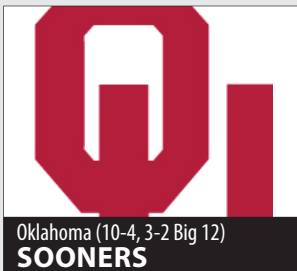

#### SOONERS CONTINUE HOMESTAND AGAINST TECH

After opening the season with 12 of their 13 matches on the road, Oklahoma continues its three-game homestand Saturday afternoon. First serve between the Sooners and Texas Tech is set for 3 p.m. CT. A free one hour clinic will be held for kids immediately following the match.

#### SOONERS REWIND: OU DROPS HARD-FOUGHT MATCH

The University of Oklahoma volleyball team dropped a hard fought 3-2 match to 10th-ranked Nebraska Wednesday evening. In front of a crowd of 2,046, the second largest ever to watch a match in McCasland Field House, the Sooners took the opening set 25-17. Nebraska answered winning the second 26-24 and third 25-15 before OU took the fourth 27-25. The Huskers won the fifth set 15-10. Sophomore setter **Brianne Barker** led OU with her 10th double-double this season, recording 42 assists and a career-high 25 digs.

#### OKLAHOMA'S DEFENSE ONE OF NATION'S BEST

Oklahoma leads the Big 12 in digs per set with 17.73, a mark that is seventh in the nation. National leader NJIT averages 21.17 per set. Freshman **Maria Fernanda** ranks second in the league in digs per set and 38th in the nation with 4.80 per set. Senior **Bridget Laplante** (194th, 3.74) also ranks in the top 250 nationally in digs per set.

#### FREUDENRICH RANKED IN TOP 100 NATIONALLY

Junior **Sarah Freudenrich** ranks in the top 100 nationally in blocks per set (76th, 1.15/set) and hitting percentage (142nd, .324). The top 250 student-athletes nationally were ranked in each category.

#### RESTREPO NINE WINS SHY OF #100

Oklahoma head coach **Santiago Restrepo** is nine wins shy of his 100th victory at the school. In six seasons overseeing the Sooner program, Restrepo owns a mark of 91-75.

#### LAPLANTE'S CAREER ACCOMPLISHMENT

Senior **Bridget Laplante** recently reached the 1,000/1,000 mark for her career. Laplante (1,044 kills and 1,157 digs) becomes just the second Sooner under Restrepo to reach the plateau after Joanna Schmitt accomplished the feat from 2003-06 with 1,730 career kills and 1,177 career digs.

#### REMEMBERING JAVI: SOONERS CONTINUE MISSION

Throughout the 2009 season, the Oklahoma volleyball team continues their year-long mission to honor the son of their head coach, **Santiago Restrepo**. When he was just one-and-a-half years old, **Javier Restrepo** was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL). In August 2008, he had a relapse and received a bone marrow transplant and then received a liver transplant but unfortunately relapsed again. Javi fought the disease like a true champion, nearly beating it on multiple occasions before it ultimately claimed his life on July 31, 2009.

#### SIDING ON THE RIGHT

Oklahoma has produced a sideout percentage of 100 percent during two sets this season. The rare feat was accomplished against North Carolina and UT-Arlington. It has only been done six times under head coach **Santiago Restrepo**.

**EKWEREKWU LEADING OFFENSE**

Junior **Francie Ekweroku** currently leads OU offensively with 2.69 kills per set and is second on the team with 11 service aces. She averages 1.00 blocks per set. Ekweroku has played in 49 sets this year and leads Oklahoma with 3.50 points per set. She had a five-match double-digit kill performance end against Nebraska.

**DUO LEADING IN SERVICE ACES**

Sophomore **Brianne Barker** leads the Sooners with 12 service aces on the year. Junior **Francie Ekweroku** is second on the team with 11. Ekweroku is consistently in the service rotation for the first time in her career. She previously only had one service attempt in 2008 at Southern California. Sophomore **Caitlin Higgins** is the other Sooner with double-digit aces with 10.

