ABOUT THE GAME

- ▶ No. 19 TCU hosts Oklahoma in a Saturday 4 p.m. contest on FOX.
- ▶ Over the last three seasons, TCU has the Big 12's best overall record (26-4) and conference mark (16-3).
- ▶ All four Big 12 meetings between TCU and Oklahoma have been decided by seven points or less, a total of 15 points. The Sooners have won three of those games.
- ▶ The game features the all-time winningest coaches at both schools. TCU's Gary Patterson has 146 victories at TCU, while Bob Stoops has 180 for Oklahoma.
- ▶ Patterson and Stoops are two of just three active head coaches, all from the Big 12, with at least 146 wins at their current schools. Kansas State's Bill Snyder has 195.
- ▶ TCU has opened with a record of 3-1 or better for the eighth time in the last nine seasons and 12th time in 16 years under Patterson. The Horned Frogs are looking to go 4-1 or better for the seventh time in nine years.
- ▶ TCU is playing at home for the fourth time in five games this season. Ten of the Horned Frogs' 12 contests in 2016 are in Texas.

SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ Oklahoma holds a 10-5 series lead over TCU.
- ▶ No. 25 TCU won 37-33 over No. 3 Oklahoma in 2014, the last time the teams played in Fort Worth.
- ▶ The Horned Frogs are 2-5 versus the Sooners in Fort Worth, 3-4 in Norman and 0-1 in Oklahoma City.
- ▶ The first game in the series was a 34-19 Sooners' win in Oklahoma City in 1944.
- ▶ TCU's 17-10 win at No. 5 Oklahoma in 2005 was its first victory over an opponent ranked that high since a 6-0 decision at No. 1 Texas in 1961.

HOME SWEET HOME

- ▶ In 16 seasons under head coach Gary Patterson, TCU is 76-15 at Amon G. Carter Stadium.
- ▶ The Horned Frogs have won 15 of their last 16 home games.
- ▶ TCU's 14-game home winning streak, which was third nationally behind only Florida State (22) and Clemson (18), was snapped in the 41-38 double-overtime loss to Arkansas.

FAMILIAR NAMES

- ▶ TCU defensive tackle Aaron Curry is the son of Aaron Curry, the 24th all-time leading scorer in Oklahoma men's basketball history with 1,237 points (1977-80).
- ▶ The younger Curry is one of four players, including three Horned Frogs (L.J. Collier, Tipa Galeai), tied for the Big 12 lead with 2 1/2 sacks.
- ▶ Curry tops TCU defensive linemen with 17 tackles.

TCU NOTABLES

- ▶ The Horned Frogs have just eight scholarship seniors on this year's team.
- ▶ TCU has finished in the top 10 in back-to-back seasons and five times in the last eight years. In 15 seasons under head coach Gary Patterson, TCU has posted six top-10 finishes and 10 in the top 25.
- ▶ TCU has reached the 11-win mark eight times in the last 11 seasons.
- ▶ Dating back to last year, three of TCU's last six games have gone to multiple overtimes: a 28-21 win versus Baylor in double OT, a 47-41 victory over Oregon in triple OT at the Valero Alamo Bowl and a 41-38 defeat in double OT to Arkansas Sept. 10.
- ▶ TCU has at least one sack in a school-record 34 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the nation (Ohio State, 38).
- ▶ TCU leads the Big 12 with 14 sacks while tying for 14th nationally with its average of 3.5 per game.
- ▶ The Horned Frogs rank fourth nationally in total offense at 576.0 yards per game.
- ▶ Over the last two games, TCU's defense has allowed just 11.5 points and 337.5 yards per game.
- ▶ Kenny Hill is the only player to rank in the top 10 nationally in total offense (413.2 yards per game), passing yards (371.8 yards per game) and rushing touchdowns (6).
- ▶ Kyle Hicks leads TCU in rushing (314) and receptions (20). He is one of two players nationally with at least 310 yards rushing and 220 receiving.
- ▶ Hill (6) and Hicks (5) are tied for second nationally in most rushing TDs (11) by a pair of teammates.
- ▶ Over the last two games, John Diarse has 13 receptions for 236 yards (18.2 avg.) and a touchdown.
- ▶ Ty Summers leads the Big 12 in tackles with 39. He has been in double figures in stops the last three games.

