided due to the fact neither team produced a lengthy rally on the night. Oklahoma recorded a higher sideout percentage than the Aggies in all three sets, highlighted by a 71-60 percent margin in the second set. Sophomore **Caitlin Higgins** led OU with 11 kills, hitting .267 on the night.

SOONERS RAISE FUNDS FOR JIMMY EVEREST CENTER

University of Oklahoma volleyball fans contributed more than \$4,000 to the Jimmy Everest Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders at the Children's Hospital at OU Medical Center during the team's Pledge for a Cure event on Sept. 30. OKLAHOMA'S DEFENSE ONE OF NATION'S BEST

Oklahoma leads the Big 12 in digs per set with 17.75, a mark that is ninth in the nation. National leader NJIT averages 20.84 per set. Freshman **Maria Fernanda** ranks second in the league in digs per set and 42nd in the nation with 4.84 per set. Senior **Bridget Laplante** (234th, 3.51) also ranks in the top 250 nationally in digs per set.

FREUDENRICH RANKED IN TOP 120 NATIONALLY

Junior **Sarah Freudenrich** ranks in the top 120 nationally in blocks per set (72nd, 1.12/set) and hitting percentage (112th, .325). The top 250 student-athletes nationally were ranked in each category.

RESTREPO SIX WINS SHY OF #100

Oklahoma head coach **Santiago Restrepo** is six wins shy of his 100th victory at the school. In six seasons overseeing the Sooner program, Restrepo owns a mark of 94-76.

LAPLANTE'S CAREER ACCOMPLISHMENT

Senior **Bridget Laplante** recently reached the 1,000/1,000 mark for her career. Laplante (1,071 kills and 1,207 digs) becomes just the second Sooner under Restrepo to reach the plateau after Joanna Schmitt accomplished the feat from 2003-06 with 1,730 career kills and 1,177 career digs.

REMEMBERING JAVI: SOONERS CONTINUE MISSION

Throughout the 2009 season, the Oklahoma volleyball team continues their year-long mission to honor the son of their head coach, **Javier Restrepo**. When he was just one-and-a-half years old, **Javier Restrepo** was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL). In August 2008, he had a relapse and received a bone marrow transplant and then received a liver transplant but unfortunately relapsed again. Javi fought the disease like a true champion, nearly beating it on multiple occasions before it ultimately claimed his life on July 31, 2009.

SOONERS DOWN RANKED OPPONENTS BACK-TO-BACK

Oklahoma defeated No. 19 Baylor 3-2 on Oct. 17 and followed by sweeping No. 21 Texas A&M on Oct. 21. It marked the first time in school history the Sooners defeated ranked opponents in back-to-back matches. Under Santiago Restrepo, Oklahoma is now 8-41 against ranked opponents with six of those wins coming in the last three seasons. The most wins for OU over ranked opponents was a 3-6 mark in 2007.

OKLAHOMA UPSETS NO. 19 BAYLOR

The University of Oklahoma volleyball team defeated No. 19 Baylor 25-13, 21-25, 25-17, 19-25, 15-12 at McCasland Field House on Oct. 17. It marked Oklahoma's first win over a ranked opponent at home since defeating No. 14 Kansas State 3-1 on Oct. 19, 2007. Sophomore **Suzy Boulavsky** recorded her first career double-double with a career high 21 kills and a career-high 20 digs. Boulavsky hit a match-high .455, recording just one attack error in 44 attempts. She also brought down five total blocks, including one block solo.

BOULAVSKY NAMED OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

University of Oklahoma sophomore **Suzy Boulavsky** was named the Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 19. Boulavsky earned the honor after her stellar performance in Oklahoma's five-set upset of No. 19 Baylor on Saturday. The Houston, Texas, native recorded her first career double-double with a career high 21 kills and a career-high 20 digs. Boulavsky hit a match-high .455, recording just one attack error in 44 attempts. She also brought down five total blocks, including one block solo and one service ace. Boulavsky is the first Sooner to earn the offensive award since the league began distinguishing between offensive and defensive award winners. Freshman **Maria Fernanda** earned defensive accolades on Sept. 20 and was named Rookie of the Week on Oct. 5.

BOULAVSKY TABBED CVU.COM TOP PERFORMER

University of Oklahoma sophomore **Suzy Boulavsky** was also named a CVU.com Top Performer on Oct. 20.

SOONERS' MAGIC NUMBER TWO

After finishing last season two wins shy of a .500 mark (12-16), the 2009 Sooners are two wins away from clinching a winning season with a mark of at least 15-14.

BOULAVSKY EMERGING AS THREAT

Sophomore **Suzu Boulavsky** is finally getting her due as an offensive threat. Boulavsky leads OU with 179 kills and a 2.63 kps average on the year and has produced double-digit totals in eight matches.

