First Serve...

The University of Oklahoma volleyball team hits the road for the first time this season at the Bobcat Invitational, hosted by Ohio University. The Sooners face High Point Friday, September 1 and 11 a.m. CT and the host Bobcats at 6:30 p.m. The weekend wraps up against SEC foe Georgia on Saturday, September 2 at 10 a.m.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma went 1-2 at its annual NIKE Invitational at McCasland Field House last weekend. The Sooners played to a five-set loss to Seton Hall in the season opener before grabbing a three-set win over Northwestern State. The weekend concluded with a four-set loss to former Big 12 rival and current Pac-12 opponent Colorado. Junior outside hitter **Alyssa Enneking**, who didn't see the court until late in set two of the opener, finished with a team-high 40 kills, averaging 3.64 per set, and hitting .337 with a 2.00 digs per set average. Junior **Morgan Miller** played all six rotations as a setter and outside hitter; averaging 2.42 kills, 2.25 digs and 4.08 assists per set. Fellow junior **Audrey Alford** split the setting duties with Miller and averaged a team-best 5.08 assists to go with 1.58 digs per set.

Triple-Double...

In her Sooner debut, **Morgan Miller** recorded the first triple-double at Oklahoma in seven years. **Brianne Barker** was the last to do so on December 4, 2010. She posted 10 kills, 57 assists and 14 digs in a NCAA Tournament First Round win over No. 22 Tulsa in Norman. Miller accomplished the feat with 12 kills, 17 assists and 15 digs to go with five blocks against Seton Hall (Aug. 25). She nearly duplicated the effort in the finale against Colorado (Aug. 26). Miller went for nine kills, 16 assists and eight digs against the Buffaloes.

Scouting the Panthers...

High Point, which is coming off a 23-win 2016 and trip to the NCAA Tournament as the Big South Champion, went 1-2 last weekend in a tournament hosted by Northern Illinois. The Panthers opened play with a four-set loss to the host before losses to Cal Poly and Dayton. Outside hitter **Haley Barnes** led the HPU attack with 2.82 kills and added 2.64 digs per set. Middle blocker **Molly Livingston** hit a team-best .390 with 2.73 kills and 1.45 blocks per set. Libero **Abby Bottomley** picked up 4.55 digs per set.

Scouting the Bobcats...

Ohio is off to a 3-1 start following an undefeated weekend in tournament play at Samford, which included a five-set win over the host. The Bobcats suffered a four-set setback on the road Tuesday night to Dayton for their first loss of the season. Outside hitter **Jaime Kosiorek** and **Lizze Stephens** have powered the Ohio attack with averages of 3.92 and 3.13 kills per set. Setter **Vera Giacomazzi** has managed the offense through her first four collegiate matches by averaging 10.67 assists to go with 2.13 digs per set.

Scouting the Bulldogs...

Georgia was in action for four matches at its home tournament last weekend and enters this weekend 4-0. The Bulldogs, who did not drop a set, are hitting .311 as a team, while holding opponents to a .108 attack rate. Outside hitter **T'ara Ceasar** leads UGA with 4.22 kills per set, followed closely by fellow outside hitter **Rachel Ritchie** at 4.11. Middle blocker **Majesti Bass** is hitting a team-high .386, ahead of Ceasar's .351 hitting percentage.

All-Time vs. the Field...

Oklahoma's weekend opener against High Point will mark the first match-up between the two schools in volleyball. The Sooners then face Ohio, which OU defeated in straight-sets at the 2016 NIKE Invitational. The match was the first meeting between the two programs. Meanwhile, Georgia holds a 4-0 lead in the all-time series against Oklahoma, but the two teams have not taken the floor together since 1993.

Last Time vs. Ohio...

After having its seven-match win-streak to start the 2016 season snapped a day earlier, Oklahoma bounced back with a 3-0 win over Ohio (Sept. 9, 2016) at the NIKE Invitational. Middle blocker **Marion Hazelwood** was error-free for the Sooners with 10 kills and a .556 attack rates. The fifth set of the season for OU came by scores of 25-12, 25-19 and 25-18. The Sooners hit a collective .337 for the match with **Kimmy Gardiner** and **Alyssa Enneking** joining Hazelwood in double figures with 11 and 10 kills, respectively.

Against the SEC...

After a 3-2 loss at No. 10 Florida (8/30/14), OU had a four-match win streak against SEC opponents snapped. Oklahoma rebounded with a five-set win over Mississippi State (9/3/16) to end a brief two-match slide vs. the SEC. The Sooners are 20-27 all-time vs. the SEC and 9-5 with Restrepo calling the shots. The Sooners most common opponents from the SEC include LSU (3-8) and Arkansas (4-3).

Season Openers...

OU is 21-23 all-time in season openers following a 3-2 loss to Seton Hall (Aug. 25) at the NIKE Invitational. The Sooners are 10-4 in season-opening matches since the arrival of **Santiago Restrepo** in 2004. Oklahoma opened at home in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2011 and 2012.