NORMAN, Okla. - Bram Kohlhausen's two-point conversion attempt was batted away by Oklahoma's Steven Parker with less than a minute left and No. 18 TCU fell to No. 7 Oklahoma, 30-29.

After trailing 30-13 in the fourth quarter, TCU had a chance to tie the game after Kohlhausen's 14-yard touchdown pass to Emanuel Porter with 51 seconds remaining. Instead, the Horned Frogs went for the win by attempting the two-point conversion but were turned away by Parker's late play.

TCU's comeback began with an 86-yard scoring strike from Kohlhausen to KaVontae Turpin, followed by a 43-yard field goal by Jaden Oberkrom.

The Horned Frogs played without offensive stars Trevone Boykin, Josh Doctson and Joey Hunt and were victimized by four turnovers, leading to 24 Oklahoma points.

► In 2016, TCU is one of just two FBS teams (Bowling Green) to lose a 3,000-yard passer (Trevone Boykin), 1,000-yard rusher (Aaron Green) and 1,000-yard receiver (Josh Doctson) from last season.

► TCU is one of only four FBS teams to lose its top-four scorers (Jaden Oberkrom, Doctson, Green and Boykin) from last season. The others are Bowling Green, Navy and Toledo.

► Kenny Hill is tied for the Big 12 lead in rushing touchdowns with six. Only three quarterbacks have led the conference in rushing scores: Bryce Petty (Baylor, 2013), Collin Klein (Kansas State, 2011, 2012) and Eric Crouch (Nebraska, 1999, 2000, 2001).

► Hill has a rushing touchdown in three of four games this season.

FROG OFFENSIVE NOTES

IMPRESSIVE DEBUT

▶ In his TCU debut, Kenny Hill became the first player nationally with 400 yards passing, two touchdown passes and three rushing scores in a game since Michigan's Devin Gardner against Indiana in 2013.

▶ Hill completed 33-of-49 passes for 439 yards while adding 45 yards rushing on seven carries.

MAKING HISTORY

▶ Kenny Hill became one of only two quarterbacks nationally since 1996 to pass for at least 800 yards and rush for 100 yards in his team's opening two games.

▶ During that stretch, Hill posted top-10 efforts in TCU history for total offense. Hill's 484 yards versus South Dakota State rank seventh, while his 470 against Arkansas place ninth.

CHARTING HILL

▶ In his opening four contests as a Horned Frog, Kenny Hill posted two of the top eight games in TCU history for passing yards. His 452 against SMU ranked sixth, while his 439 versus South Dakota State is eighth.

▶ Hill had at least 31 completions in three of the opening four games. His 36 completions versus Arkansas tied for third by a Horned Frog, while the 33 against South Dakota State tied for seventh.

HUMAN HIGHLIGHT FILM

▶ Through the opening two games, KaVontae Turpin was leading the nation in all-purpose yards at 236.0 per game. He then left the Iowa State game early due to injury and is now third in the Big 12 and 13th nationally at 169.3 yards per game.

▶ He is on pace to break LaDainian Tomlinson's TCU career record of 6,337 all-purpose yards (1997-00). Included below is a look at their first two seasons:

▶ Turpin totaled a career-best 295 all-purpose yards (126 receiving, 136 kick returns, 33 punt returns) against Arkansas.

▶ In each of the opening two games, Turpin tied a career high with seven receptions.

▶ Turpin's 126 yards receiving versus Arkansas were 12 shy of a career-high 138 set last season against Texas.

▶ Turpin is averaging 19.5 yards each time he touches the ball in 2016, an increase from a 15.3 mark last year.

▶ At 5-foot-9, Turpin is the shortest returning player from a Power 5 team to have at least eight touchdown catches last season.

