- Iowa State (2-2, 0-1 Big 12) travels to No. 3 Oklahoma (4-0, 1-0 Big 12) on Saturday on Fox.
- Oklahoma leads the all-time series at 74-5-2 and has won 18-straight games in the series.
- OU is the first ranked opponent the Cyclones have faced this season. ISU has lost 20-straight games to ranked opponents. It's last win over a rated foe was a 37-23 win at No. 15 TCU in 2012.
- ISU has had over 50,000 fans attend a game in Jack Trice Stadium for a school-record 42-straight games. ISU's first two home games (UNI, Iowa) were sellouts (61,500), tying the single-game home attendance mark.
- Iowa State had its school-record-tying streak of consecutive games with 40+ points end in a 17-7 loss to Texas. The Cyclones also had a school-record streak of six-straight 400-yard offensive games halted vs. UT.
- Junior QB Jacob Park is having a fabulous start to his season, averaging 295.2 yards (15th in NCAA), 25.0 completions per game (12th in NCAA) and tossing nine TD passes (28th in NCAA).
- Park has thrown for over 300 yards twice this season, tying for fifth in school history, and four times in his career, tying for second in school history.
- Park's 60.1 completion percentage is No. 1 in school history.
- Senior WR Allen Lazard, a preseason All-American and Biletnikoff Award nominee, leads the team in receptions (24) and has 241 yards and three TDs. Lazard is ISU's career leader in receptions (194) and 100-yard receiving games (9).
- Lazard leads the nation among active NCAA players in consecutive games with a reception (39) and is third nationally among active players in receptions (194), fourth in receiving yards (2,660) and seventh in TD catches (19).
- Lazard needs 31 yards to rank 2nd all-time in career receiving yards (2,690- Lane Danielsen, 2000-03) at ISU.
- Lazard is one of five players on the team with 10 or more receptions and 100 or more receiving yards. Lazard and Hakeem Butler form one of the league's best tandems, combining for 43 receptions, 537 receiving yards and six TDs.
- Sophomore RB David Montgomery has been a force for the Cyclones, leading the team and ranking fifth in the Big 12 in rushing at 88.8 ypg. He's rushed for over 100 yards in four of his last seven games.
- Iowa State is one of eight teams in the nation yet to lose a fumble this season.
- The Cyclone defense has only allowed one opponent to reach 400 yards of total offense this season.
- ISU has picked off six passes (19th in NCAA) and has a +3 (8-5) turnover margin (29th in NCAA) this season. In the Matt Campbell era, ISU is 5-2 when winning the turnover margin and 0-9 when losing or tying the turnover margin in a game.
- The defense leads the Big 12 and ranks 15th nationally in TFL at 8.0, registering at least six TFL in all four games this season. ISU has a +17 TFL margin (ISU- 32; Opponents- 15) to rank fourth nationally.
- Senior LB Joel Lanning has made an amazing transition to defense after spending his first four years at ISU as a QB. Lanning leads the team, ranks second in the Big 12 and fifth nationally in tackles per game (11.5). He is tied for the team lead in double-digit tackle games with two. LB Marcel Spears is third in the Big 12 and 12th nationally in tackles per game (10.3).
- Lanning set a career high in tackles with 20 vs. Texas, the most by a Cyclone since 2006 and the first 20-tackle outing in a regulation game since 1998 (Jeff Waters, 22 vs. Missouri).
- Senior S Kamari Cotton-Moya is second in the league (T8th in NCAA) in interceptions with two and has four in his career, tying with Brian Peavy as ISU's active career leaders.

- ISU broke Big 12 era records (league games only) in total offense (439.8) and scoring (29.4) in his first season in 2016.
- Member of five Division III national champion teams as a player and coach at Mount Union (2000, 2001, 2002, 2005, 2006).
- Member of 11 conference champion teams as a player and coach.
- 2015 MAC Coach of the Year.
- First two Iowa State recruiting classes ranked in the top-50 nationally.
- Campbell's .700 winning pct. at Toledo was third-best in school history behind Nick Saban and Bill Orwig.
- Two Toledo teams (2012 & 2015) cracked the nation's top-25.
- Defeated two ranked teams at Toledo (No. 18 Cincinnati in 2012; No. 18 Arkansas in 2015).
- Two-time All-American defensive lineman and Academic All-American at Mount Union.
- Was 54-1 in his four-year playing career at Mount Union.
- Father, Rick, was a high school football coach at Jackson H.S. in Massillon, Ohio.