Preseason Team...

Outside hitter **Madison Drescher** was the lone Sooner voted by the league's coaches to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. Drescher's numbers against league opponents surpassed her overall numbers in 2016 with a 2.30 kills per set average as she hit .217 and added 0.62 blocks per set.

Big 12 Poll Position...

Oklahoma finished seventh in the 2016 standings and was predicted to finish eighth by the Big 12 coaches in the preseason poll. After five straight years as the unanimous No. 1, Texas is first in the rankings, but the Longhorns claimed just six first place votes, while last year's regular season champion Kansas is No. 2 with three first place votes. OU's ranking is the lowest since being picked eighth in 2008 in an 11-team Big 12.

Against the Pac-12...

The Pac-12 has held a firm grip over Oklahoma with a 24-2 advantage after OU dropped a four-set match to Colorado (Aug. 26). The Sooners' two wins have come against Oregon State, with an even 2-2 record, in 2006 and 2007.

Double-Doubles...

Five Sooners combined for 28 double-doubles in 2016 and exactly half of those double-doubles return for 2017. **Audrey Alford** and **Alyssa Enneking** each collected seven double-doubles a year ago. Alford picked up her first of 2017 with a 23-assist, 11-dig effort in the first match of the season.

Open House...

The Sooners hold a 29-15 record all-time in home openers and are 11-3 under Restrepo. A five-set loss to Seton Hall at home snapped a six-match win streak in home openers for OU.

Silver Medalists...

Newcomers **Sarah Sanders** and **Paige Angerson**, a PrepVolleyball.com All-American, teamed up with Texas Advantage Volleyball to earn a silver medal at the USA Volleyball 18-Open Division Girls' Junior National Championships in Minneapolis.

Who's In the Middle?...

Oklahoma has had an All-American middle blocker every year since 2011 in **Sallie McLaurin** (2011, '12, '13) and **Marion Hazelwood** (2014, '15, '16). Hazelwood, an early enrollee in the spring of 2014, graduated in just seven semesters and transferred to finish her collegiate career at Washington. The Sooners also move on without four-year starter **Micaela Spann**, who graduated after earning All-Big 12 Second Team in 2016. Redshirt-junior **Leslie Atherton** is the lone returner at middle blocker and has appeared in 12 sets over the last two seasons. She is joined by freshmen **Paige Anderson** and **Katherine Cashman** competing for rotations at middle blocker.

Academic Honors...

A program-record 11 Sooners were named to the 2016 Academic All-Big 12 Team; tied with K-State for the most in the league. Nine Sooners earned First Team recognition, while two earned Second Team honors. **Micaela Spann** became the first three-time Academic First Team selection since **Sallie McLaurin** (2011-13). **Kimmy Gardiner** followed up a 2015 Second Team honor with a First Team spot and **Lauren English** appeared on the First Team after a Second Team nod in 2014.

Miller Transfers to OU...

Oklahoma added junior setter/outside hitter **Morgan Miller** to its roster after she transferred from Louisville. Miller totaled 100 sets as a sophomore in 2016 and averaged 1.97 kills, 1.67 assists, 0.93 digs and 0.52 blocks per set. The 6-foot lefty can run the Sooner offense, while also swinging from the right side.

The Home Crowd...

The Sooners hosted No. 4 Texas in front of a crowd of 1,874 at McCasland Field House on September 28, 2016. It marked the seventh largest home crowd in program history. Each of the Sooners' last four home matches against the Longhorns ranks in the top-10 for home attendance. Oklahoma hosted its second four-digit home crowd of the season against No. 4 Kansas (11/5) with 1,052 fans in attendance. OU surpassed 10,000 in total attendance for the seventh straight year with its third crowd of 1,000 or more to finish the season against Baylor (11/19).

Vs. The Ranked...

The Sooners have dropped 14-consecutive matches to ranked opponents, including a 0-12 mark against Top-10 opponents. Under head coach **Santiago Restrepo**, Oklahoma owns a 21-86 (.196) record against ranked teams. Over a stretch of six NCAA Tournament seasons from 2009-14, the Sooners went 15-34 (.306) vs. ranked teams. After a 0-19 record in his first two seasons at Oklahoma, Restrepo and the Sooners are 21-67 (.239) against teams in the Top-25. OU's last win over a ranked opponent was at No. 2 Texas (10/25/14).

Against the Top-5...

Prior to defeating No. 5 Texas (10/25/14), OU's biggest upset was at No. 3 Texas (10/28/08). All-time, the Sooners are 2-29 vs. top-five teams. Oklahoma is 2-8 against the Longhorns, while 0-14 against Nebraska. The Sooners have never defeated the No. 1 team, having last lost to top-ranked Texas at home (11/2/13).