TURPIN'S MONROE BUDDY

▶ Graduate transfer John Diarse, who played his first two seasons at LSU, is from the same Monroe (La.) Neville High School that produced KaVontae Turpin.

► Since the NCAA began tracking statistics in 1937, TCU trails only Alabama for the most times leading the nation in total defense. The Crimson Tide have been No. 1 six times, while all five No. 1 rankings for the Horned Frogs are in the last 16 seasons.

► In 2010, TCU became just the third program in NCAA history to top the nation in total defense in three consecutive seasons (2008-10). The others are Toledo (1969-71) and Oklahoma (1985-87).

► In 16 seasons with Gary Patterson as head coach, TCU is 101-3 when allowing 17 points or less.

► TCU held five opponents, including three from the Big 12, to 17 points or less last season.

KaVontae Turpin, TCU	32.8

► Turpin is 13th in the nation in all-purpose yards at 169.3 yards per game. Through two games, he was leading the country at 236.0 yards per game. He then left the Iowa State contest early due to injury.

► Turpin's career-long 64-yard kickoff return, with less than a minute to play in regulation, against Arkansas set up a potential game-winning field goal.

► Turpin's 81-yard second-quarter punt return for a touchdown against South Dakota State was the second of his career. He had a 49-yard punt return for a score versus Kansas last season.

► Turpin's touchdown in the South Dakota State game was a momentum changer, as the Horned Frogs were trailing 17-7 with just over three minutes remaining in the first half.

► Turpin's 81-yard effort tied for the sixth-longest punt return in TCU history. It was the Horned Frogs' longest since LaVar Veale went 85 yards versus Nevada in 2000.

► Turpin's two punt returns for touchdowns leave him one shy of tying TCU's career record of three:

► Turpin is the first Horned Frog with two punt returns for touchdowns since current San Francisco 49er Jeremy Kerley had a pair of scores in the 2009 campaign.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

► As a true freshman in 2015, KaVontae Turpin was the only player in the nation in the top 25 in kickoff returns (27.0 average) and punt returns (10.6 average).

► Turpin was second in the Big 12 and tied for 14th nationally in kickoff returns. He ranked second in the conference and 23rd in the FBS in punt returns.

► Turpin's 49-yard punt return at Kansas was TCU's first for a touchdown since Cameron Echols-Luper at KU in 2014.

► Turpin's 27.0-yard kickoff return average was the highest by a Horned Frog (minimum 10 attempts) since All-American Greg McCoy had a 30.6 mark in 2011.

WHITE SHINES AT SMU

► Filling in for an injured KaVontae Turpin at SMU, Desmon White had a career long 31-yard punt return on his first attempt. He totaled three returns for 74 yards (24.7 average).

► White is 12th nationally in punt returns with a 17.2 average, making TCU the only school in the country with two players in the top 12.

► White added a career-high six receptions for 49 yards at SMU to give him 123 all-purpose yards on the night.

REMEMBER WHEN?

► Deanté Gray set a TCU single-game record with 160 punt return yards, including a 70-yard touchdown, on five attempts in his collegiate debut in the 2012 season opener against Grambling State.

► The previous mark of 146 yards on seven returns was set by Lindy Berry versus Miami in 1947.

► Gray's 70-yard return for a touchdown came on his first collegiate touch. It was just 1:59 into the game after a 3-and-out on Grambling State's opening series.

► Gray had the first punt return for a touchdown by a Horned Frog since Jeremy Kerley went 69 yards against Colorado State in 2009.

THE STAPLES

► With the graduation of a pair of four-year starters in place-kicker Jaden Oberkrom and punter Ethan Perry, the TCU kicking game is in new hands for 2016.

► Oberkrom, a 2015 All-American, is the TCU and Big 12 career record-holder with 79 field goals.

NEW LEG

► Sophomore place-kicker Jonathan Song appeared in one game last season, converting the final PAT and adding a pair of kickoffs in the 70-7 win over Stephen F. Austin.

► Song was 6-of-6 on field goals, with a long of 56, as a senior at All Saints' Episcopal School in Fort Worth. He made all 40 of his PAT attempts.

