First Serve...

Tournament play wraps up for the University of Oklahoma volleyball team at the Maryland Challenge. The Sooners open the week against No. 7 Washington Thursday at 3 p.m. CT at the XFINITY Center Pavilion in College Park. The weekend continues with a Friday doubleheader against host Maryland at 10 a.m. and No. 18 Southern California at 3 p.m.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma went 2-1 last weekend at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic, hosted by Tulane, to run its record to 3-6 overall. Junior outside hitter **Alyssa Enneking** is averaging a team-best 4.00 kills per set, while hitting .247, with 2.76 digs per set. Junior **Morgan Miller** is third in kills (2.07), second in assists (6.30) and third in digs (2.50) as she splits time between setting in OU's 6-2 and hitting from the right side. Junior setter **Audrey Alford** is tops on the team in assists at 7.09 per set to go with 2.13 digs per set. As a team, Oklahoma is averaging 2.41 blocks per set, which ranks 60th in the nation. Freshman **Sarah Maras**, who recently moved from outside hitter to middle blocker, is first on the team with a 1.12 blocks per set average.

All-Tournament, All The Time...

Through three weekends of tournament play, **Alyssa Enneking** has earned All-Tournament honors each time. She added to her accomplishments at the NIKE Invitational and Bobcat Invitational this past weekend at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic. In Ohio, two weeks ago, she hit .245 for the tournament and posted a career-high in kills with 26 against the Bobcats (Sept. 1). Her 26 kills marked the most by a Sooner since **Kierra Holst** set the program mark in the 25-point, rally-scoring era with 32 against Iowa State in 2014. Prior to this season, Enneking earned All-Tournament honors at the 2016 Pac-12 Challenge.

Scouting the Huskies...

No. 7 Washington is 8-1 on the season and riding a six-match win streak following a weekend at the Pepperdine Asics Classic. The Huskies' lone loss of the season came at home to No. 9 Creighton in four sets on August 26 when they were ranked third in the country. Three UW players are averaging 3.00 kills per set or better with **Kara Bajema** leading the way at 3.64. **Carly DeHoog** is second at 3.10 with a team-leading .383 attack rate and **Courtney Schwan** chips in with 3.07 per set.

Scouting the Terrapins...

Maryland is a perfect 9-0 on the season after three wins at Marshall's Thunder Invite last weekend. The Terrapins are hitting a collective .303, while opponents hit just .153 on the season. **Erika Pritchard** is averaging 3.37 kills per set to go with a .326 attack rate. **Hailey Murray** hits a team-high .484 and averages 2.09 kills and 0.91 blocks per set. **Angel Gaskin** is second in hitting (.343) and third in kills (2.21).

Scouting the Trojans...

No. 18 USC has won three in a row to run its record to 7-2. **Khalia Lanier** leads the Trojans in kills at 4.21 per set on a .319 hitting percentage along with 2.52 digs per set. **Reni Meyer-Whalley** and **Cindy Marina** share the USC setting duties. Meyer-Whalley leads the offense with 6.12 assists per set followed closely by Marina at 5.47.

Up Next...

Oklahoma returns home for the first time since opening weekend when it hosts Kansas State in the Big 12 opener on Wednesday, September 20. There will be \$5 admission for all OU faculty and staff as well as an OU volleyball water bottle giveaway to the first 200 fans in attendance.

All-Time vs. the Field...

The 2015 Oklahoma Invitational marked the first-ever match-up between the Sooners, who won in 2015, and the Terrapins, who won in 2016 in Los Angeles to even the series. Oklahoma is 0-5 in matches against USC dating back to 1990 and 0-3 against Washington with the first contest coming in 1988. **Alyssa Enneking** posted a then career-high 18 kills against the Huskies in a four-set loss last season. In 2015, Oklahoma lost to Washington in four, but snapped the No. 7 Huskies 28-0 record in sets played to that point in the season with a second set victory.

OU-UW Connection...

Marion Hazelwood was a three-time AVCA All-America Honorable Mention at Oklahoma from 2014-16. An early enrollee in the spring of 2014, she graduated from OU this past spring and moved on to Washington as a graduate transfer. She is averaging 2.41 kills and 1.77 blocks per set with the Huskies. As a Sooner, Hazelwood averaged 2.33 kills and 1.07 blocks per set for her career. She twice earned All-Big 12 First Team and was a member of the All-Big 12 Freshman Team as well. Combined between OU and UW, Hazelwood has 806 career kills. Her .324 career hitting percentage ranks fourth all-time at OU.

OU-UMD Connection...

Kristin Carpenter replaced **Kelly Files** on the Oklahoma coaching staff as an assistant for the 2016 season. A former player at Penn State, where Maryland head coach **Steve Aird** worked as an assistant, Carpenter moved on to College Park to join the Terrapins staff this past winter. A native of Mechanicsville, Va., Carpenter had arrived at OU after a stint as the volunteer assistant at Virginia in 2015.

Restrepo, Files, Southern Miss Reunion...