**DELAYED HOMESTAND**

After playing its 12 of its first 13 matches on the road, Oklahoma has six of its next nine matches at home beginning with the Sept. 30 Nebraska match.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

Oklahoma played in the friendly confines of the McCasland Field House for the first time this season on Sept. 19. The last time OU played a home opener later was when the Sooners opened their 2003 home slate on Sept. 24 against Texas. The last time OU played their first two home matches later than Sept. 30 was also in 2003. The Sooners played their second home match against Nebraska on Oct. 4.

**EKWEREKWU ON THE CLIMB**

Having already matched her season high of 14 kills once already, junior **Francie Ekweroku** bested the mark at Kansas with 15 kills. She matched her career high of a .562 hitting percentage at Colorado. Ekweroku had 11 kills in 16 attempts.

**HIGGINS LEADS OU AT KANSAS**

Sophomore **Caitlin Higgins** recorded a season-high 17 kills to lead OU at Kansas. Higgins also added 10 digs for her third double-double this season.

**LAPLANTE SETS NEW DIGS MARK**

With 27 digs at Kansas, senior **Bridget Laplante** surpassed her previous career best of 26 set at Kansas State on Oct. 18, 2007.

**BOULAVSKY GETTING IT DONE**

Sophomore **Suzu Boulavsky** was OU's X-factor in the win at Kansas State. Boulavsky added 12 kills.

**ALVA COMES UP BIG ON DEFENSE**

Sophomore **Danielle Alva** saw time in all four sets at Kansas State. Alva's 14 digs were a career high, she added a service ace and assist in the win.

**HIGGINS GETS BACK IN HER GROOVE**

Sophomore **Caitlin Higgins** had an excellent match against UT-Arlington. Higgins recorded her second double-double of the season with 13 kills and a career-high 23 digs.

**ONE-WOMAN WRECKING CREW**

Junior **Sarah Freudenrich** is causing havoc in most matches she has played in this season. Freudenrich is averaging 2.35 kills per set and hitting a team-best .331. In 13 matches played this season, she has 10 or more kills in seven of those contests. Considering her offensive power is potent, what really makes her a valuable commodity is her blocking. She already has 58 blocks on the year, a 1.12 per set average. She has six block solos and 52 block assiston the year.

**GRAND HOMECOMING**

Junior **Francie Ekweroku** had a stellar performance at the UT-Arlington Invitational, earning Most Valuable Player honors. In her return to her hometown, Ekweroku led OU with 3.12 kills per set and a .327 hitting percentage. She also recorded nine blocks (1.12/set), including one block solo. Her three service aces and seven digs also contributed to OU winning the tournament with a 2-0 mark.

**SOONERS OUT-HITTING OPPONENTS**

Oklahoma fares quite well in out-hitting opponents. The Sooners have hit .212 as team in the first 14 matches of the season. They have held opponents to a .139 clip.

**OKLAHOMA AGAINST THE BIG 12**

Oklahoma owns a winning series against four Big 12 opponents (Baylor, Kansas, Kansas State and Missouri) but has just an 86-179 mark in conference play.

**SHOCKER CLASSIC ALL-TOURNEY**

Freshman **María Fernanda** was named to the all-tournament for the Best Western Shocker Classic. It marks the second straight weekend the rookie was named among the best at an event. She was previously named to the all-tournament team at the Mizuno Invitational in Houston.

**BOULAVSKY NETS CAREER HIGH**

Sophomore **Suzu Boulavsky** netted a career-high 15 kills against Central Arkansas.

**SOONERS HIT WELL AGAINST RICE**

As a team, Oklahoma hit .347 against Rice on Aug. 28. The last time the Sooners produced a match with a better percentage was against Seton Hall on Aug. 25, 2007.

**TRIO NAMED ALL-TOURNAMENT**

Sophomore setter **Brianne Barker** was named the Most Valuable Player of the 2009 Mizuno Invitational hosted by Rice. Freshman LB **María Fernanda** was named to the team as was senior OH **Bridget Laplante**. Barker averaged 9.85 assists per set and 3.31 digs. Fernanda led OU with 4.23 digs per set and Laplante led the team in kills with 34.