NEW FACES

► With an injury to Jonathan Song, TCU has debuted a trio of walk-on place-kickers this season.

► Ryan Graf (5-of-6) and Brandon Hatfield (3-of-3) have combined to go 8-of-9 on field goals.

► Graf, a Los Angeles native who chose TCU over Yale, has converted all 20 of his PAT attempts. He had a career long 46-yard field goal at SMU and has at least one field goal in each game this season.

► Brandon Hatfield's first career field-goal attempt was a successful 37-yard effort for TCU's final points against Iowa State.

► Cole Bunce, from San Jose, Calif., has handled the kickoff duties and recorded nine touchbacks while helping limit opponents to a 19.0 kickoff return average.

STRONG FOOT

► Adam Nunez's 41.9-yard average on punts is the best by a Horned Frog since Ethan Perry had a 44.5 mark in 2012.

► Since 2002, the 41.9 average by Nunez is third best by a Horned Frog. He has a 38.2 net.

► Nunez has placed six punts inside the opponent 20 with just one touchback.

► Nunez had a 45.0 average on six punts versus Iowa State with three placed inside the 20. The Cyclones had a minus-2 yards on four punt returns.

THE COVERAGE GAME

► TCU is allowing just a 19.0-yard average on kickoff returns and 5.1 on punt returns.

► Last season, the Horned Frogs were second in the Big 12 and fifth nationally in punt return defense (2.5 yards). TCU opponents had just 13 punt returns for 33 yards.

► The Horned Frogs set an NCAA record in holding opponents to minus-9 yards on punt returns in 2014.

▶ Defensive end Josh Carraway said of Morris, "We always stop whatever we're doing when he's about to lift."

FROG HOPS

▶ TCU is 32-11 in regular-season games following a loss under Gary Patterson.

▶ The Horned Frogs have won 12 of their last 13 regular-season games after an open date.

▶ TCU is 10-6 in short-week games under Patterson.

▶ TCU ended Boise State's 35-game home winning streak, the longest in the nation, with a 36-35 victory in 2011. The Broncos had won 65 straight regular-season home contests and 47 consecutive conference home games.

▶ TCU snapped Utah's Mountain West record 21-game home winning streak with a 47-7 victory in 2010.

▶ With a 17-10 win in Norman in 2005, TCU gave Oklahoma one of its nine home losses since 2001. The 10 points by the Sooners mark their fewest in a home game under head coach Bob Stoops.

▶ Hunt is the younger brother of former TCU All-Big 12 center and current Seattle Seahawk Joey Hunt.

HOME SWEET HOME

▶ The \$164 million rebuild of Amon G. Carter Stadium, completed in 2012, was funded entirely by donor support and features a seating capacity of 45,000.

▶ The six Founders Club suites, located at midfield on the concourse level, were sold at \$15 million each to provide lead gifts totaling \$90 million.

▶ There are 25 suites, all sold, on the west side.

▶ In August 2013, Yahoo! Sports ranked Amon G. Carter Stadium as the best stadium in the Big 12.

HORNED FROGS FEVER

▶ The Oklahoma game will mark TCU's third sellout in four home games this season and 27 of the past 37.

▶ TCU ranked third nationally among Power 5 schools in percent of capacity last season. The Horned Frogs averaged 46,767 fans per game, 103.9 percent of the 45,000 capacity for Amon G. Carter Stadium.

▶ Three of the five largest crowds in stadium history are in the last two seasons. The 48,091 for the Arkansas game ranked fifth.

▶ Five of TCU's six road games last season saw its opponent have a top-6 attendance in school history. TCU played in front of the largest crowd ever in Minnesota's TCF Bank Stadium (54,147), second-best at Texas Tech's Jones AT&T Stadium (61,283), third-largest at both Oklahoma's Gaylord Family - Oklahoma Memorial Stadium (85,821) and Kansas State's Bill

Snyder Family Stadium (53,671) and a tie for sixth at Oklahoma State's Boone Pickens Stadium (59,061).