FERNANDA EARNS ROOKIE AWARD

Freshman libero **María Fernanda** was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Week on Oct. 5, after earning conference Defensive Player of the Week honors on Sept. 21. Fernanda is the first Sooner to be named Rookie of the Week since **Sarah Freudenrich** earned the award Oct. 22, 2008. Fernanda is the only Sooner to be honored twice.

SIDING ON THE RIGHT

Oklahoma has produced a sideout percentage of 100 percent during two sets this season. The rare feat was accomplished against North Carolina and UT-Arlington. It has only been done six times under head coach **Santiago Restrepo**.

FERNANDA NAMED DEFENSIVE POW

University of Oklahoma freshman libero **María Fernanda** was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 20. Fernanda is the first Sooner to be named Defensive Player of the Week since Mariana Blum earned the honor on Sept. 10, 2007. Previously, teammates **Sarah Freudenrich** (Rookie of the Week; Oct. 22, 2008) and **Caitlin Higgins** (Offensive Player of the Week; Nov. 3, 2008) were honored with weekly awards.

EKWEREKWU AN OFFENSIVE LEADER

Junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** currently is second on the team with 2.55 kills per set and is third on the team with 11 service aces. She averages 0.99 blocks per set. Ekwerekwu has played in 67 sets this year and leads Oklahoma with 3.29 points per set.

DUO LEADING IN SERVICE ACES

Sophomores **Brianne Barker** and **Caitlin Higgins** lead the Sooners with 13 service aces each on the year. Junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** is third on the team with 11.

ON TRACK FOR A CAREER MARK

Sophomore setter **Brianne Barker** has 1,687 career assists already. OU has separate records for each scoring era but Barker's current mark would rank in the top five of both the sideout scoring and 30-point rally scoring records.

DELAYED HOMESTAND

After playing its 12 of its first 13 matches on the road, Oklahoma has six of its next nine matches at home beginning with the Sept. 30 Nebraska match. The streak ends with a home match against Kansas State on Oct. 31.

HOME SWEET HOME

Oklahoma played in the friendly confines of the McCasland Field House for the first time this season on Sept. 19. The last time OU played a home opener later was when the Sooners opened their 2003 home slate on Sept. 24 against Texas. The last time OU played their first two home matches later than Sept. 30 was also in 2003. The Sooners played their second home match against Nebraska on Oct. 4.

BOULAVSKY SETS MARK VS. TECH

Sophomore **Suzu Boulavsky** recorded a new career high with a .636 hitting percentage against Texas Tech. She also added 15 kills against the Red Raiders.

SOONERS DOMINATE RED RAIDERS

As a team, Oklahoma hit .320 against Texas Tech, marking the sixth time this season OU has hit at least .250 in a match. The Sooners have hit .300 or better on just two occasions - against TTU and a .347 clip against Rice.

EKWEREKWU KEEPS ON CLIMBING

Having already matched her season high of 14 kills once already, junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** bested the mark at Kansas with 15 kills. She matched her career high of a .562 hitting percentage at Colorado. Ekwerekwu had 11 kills in 16 attempts.

HIGGINS LEADS OU AT KANSAS

Sophomore **Caitlin Higgins** recorded a season-high 17 kills to lead OU at Kansas. Higgins also added 10 digs for her third double-double this season.

LAPLANTE SETS NEW DIGS MARK

With 27 digs at Kansas, senior **Bridget Laplante** surpassed her previous career best of 26 set at Kansas State on Oct. 18, 2007.

ALVA COMES UP BIG ON DEFENSE

Sophomore **Danielle Alva** saw time in all four sets at Kansas State. Alva's 14 digs were a career high, she added a service ace and assist in the win.

ONE-WOMAN WRECKING CREW

Junior **Sarah Freudenrich** is causing havoc in most matches she has played in this season. Freudenrich is averaging 2.40 kills per set and hitting a team-best .326. In 18 matches played this season, she has 10 or more kills in nine of those contests. Considering her offensive power is potent, what really makes her a valuable commodity is her blocking. She already has 77 blocks on the year, a 1.10 per set average. She has 13 block solos and 64 block assistos on the year.

GRAND HOMECOMING

Junior **Francie Ekwerekwu** had a stellar performance at the UT-Arlington Invitational, earning Most Valuable Player honors. In her return to her hometown, Ekwerekwu led OU with 3.12 kills per set and a .327 hitting percentage. She also recorded nine blocks (1.12/set), including one block solo. Her three service aces and seven digs also contributed to OU winning the tournament with a 2-0 mark.

SOONERS OUT-HITTING OPPONENTS

Oklahoma fares quite well in out-hitting opponents. The Sooners have hit .203 as team in the first 19 matches of the season. They have held opponents to a .149 clip. Defensively, OU is out-digging opponents 17.8 per set to 16.8 per set and 2.3 blocks per to 2.0 blocks per set.

OKLAHOMA AGAINST THE BIG 12

Oklahoma owns a winning series against four Big 12 opponents (Baylor, Kansas, Kansas State and Missouri) but has just an 89-181 mark in conference play.