**A TALE OF TWO SEASONS**

When Oklahoma began the 2008 season, the Sooners returned just two starters. What

a difference a year makes. To start the 2009 season, Oklahoma returns all six position starters. Of those six, one is a senior (OH **Bridget Laplante**). The team's only other senior is OH **Jackie Fotu**.

Entering his sixth season as the head coach at the University of Oklahoma, Santiago Restrepo has brought the program to new heights in just five seasons at the helm of the program. Pairing his international recruiting with his hard-working, blue collar coaching style, Restrepo has made a name for Oklahoma within the volleyball community.

The program felt Restrepo's impact as soon as he arrived on campus from his previous coaching stop at Southern Mississippi. In his first season at the helm of the Sooner program, he led the 2004 OU squad to a 12-17 record. No Sooner squad had produced a better record since the 1997 squad that reached the NCAA Tournament.

While the 2004 season caught many people's eye, nobody would predict what would happen two years later as Restrepo led the Sooners to the best season in school history. The 2006 season broke plenty of OU records and sparked momentum for the 2007 season.

Restrepo earned Big 12 and Regional Coach of the Year honors and was recognized by CVU.com as its National Coach of the Year as he led the Sooners to the best one-year turnaround in Big 12 history. Behind Restrepo's leadership, the Sooners recorded the best winning percentage in school history with a 28-6 record (.824) and finished a program-best second in the Big 12 Conference race (17-3).

Restrepo's successful 2006 season included OU's first-ever win over Texas in the series history as well as entry into the 2006 NCAA Tournament for only the fourth time in school history and the program's second Sweet 16 trip. Oklahoma finished the season as one of the best in the country with a No. 12 final ranking, its highest in history.

The Oklahoma players also felt the presence of Restrepo, individually, as all five seniors of the 2006 class earned All-Big 12 recognition while Joanna Schmitt and Eliane Santos became the second and third All-Americans in school history.

OU did not disappoint in 2007, either. After being picked ninth in the preseason coaches' poll, the Sooners advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive season. It also marked the second time in OU history that the Sooners made back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

Senior outside hitter Sarah Weiland represented OU on the All-Big 12 honorable mention team, while freshman Francie Ekwerekwu was named to the All-Big 12 freshman team. For their efforts in the classroom, five Sooners earned Academic All-Big 12 honors and three were named Academic All-District.

The history-making 2006 and 2007 seasons were remarkable, considering they followed a 2005 season that saw the Sooners finish 7-22.

However, Restrepo was getting his tools in place in 2005 for the historic next year as his recruiting skills shined with the addition of juco transfer Santos. In her junior season, Santos made her mark on Big 12 volleyball, finishing in the top five in the conference in blocks and kills and was named one of Collegiate Volleyball Update's top-five blockers in the country.

In 2008, he coached Brienne Barker and Caitlin Higgins to All-Big 12 Freshman team honors. Higgins became the first Oklahoma player to earn the Sports Imports/American Volleyball Coaches Association Division I National Player of the Week on Nov. 4.

Restrepo was named the fourth head coach in OU volleyball history on January 26, 2004. During the search process, OU Athletics Director Joe Castiglione was set on making a program-changing hire that fit perfectly into the values of the university.

A former NCAA Division I All-American at East Stroudsburg, Restrepo was also a four-time all-conference selection. He earned team Most Valuable Player honors all four years and was the co-winner of the Senior Athlete Award in 1986. He was inducted into the East Stroudsburg Hall of Fame in 2004.

Following his collegiate career, Restrepo played one season professionally in France and returned to the United States where he played on the American Volleyball Players Pro Beach Tour.

He earned a 3A player rating on the AVP tour and had the opportunity to play against some of the giants of professional beach volleyball, including Karch Kiraly, Sinjin Smith, Randy Stoklos and Kent Steffes.

Highly involved in the international circuit and USA Volleyball, Restrepo served as co-head coach of one of two USA Volleyball under-22 select teams that toured Argentina in June 2005 and 2006.

Restrepo and his wife, the former Heidi Nichols, have two sons, Diego Ignacio and Javier Santiago.