▶ TCU has sold out of football season tickets four times in the last five campaigns, including this season's total of 34,000.

▶ TCU set a school record for season ticket sales in five of the last seven years. Nine of the top 10 home crowds in TCU history are in the last five seasons.

▶ Nearly 35,000 TCU fans traveled to the 2011 Rose Bowl. Over 20,000 made the trip the previous year to the Fiesta Bowl. At its first New Year's Six bowl, TCU had 15,000 fans at the 2014 Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl.

BOWL MAINSTAYS

▶ TCU has reached a bowl game in 16 of the last 18 seasons. The Horned Frogs have earned a bowl trip in 13 of Gary Patterson's 15 seasons as head coach.

▶ TCU is one of 20 schools to make at least 13 bowl appearances in the last 15 seasons. Gary Patterson is TCU's all-time winningest football coach, while his 146-48 record (.753) ranks fifth among active coaches nationally with a minimum of 10 years experience.

Patterson received 10 national coach of the year honors in 2014 and has totaled 20 such awards over the last seven years, including nine in the 2009 season when he led TCU to its first BCS game. The third-longest tenured head coach in the FBS, he is one of just three active coaches with 146 or more victories at their current schools.

Patterson has led TCU to conference championships in three different leagues (C-USA, Mountain West, Big 12). He also won coach of the year honors in all three conferences.

In August 2011, Patterson was named the nation's top coach by Sports Illustrated and ESPN The Magazine. He led TCU to back-to-back BCS appearances in the 2009 and 2010 seasons, including a 2011 Rose Bowl championship.

Patterson has produced at least 10 wins in 10 of the last 14 years, including nine seasons of 11 or more victories. He has helped lead the Horned Frogs to eight conference titles and 16 bowl games in 18 years.

In 15 seasons as TCU's head coach, Patterson has had 41 players drafted with 93 in NFL camps.

FORT WORTH, Texas - Kenny Hill accounted for 484 yards of offense and five touchdowns and KaVontae Turpin sparked the 13th-ranked Horned Frogs with an 81-yard punt return in a 59-41 victory over South Dakota State.

It was TCU's 15th straight home-opening win. Hill was 33 of 49 for 439 yards with two touchdown passes, ran for three scores and converted a critical third down with a 13-yard scramble while the Horned Frogs were up four points in the fourth quarter. That drive ended on a 46-yard scoring pass to Taj Williams for a 52-41 lead. Williams, who had 11 catches for 158 yards, made the grab after the ball deflected several yards forward off the hands of TCU receiver Desmon White and South Dakota State linebacker Dallas Brown.

Turpin started the comeback from the surprising second-quarter deficit with his return, leading the Horned Frogs to their 14th straight home win, third in the nation behind Florida State (21) and Clemson (16). The 5-foot-9 speedster tied a career-high with seven receptions while adding a 33-yard run and finishing with 177 all-purpose yards.

TCU totaled 662 yards of offense and converted 11 of 15 third-down attempts.

Allen led the Razorbacks (2-0) to the tying score in the final two minutes of regulation, throwing a touchdown pass to Keon Hatcher and then catching the tying two-point conversion from the receiver with 1:03 remaining.

The Horned Frogs (1-1) rallied from 13 down in the fourth quarter to take a 28-20 lead, but couldn't hang on as their 14-game home winning streak ended in the first meeting of these former Southwest Conference rivals since 1991.

TCU's Kenny Hill threw for 377 yards and an overtime TD to Taj Williams and also had 93 yards rushing and two scores. But he couldn't get the Horned Frogs in the end zone in the second OT, and they settled for Ryan Graf's 37-yard field goal.

KaVontae Turpin set up both of TCU's fourth-quarter touchdowns with long catches, including on the go-ahead drive from midfield after he added nearly 25 yards on a dazzling punt return when he spun out of several tackles while somehow keeping both knees off the ground.

After the Razorbacks got even, Turpin returned the kickoff 64 yards, but Arkansas' Dan Skipper blocked Graf's 28-yard field goal try with 10 seconds remaining.
