First Serve...
 The University of Oklahoma volleyball team is back on the road as Big 12 play rolls on at Iowa State this weekend. The Sooners and the Cyclones hit the floor at Hilton Coliseum on Saturday, September 23 for a 4 p.m. first serve.

About the Sooners...
 Oklahoma is 3-10 overall after dropping its conference opener to Kansas State in five sets on Wednesday. Junior outside hitter **Alyssa Enneking** leads the Sooner attack with 4.08 kills per set on a .257 attack rate to go with 2.69 digs per set. Junior outside hitter **Madison Drescher**, coming off a career-high 25 kill on a .400 hitting percentage vs. the Wildcats, is second with 2.67 kills per set. Junior setter **Audrey Alford** has served as OU's primary setter in its 5-1 offense over the last few weeks and has lifted her assists per set average to 8.37 after dishing out 50 on Wednesday night. Freshman libero **Kira Morikawa** has started 12 of 13 matches and leads the Sooner back row with 3.29 digs per set.

Scouting the Cyclones...
 Iowa State is 9-1 overall and comes into their Big 12 opener on a two-game winning streak, including a five-set win over No. 8 Creighton at home. The Cyclones are 3-1 on their home floor this season. Outside Hitter **Samara West** leads the Cyclone attack with 2.71 kills per set and a .317 attack rate. Outside hitter **Jess Schaben** comes in averaging 2.70 kills and 2.78 digs per set. Libero **Hali Hillegas** leads the Big 12 with 5.51 digs per set.

Up Next...
 Oklahoma will continue its three-game road trip when they travel to face North Texas on Wednesday, September 27 at 7 p.m. The Sooners return to Norman on October 4 against Texas Tech.

Last Time They Met...
 Iowa State swept the season finale against the Sooners by scores of 19-25, 22-25, and 14-25. The Cyclones outthit the Sooners 441-277. Alford dished a 35 assists in the three-set loss. Iowa State's Schaben had a team-high 12 kills on a .333 attack rate, while West hit .600 with nine kills and no errors.

All-Time vs. Iowa State...
 Despite falling in each of the last seven match-ups, Oklahoma leads the all-time series against Iowa State, 44-35. The Sooners last won on October 5, 2013. It was a five-set Oklahoma win over the No. 25 Cyclones. **Keila Rodriguez** led all players with 19 kills in the win.

All-Tournament, All The Time...
 Against No. 18 USC (Sept. 15), **Alyssa Enneking** recorded the 500th kill of her career on her way to earning All-Tournament honors at the Maryland Challenge. It marked the fourth All-Tournament award in as many weeks for Enneking as she added to her accolades from the NIKE Invitational, Bobcat Invitational and Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic. Enneking previously earned the first All-Tournament honor of her career at the 2016 Pac-12 Challenge, hosted by USC.

Big 12 Openers...
 OU opened conference play with a 3-2 loss to Kansas State (Sept. 20). The Sooners are now 10-12 in Big 12 openers dating back to the league's inaugural season in 1996. OU's 2015 loss at Texas Tech snapped a stretch of nine conference-opening wins. Under Restrepo, the Sooners are 9-5 in the first Big 12 match of the season. In home Big 12 openers, OU is 11-9; having won seven in a row until this season.

Milestone Tracker...

Setter **Audrey Alford** recorded the 2,000th assist of her Sooner career against Kansas State (Sept. 20). She moved into ninth all-time at OU against Maryland (Sept. 15) as she recorded the 1,910th of her career to pass **Jessica Barney** (2001-02). Alford, who reached the 2,000-assist mark in her 61st match and now has 2,027 in her career, is now chasing **Julie Chester** (2004-07), who dished out 2,794 career assists, for eighth all-time at Oklahoma.

Sooner Youth Movement...

Oklahoma has regularly started three freshmen this season, including middle blocker **Paige Anderson**, who has started all 13 matches. **Kira Morikawa** has earned 12 starts at libero and outside hitter-turned-middle blocker **Sarah Maras** has started eight of the Sooners' last nine matches. Oklahoma last used three starters in its lineup early in the 2012 season with **Julia Doyle**, **Kierra Holst** and **Madison Ward** in the lineup. That OU trio combined to start 62 matches, including 33 by Doyle, 24 by Holst and five by Ward, who suffered a season-ending injury. The 2017 Sooner freshmen have already combined for 33 starts. OU freshmen did not make a single start in 2016 and **Audrey Alford** was the only freshman in the lineup in 2015 as she started the final 11 matches of the season at setter.

New Kids on the Block...

Oklahoma has had an All-American middle blocker every year since 2011 in **Sallie McLaurin** (2011, '12, '13) and **Marion Hazelwood** (2014, '15, '16). Hazelwood, an early enrollee in the spring of 2014, graduated in just seven semesters and transferred to finish her collegiate career at Washington. The Sooners also move on without four-year starter **Micaela Spann**, who graduated after earning All-Big 12 Second Team in 2016. As a team, Oklahoma returned just four starts at middle blocker for 2017, including two starts by **Leslie Atherton** and two by outside hitter **Madison Drescher** in 2016. Paige Anderson has been a consistent starter at middle blocker as a freshman in all 13 matches and averaging 0.84 blocks per set. Fellow freshman **Sarah Maras** moved from outside hitter to middle blocker early in the season and is averaging 0.85 blocks per set.