SHOCKER CLASSIC ALL-TOURNEY

Freshman **María Fernanda** was named to the all-tournament for the Best Western Shocker Classic. It marks the second straight weekend the rookie was named among the best at an event. She was previously named to the all-tournament team at the Mizuno Invitational in Houston.

SOONERS HIT WELL AGAINST RICE

As a team, Oklahoma hit .347 against Rice on Aug. 28. The last time the Sooners produced a match with a better percentage was against Seton Hall on Aug. 25, 2007.

TRIO NAMED ALL-TOURNAMENT

Sophomore setter **Brianne Barker** was named the Most Valuable Player of the 2009 Mizuno Invitational hosted by Rice. Freshman LB **María Fernanda** was named to the team

as was senior OH **Bridget Laplante**. Barker averaged 9.85 assists per set and 3.31 digs. Fernanda led OU with 4.23 digs per set and Laplante led the team in kills with 34.

A TALE OF TWO SEASONS

When Oklahoma began the 2008 season, the Sooners returned just two starters. What a difference a year makes. To start the 2009 season, Oklahoma returns all six position starters. Of those six, one is a senior (OH **Bridget Laplante**). The team's only other senior is OH **Jackie Fotu**.

Entering his sixth season as the head coach at the University of Oklahoma, Santiago Restrepo has brought the program to new heights in just five seasons at the helm of the program. Pairing his international recruiting with his hard-working, blue collar coaching style, Restrepo has made a name for Oklahoma within the volleyball community.

The program felt Restrepo's impact as soon as he arrived on campus from his previous coaching stop at Southern Mississippi. In his first season at the helm of the Sooner program, he led the 2004 OU squad to a 12-17 record. No Sooner squad had produced a better record since the 1997 squad that reached the NCAA Tournament.

While the 2004 season caught many people's eye, nobody would predict what would happen two years later as Restrepo led the Sooners to the best season in school history. The 2006 season broke plenty of OU records and sparked momentum for the 2007 season.

Restrepo earned Big 12 and Regional Coach of the Year honors and was recognized by CVU.com as its National Coach of the Year as he led the Sooners to the best one-year turnaround in Big 12 history. Behind Restrepo's leadership, the Sooners recorded the best winning percentage in school history with a 28-6 record (.824) and finished a program-best second in the Big 12 Conference race (17-3).

Restrepo's successful 2006 season included OU's first-ever win over Texas in the series history as well as entry into the 2006 NCAA Tournament for only the fourth time in school history and the program's second Sweet 16 trip. Oklahoma finished the season as one of the best in the country with a No. 12 final ranking, its highest in history.

The Oklahoma players also felt the presence of Restrepo, individually, as all five seniors of the 2006 class earned All-Big 12 recognition while Joanna Schmitt and Eliane Santos became the second and third All-Americans in school history.

OU did not disappoint in 2007, either. After being picked ninth in the preseason coaches' poll, the Sooners advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive season. It also marked the second time in OU history that the Sooners made back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

Senior outside hitter Sarah Weiland represented OU on the All-Big 12 honorable mention team, while freshman Francie Ekwerekwu was named to the All-Big 12 freshman team. For their efforts in the classroom, five Sooners earned Academic All-Big 12 honors and three were named Academic All-District.

The history-making 2006 and 2007 seasons were remarkable, considering they followed a 2005 season that saw the Sooners finish 7-22.

However, Restrepo was getting his tools in place in 2005 for the historic next year as his recruiting skills shined with the addition of juco transfer Santos. In her junior season, Santos made her mark on Big 12 volleyball, finishing in the top five in the conference in blocks and kills and was named one of Collegiate Volleyball Update's top-five blockers in the country.

In 2008, he coached Brienne Barker and Caitlin Higgins to All-Big 12 Freshman team honors. Higgins became the first Oklahoma player to earn the Sports Imports/American Volleyball Coaches Association Division I National Player of the Week on Nov. 4.

Restrepo was named the fourth head coach in OU volleyball history on January 26, 2004. During the search process, OU Athletics Director Joe Castiglione was set on making a program-changing hire that fit perfectly into the values of the university.

A former NCAA Division I All-American at East Stroudsburg, Restrepo was also a four-time all-conference selection. He earned team Most Valuable Player honors all four years and was the co-winner of the Senior Athlete Award in 1986. He was inducted into the East Stroudsburg Hall of Fame in 2004.

Following his collegiate career, Restrepo played one season professionally in France and returned to the United States where he played on the American Volleyball Players Pro Beach Tour.

He earned a 3A player rating on the AVP tour and had the opportunity to play against some of the giants of professional beach volleyball, including Karch Kiraly, Sinjin Smith, Randy Stoklos and Kent Steffes.

Highly involved in the international circuit and USA Volleyball, Restrepo served as co-head coach of one of two USA Volleyball under-22 select teams that toured Argentina in June 2005 and 2006.

Restrepo and his wife, the former Heidi Nichols, have two sons, Diego Ignacio and Javier Santiago.
