## NO. 25/25 FLORIDA 84, OKLAHOMA 52 JANUARY 28, 2017 • POSTGAME NOTES

---

- Oklahoma (8-12, 2-6 Big 12) fell to No. 25/25 Florida (16-5, 6-2 SEC), 84-52, on Saturday at Lloyd Noble Center. With the loss, the Sooners are now 3-1 when playing in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge.
  - Sophomore guard **Rashard Odomes** led Oklahoma in scoring with 13 points on 5-of-9 shooting to go with six rebounds. Odomes has scored in double figures in five of his last seven games.
  - Freshman guard **Kameron McGusty** tallied double-digit scoring for the eighth-straight game with 10 points on 5-of-10 shooting in 29 minutes. His eight consecutive double-digit outings is the longest such streak by any Sooner this season. Isaiah Cousins and Buddy Hield were the only members of last season's team with a double-figure scoring streak of at least eight games. McGusty is leading OU's scoring efforts during the month of January with an average of 15.1 points per game on 43.4 percent shooting.
  - Freshman forward **Kristian Doolittle** produced eight points and nine rebounds. Coming off of a pair of double-double performances – including 29 points at Texas on Monday – Doolittle is averaging 17.3 points and 11.3 rebounds in his past three games. Doolittle has pulled down at least five rebounds in every game in January.
  - The Sooners are now 0-2 all-time against Florida. In the only previous meeting with the Gators (1995), Florida defeated the Sooners in the All-College Classic under head coach **Lon Kruger**. Kruger coached the Gators from 1990 to 1996, racking up a record of 104-80 with a trip to the 1994 Final Four.
  - Next up, Oklahoma and Oklahoma State will meet on the hardwood for the 232nd edition of Bedlam basketball on Monday, Jan. 30. The Sooners and Cowboys will tip at 8 p.m. CT on ESPN's Big Monday inside Lloyd Noble Center. The matchup is OU's second-straight week with a Big Monday game and third consecutive contest televised on ESPN.
  - The Sooners have won 17 of the last 24 Bedlam meetings, including the past seven contests. OU owns a 136-95 all-time advantage in the series and boasts an 84-26 lead when played in Norman. Oklahoma has won 15 of the last 16 Bedlam battles in Norman, including the last 12 meetings. The Sooners have not lost a Bedlam game at home since 2004.
  - OU is 9-2 against the Cowboys during the Lon Kruger era. Monday's meeting with OSU will be the first matchup since Brad Underwood took over as head coach. Both Kruger and Underwood played collegiately at Kansas State.