⇒ **IOWA STATE VS. RANKED OPPONENTS**

- Iowa State has a 17-184-2 all-time overall record vs. ranked opponents and a 6-95-1 mark vs. ranked foes on the road.
- Oklahoma is the first ranked opponent the Cyclones have faced this season.
- ISU's last win over a ranked opponent was a 37-23 win at No. 15 TCU on Oct. 6, 2012.
- ISU's last win over a ranked opponent at home was a 37-31 2OT victory over No. 2 Oklahoma State on Nov. 18, 2011.
- ISU has lost 20-straight games to ranked opponents.
- ISU head coach Matt Campbell is 2-8 vs. ranked opponents in his head coaching career (0-4 at ISU).

⇒ **IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME**

- Iowa State has shattered virtually all attendance marks in this decade.
- Over 50,000 fans have attended a game in Jack Trice Stadium a school-record 42-straight games.
- The top-10 most attended games in school history have occurred since 2011.
- Jack Trice Stadium capacity was increased to 61,500 in 2015, making it the third-largest stadium in the Big 12.
- ISU sold out its first two games at 61,500, the fourth sell-out since the new configuration (2015).

⇒ **IOWA STATE-OKLAHOMA TIDBITS**

- Oklahoma leads the all-time series vs. Iowa State at 74-5-2.
- The Sooners are 38-3-1 vs. the Cyclones in games played in Norman.
- ISU's last win in the series was in Norman when the Cyclones defeated the Sooners, 33-31 in 1990.
- OU has won 18-straight games in the series.
- OU special teams/running backs coach Jay Boulware was on ISU's staff in 2007-08.
- ISU senior WR Allen Lazard is averaging 6.3 receptions and 76.0 receiving yards in three career games played against the Sooners. He scored a TD in last year's game in Ames and recorded 101 receiving yards in Norman in 2015.
- ISU sophomore DE JaQuan Bailey tallied a career-high six tackles and 2.0 TFL vs. OU a year ago.

⇒ **IOWA STATE-TEXAS RECAP**

- Iowa State and Texas staged a defensive battle on Thursday night, as the Cyclones fell to the Longhorns, 17-7.
- ISU held UT to 312 yards of total offense and 17 points, but couldn't get much going vs. the stout UT defense, tallying 256 yards of offense and 10 rushing yards.
- UT led at the break 14-0. It was the first scoreless first half for the Cyclones since 2013.
- The Cyclones cut the UT lead to 14-7 in the third quarter with a 11-yard TD reception by Matt Eaton from Jacob Park.
- ISU mounted a couple drives in the fourth quarter, but couldn't capitalize on two fourth down tries in UT territory.
- Coming into the game the Cyclone offense had only given up one sack all season, but the Longhorns got to Jacob Park four times.
- ISU registered a pair of sacks, both by JaQuan Bailey, the most by a Cyclone since 2015.
- ISU also had six TFL, marking the fourth game in a row with six or more TFL.
- Senior S Kamari Cotton-Moya picked off his second pass of the season and the fourth of his career.
- Senior LB Joel Lanning was all over the place, accumulating a career-high 20 tackles. It was the first time a Cyclone had 20 tackles since Alvin Bowen did it in a triple overtime game vs. Toledo in 2006. Lanning's 20 stops was the first 20-tackle game in regulation since Jeff Waters posted 22 vs. Missouri in 1998.
- Offensively, senior WR Allen Lazard caught five passes for 63 yards, increasing his NCAA-leading active streak of consecutive games with a catch to 39.
- Junior QB Jacob Park threw for 246 yards and a TD. He's tossed a TD pass in all four games this year.
- Senior WR Marchie Murdock tied his career high with four receptions for 50 yards, while Hakeem Butler added four catches for 62 yards.

⇒ **OFFENSE GENERATING YARDAGE AND POINTS**

- The Iowa State offense is showing signs of becoming one of the most prolific in school history.
- The Cyclones rank 55th nationally in scoring (32.8) and 22nd nationally in passing offense (295.2).
- ISU posted over 400 yards of total offense in its first three games after hitting the 400 mark in its last three games of 2016. The six-game streak of over 400 yards of total offense is a school record.