Double-Doubles...

Five Sooners combined for 28 double-doubles in 2016 and exactly half of those double-doubles return for 2017. **Audrey Alford** and **Alyssa Enneking** each collected seven double-doubles a year ago. Alford picked up her first of 2017 with a 23-assist, 11-dig effort in the first match of the season. Enneking leads the team with five so far in 2017. Alford and **Morgan Miller**, who has added a triple-double, have each recorded three double-doubles through 13 matches.

Restrepo, Files, Southern Miss Reunion...

When the Sooners took the floor against Southern Miss (Sept. 9) it marked the first time for OU head coach **Santiago Restrepo** and assistant coach **Kelly Files** against their former team. Restrepo was the Golden Eagles' head coach from 2001-03, while Files played four years at USM from 1998-01. Oklahoma earned the win in four sets for in the first-ever match-up between the two programs.

Against the Pac-12...

The Pac-12 has held a firm grip over Oklahoma with a 26-2 advantage after OU dropped a pair of matches to No. 7 Washington (Sept. 14) and No. 18 USC (Sept. 15) at the Maryland Challenge. The Sooners' two wins have come against Oregon State, with an even 2-2 series record, in 2006 and 2007.

Triple-Double...

In her Sooner debut, **Morgan Miller** recorded the first triple-double at Oklahoma in seven years. **Brianne Barker** was the last to do so on December 4, 2010. She posted 10 kills, 57 assists and 14 digs in a NCAA Tournament First Round win over No. 22 Tulsa in Norman. Miller accomplished the feat with 12 kills, 17 assists and 15 digs against Seton Hall (Aug. 25). She nearly duplicated the effort in the finale against Colorado (Aug. 26). Miller went for nine kills, 16 assists and eight digs vs. CU.

Preseason Team...

Outside hitter **Madison Drescher** was the lone Sooner voted by the league's coaches to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. Drescher's numbers against league opponents surpassed her overall numbers in 2016 with a 2.30 kills per set average as she hit .217 and added 0.62 blocks per set.

Season Openers...

OU is 21-23 all-time in season openers following a 3-2 loss to Seton Hall (Aug. 25) at the NIKE Invitational. The Sooners are 10-4 in season-opening matches since the arrival of **Santiago Restrepo** in 2004. Oklahoma opened at home in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2011 and 2012.

Big 12 Poll Position...

Oklahoma finished seventh in the 2016 standings and was predicted to finish eighth by the Big 12 coaches in the preseason poll. After five straight years as the unanimous No. 1, Texas is first in the rankings, but the Longhorns claimed just six first place votes, while last year's regular season champion Kansas is No. 2 with three first place votes. OU's ranking is the lowest since being picked eighth in 2008 in an 11-team Big 12.

Vs. The Ranked...

The Sooners have dropped 16-consecutive matches to ranked opponents, including a 0-13 mark against Top-10 opponents. Under head coach **Santiago Restrepo**, Oklahoma owns a 21-88 (.193) record against ranked teams. Over a stretch of six NCAA Tournament seasons from 2009-14, the Sooners went 15-34 (.306) vs. ranked teams. After a 0-19 record in his first two seasons at Oklahoma, Restrepo and the Sooners are 21-69 (.233) against teams in the Top-25. OU's last win over a ranked opponent was at No. 2 Texas (Oct. 25, 2014).

Against the SEC...

The Sooners had won five of seven against SEC competition until a three-set loss to Georgia (Sept. 2). Oklahoma last beat an SEC foe with a five-set win over Mississippi State (Sept. 3, 2016) to end a brief two-match slide vs. the SEC. The Sooners are 20-28 all-time vs. the SEC and 9-6 with Restrepo calling the shots. The Sooners most common opponents from the SEC include LSU (3-8) and Arkansas (4-3).

Open House...

The Sooners hold a 29-15 record all-time in home openers and are 11-3 under Restrepo. A five-set loss to Seton Hall at home snapped a six-match win streak in home openers for OU.

The Home Crowd...

The Sooners hosted No. 4 Texas in front of a crowd of 1,874 at McCasland Field House on September 28, 2016. It marked the seventh largest home crowd in program history. Each of the Sooners' last four home matches against the Longhorns ranks in the top-10 for home attendance. Oklahoma hosted its second four-digit home crowd of the season against No. 4 Kansas (Nov. 5, 2016) with 1,052 fans in attendance. OU surpassed 10,000 in total attendance for the seventh straight year with its third crowd of 1,000 or more to finish the season against Baylor (Nov. 19, 2016).

PLEDGE FOR A CURE The Oklahoma volleyball team continues the mission to honor the son of its head coach, Santiago Restrepo. When he was just one-and-a-half years old, Javier Restrepo was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL). In August 2008, he had a relapse and received a bone marrow transplant and then received a liver transplant but unfortunately relapsed again. Javi fought the disease like a true champion, nearly beating it on multiple occasions before it ultimately claimed his life on July 31, 2009.