When the Sooners took the floor against Southern Miss (Sept. 9) it marked the first time for OU head coach **Santiago Restrepo** and assistant coach **Kelly Files** against their former team. Restrepo was the Golden Eagles' head coach from 2001-03, while Files played four years at USM from 1998-01. Oklahoma earned the win in four sets for in the first-ever match-up between the two programs.

Triple-Double...

In her Sooner debut, **Morgan Miller** recorded the first triple-double at Oklahoma in seven years. **Brianne Barker** was the last to do so on December 4, 2010. She posted 10 kills, 57 assists and 14 digs in a NCAA Tournament First Round win over No. 22 Tulsa in Norman. Miller accomplished the feat with 12 kills, 17 assists and 15 digs against Seton Hall (Aug. 25). She nearly duplicated the effort in the finale against Colorado (Aug. 26). Miller went for nine kills, 16 assists and eight digs vs. CU.

Preseason Team...

Outside hitter **Madison Drescher** was the lone Sooner voted by the league's coaches to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. Drescher's numbers against league opponents surpassed her overall numbers in 2016 with a 2.30 kills per set average as she hit .217 and added 0.62 blocks per set.

Season Openers...

OU is 21-23 all-time in season openers following a 3-2 loss to Seton Hall (Aug. 25) at the NIKE Invitational. The Sooners are 10-4 in season-opening matches since the arrival of **Santiago Restrepo** in 2004. Oklahoma opened at home in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2011 and 2012.

Double-Doubles...

Five Sooners combined for 28 double-doubles in 2016 and exactly half of those double-doubles return for 2017. **Audrey Alford** and **Alyssa Enneking** each collected seven double-doubles a year ago. Alford picked up her first of 2017 with a 23-assist, 11-dig effort in the first match of the season. Enneking, who collected two double-doubles in one day last weekend, leads the team with two so far in 2017. Alford, Enneking and **Morgan Miller**, who has added a triple-double, have all recorded three double-doubles through nine matches.

Big 12 Poll Position...

Oklahoma finished seventh in the 2016 standings and was predicted to finish eighth by the Big 12 coaches in the preseason poll. After five straight years as the unanimous No. 1, Texas is first in the rankings, but the Longhorns claimed just six first place votes, while last year's regular season champion Kansas is No. 2 with three first place votes. OU's ranking is the lowest since being picked eighth in 2008 in an 11-team Big 12.

Against the Pac-12...

The Pac-12 has held a firm grip over Oklahoma with a 24-2 advantage after OU dropped a four-set match to Colorado (Aug. 26). The Sooners' two wins have come against Oregon State, with an even 2-2 record, in 2006 and 2007.

Vs. The Ranked...

The Sooners have dropped 14-consecutive matches to ranked opponents, including a 0-12 mark against Top-10 opponents. Under head coach **Santiago Restrepo**, Oklahoma owns a 21-86 (.196) record against ranked teams. Over a stretch of six NCAA Tournament seasons from 2009-14, the Sooners went 15-34 (.306) vs. ranked teams. After a 0-19 record in his first two seasons at Oklahoma, Restrepo and the Sooners are 21-67 (.239) against teams in the Top-25. OU's last win over a ranked opponent was at No. 2 Texas (Oct. 25, 2014).

Against the SEC...

The Sooners had won five of seven against SEC competition until a three-set loss to Georgia (Sept. 2). Oklahoma last beat an SEC foe with a five-set win over Mississippi State (Sept. 3, 2016) to end a brief two-match slide vs. the SEC. The Sooners are 20-28 all-time vs. the SEC and 9-6 with Restrepo calling the shots. The Sooners most common opponents from the SEC include LSU (3-8) and Arkansas (4-3).

Open House...

The Sooners hold a 29-15 record all-time in home openers and are 11-3 under Restrepo. A five-set loss to Seton Hall at home snapped a six-match win streak in home openers for OU.

Who's In the Middle?...

Oklahoma has had an All-American middle blocker every year since 2011 in **Sallie McLaurin** (2011, '12, '13) and **Marion Hazelwood** (2014, '15, '16). Hazelwood, an early enrollee in the spring of 2014, graduated in just seven semesters and transferred to finish her collegiate career at Washington. The Sooners also move on without four-year starter **Micaela Spann**, who graduated after earning All-Big 12 Second Team in 2016. Redshirt-junior **Leslie Atherton** is the lone returner at middle blocker and has appeared in 12 sets over the last two seasons. She is joined by freshmen **Paige Anderson** and **Katherine Cashman** competing for rotations at middle blocker.

Academic Honors...

A program-record 11 Sooners were named to the 2016 Academic All-Big 12 Team; tied with K-State for the most in the league. Nine Sooners earned First Team recognition, while two earned Second Team honors. **Micaela Spann** became the first three-time Academic First Team selection since **Sallie McLaurin** (2011-13). **Kimmy Gardiner** followed up a 2015 Second Team honor with a First Team spot and **Lauren English** appeared on the First Team after a Second Team nod in 2014.