- The Cyclones clicked 40 or more points on the scoreboard in their first three games for the first time since 1976, tying the school record for consecutive games of 40+ points (1943-44, 1971, 1976).
- ISU has recorded over 300 yards passing in four of its last six games. The Cyclones set a school record for passing yards per game (258.8) in 2016 and is on pace to shatter that mark (295.2) this year.
- ISU's outstanding receivers have complemented the passing game. The Cyclones had a school-record streak of five-straight games with a 100-yard receiver end vs. Akron. Five Cyclones have over 10 receptions on the year, led by preseason All-American Allen Lazard with 24. Lazard is fifth in the Big 12 in catches per game (6.0).
- Both Lazard and Hakeem Butler have three TD catches on the season.
- Against Iowa, ISU had a 300-yard passer (Park- 347), an 100-yard receiver (Butler- 128) and 100-yard rusher (Montgomery- 112) for only the sixth time in school history.
- A huge part of ISU's offensive success has been its ability to give QB Jacob Park time in the pocket. The O-Line has limited his touches and allowed only five sacks this season (1 sack per 32.4 attempts), ranking second in the Big 12 and 28th nationally. ISU surrendered 32 sacks in 2016.
- ISU head coach Matt Campbell's final Toledo team (2015) gave up only four sacks to rank fourth nationally. ISU OC/OL Tom Manning was also the O-Line coach of that team, earning National O-Line Coach of the Year honors.
- In the red zone, the Cyclones rank third in the Big 12 and 23rd nationally at 93.3 pct. (14-of-15; 12 TDs, 2 FGs).

⇒ DEFENSIVE NOTES

- The Cyclone defense has stepped up in delivering big plays.
- ISU has recorded 32 tackles for loss on the season, leading the Big 12 and ranking 15th nationally at 8.0 per game. ISU has a +17 margin of TFL, as the ISU offense has only allowed 15 on the year (1st in Big 12, 7th in NCAA).
- ISU's +17 TFL margin ties for fourth nationally.
- Ten of ISU's 32 TFL have been sacks, ranking second in the Big 12 in sacks per game (2.5).
- ISU has tallied at least six TFL in all four games so far this season, including a season-high 11 vs. Akron.
- The Cyclones recorded five sacks at Akron, the most since tallying six against Kansas in 2015. That total helped limit the Zips to just 38 rushing yards, the lowest total by a Cyclone opponent since 2015 (Kansas).
- With six team interceptions, the Cyclones are second in the Big 12 (19th in NCAA) in interceptions per game (1.5).
- Through four games ISU is stopping its opponents from obtaining a first down in a series drive (3-and-out or turnover) 21 times (53 drives) for an average of 5.3 per game.
- In its last eight quarters, the Cyclones have held their opponent scoreless in four them, allowing just 15.5 ppg in that span.
- ISU is allowing 379.5 yards of total offense, ranking sixth in the league, while only allowing one opponent (Iowa) this year to reach 400 yards in a game.
- The last time the Cyclones ended a year with under 400 yards of total defense average was 2007 (390.3).

⇒ LAZARD ONE OF THE NATION'S BEST RECEIVERS

- Allen Lazard has established himself as one of the premier wide receivers in the nation.
- Lazard, a First-Team All-Big 12 selection in 2016, is a member of the Biletnikoff Award Watch List and has made numerous preseason All-America teams.
- Lazard is targeting virtually every career receiving record in Cyclone history. He's already set four career records: Receptions (194), 100-yard receiving games (9), Consecutive 100-yard receiving games (4) and Consecutive games with a reception (39).
- Lazard needs 436 receiving yards to become ISU's all-time leader in that category (ranking third at 2,660).
- Among active FBS players, Lazard ranks third in career receptions (194), fourth in career receiving yards (2,660), seventh in career TD catches (19) and first in consecutive games with a reception (38).
- Lazard leads the team and ranks fifth in the Big 12 in receptions per game (6.0).
- He's caught three TD passes this season to tie for fifth in the Big 12.
- He caught two TD passes vs. Iowa, his third multi-TD catch game of his career.
- Lazard (194) along with Trever Ryan (71) rank in the top-15 nationally in active career receiving tandems (265).
- Lazard became just the fourth player in school history to record a 1,000-yard receiving season when he posted 1,018 yards in 2016.
- Lazard was also named a team captain for the second-straight season, joining his father, Kevin Lazard, as team captains at Iowa State. Kevin was a co-captain of the 1993 Iowa State football team.

⇒ LANNING MAKING AN AMAZING TRANSITION TO LINEBACKER

- One of ISU's biggest stories out of spring drills was the decision to move former QB Joel Lanning to linebacker for his senior season.
- Lanning started 14 games at QB throughout his career, recording 2,537 passing yards and 19 TDs with a completion percentage of 56.9.
- Lanning's value at QB was enhanced with his capability to run, especially in the "Lan Ram" package in short-yardage situations. He led the team with 11 rushing TDs and was third on the team in rushing yards (518) in 2016.
- Lanning tallied seven tackles vs. UNI in his first career start on defense and gained a yard in his only rush, becoming the first Cyclone since Joe Woodley (2002) to play on offense and defense in the same game.
- Lanning has been productive at the Mike linebacker spot, leading the Big 12 and ranking fifth nationally in tackles per game at 11.5. He is tied for the team lead in double-digit tackle games with two.
- The Ankeny, Iowa, native had a monster game vs. Texas, racking up 20 tackles, including eight solo stops. Lanning's 20 tackles marked the first time a Cyclone had 20 or more stops in a regulation game since 1998 (22- Jeff Waters vs. Missouri).
- His 20 tackles vs. Texas is the most by a Big 12 player this season.
- Lanning registered his first career sack and interception vs. Akron.
- Lanning is not the first Cyclone QB to make a successful switch to LB. In 2000, Derrick Walker moved to LB after spending the 1999 season as ISU's backup QB. Walker was instrumental in helping ISU earn its first bowl berth in 22 years by recording 61 tackles in 10 starts on the 2000 Insight.com Bowl champion squad.

⇒ JACOB PARK THRIVING AT QB

- Jacob Park has only started seven games in his career, but is posting some of the best numbers by a Cyclone signal-caller in school history.
- Park currently owns ISU school records in completion percentage (60.1) and passer rating (137.1).
- He's already tossed four of 300-yard passing games in his career, which ties for second in school history, and has eight multi-TD games in his career.
- Park, who ranks 15th nationally in passing yards per game (295.3), threw for 347 yards and set a career high in TD passes with four vs. Iowa. His four TD passes ties for the third-best single-game effort in school history.
- Over his last six games, Park is averaging 306.2 passing yards, eclipsing the 300-yard mark three times.
- The Maxwell Award nominee has completed 61.7 percent of his passes this year, which is on pace to break the single-season school record, and his 25.0 completions per game ranks 12th nationally.
- Park is 28th nationally in TD passes with eight, averaging 2.4 per game. He's had two or more TD passes in three of four games this season.
- In the season-opener vs. UNI, Park completed 77.1 pct. of his passes and set a career best in completions with 27.

⇒ THE MONTGOMERY EXPRESS

- Sophomore David Montgomery took over the starting running back spot late in the 2016 season and has emerged as one of the best rushers in the Big 12.
- Montgomery's toughness and tenacity is what makes him so special. He has forced 39 missed tackles this season to lead the nation after tallying 29 all of last season.
- He currently ranks fifth in the Big 12 and 40th nationally in rushing yards per game (88.8), and is third in the Big 12 in rushing TDs (4).
- Montgomery is averaging 99.4 yards per game and 5.8 yards per carry in his last seven games dating back to last season, racking up four 100-yard games in that span. ISU is 4-3 in those games.
- Montgomery has two 100-yard games this season (112 vs. Iowa; 127 vs. Akron).
- Has one fumble in 200 career touches.
- Montgomery is also a threat as a receiver, ranking fourth on the team in receptions with 13.
- Montgomery is currently averaging 5.3 yards per carry in his young career, which is on pace to be one of the best clips in school history.
- His 563 rushing yards in 2016 led the Cyclones and was the second-best rookie total in school history.
- Montgomery was a QB in high school and was teammates with current Cyclone Deshaunte Jones in eighth grade while growing up in Cincinnati.

⇒ TURNING THE TABLE ON TURNOVERS

- Winning the turnover margin is a key ingredient for successful football teams.
- The Cyclones have ended their last four seasons negative in turnover margin, but showed signs of improvement at the end of the 2016 season and while continuing the trend this year.
- ISU had a 22-game stretch (2014-16) where it won the turnover margin just three times.
- However, ISU has forced more turnovers than its committed in five of its last eight games dating back to last season at a +4 margin. In those five games with a positive turnover margin, ISU is 4-1.
- ISU has a +3 turnover margin this season (8-5), losing the turnover battle twice (Iowa, Texas).
- The Cyclones currently rank third in the Big 12 and 29th nationally in turnover margin.
- ISU is one of eight teams nationally without a lost fumble this season.
- From 2013-16, ISU recorded just one defensive TD in a 46-game stretch. However, ISU has tallied three defensive TDs in its last six games dating back to last season.
- In the season-opener vs. UNI, the Cyclones recorded a pair of interception returns for a TD (Willie Harvey and Kamari Cotton-Moya) for the first time since 2010.
- Cotton-Moya has two pick-sixes in his career. The school record is four by current NFL linebacker A.J. Klein.
- In the Matt Campbell era, ISU is 5-2 when winning the turnover margin and 0-8 when losing or tying the turnover margin.
