## OU POSTGAME NOTES

### GENERAL NOTES

- Oklahoma improved to 46-61-5 all-time against Texas, and 13-9 against the Longhorns during the Big 12 era. The 112 meetings are the most for the Sooners against another opponent.
- OU has won six of the last eight meetings, while each of the last four matchups have been decided by seven points or fewer (and by a total of 22 points).
- Lincoln Riley became just the fifth Oklahoma head coach to post a win in his first meeting against Texas, joining Bennie Owen in 1905 (2-0 score), Jim Mackenzie in 1966 (18-9), Barry Switzer in 1973 (52-13) and John Blake in 1996 (30-27 in OT).
- Oklahoma has not lost back-to-back regular season games since Oct. 2 and 9, 1999, Bob Stoops' debut season as head coach. OU has now won 37 straight regular season games following a regular season loss.
- Oklahoma has held 14 of its last 16 opponents to under a 60 percent pass completion rate. Over the last 11 games, OU opponents have combined to complete just 53.9 percent of their passes (188-for-349). Five of those 11 have been held to a mark below 50 percent.
- Oklahoma is 12-6 all-time as the No. 12 team in the AP Poll, including 11-1 against unranked teams (2-1 vs. Texas [won in 1952, lost in 2013, won in 2017]).
- Today's kickoff temperature of 90 degrees was the highest for an OU-Texas game since 1991 (93 that day).
- Today's attendance was a sellout crowd of 93,552, the fourth-largest attendance figure in series history.

### INDIVIDUAL NOTES

#### QB BAKER MAYFIELD

- Completed 17-of-27 passes for 302 yards, two touchdowns and an interception and ran seven times for 27 yards.
- In OU's 10 games away from Norman since the start of the 2016 season (six true road contests, four at neutral sites), Mayfield has completed 206-of-288 passes (71.5 percent) for 3,296 yards (329.6 per game) and 30 touchdowns against just five interceptions (6-to-1 ratio) for a pass efficiency rating of 198.6. He has averaged 16 yards per completion and 11.4 yards per attempt. Mayfield has also rushed for five scores in those outings, helping OU to a 9-1 record.
- Has thrown at least one touchdown pass in 32 straight games (every game of his OU career) to extend his own school record. He's also thrown at least two TD passes in 19 consecutive games (57 TDs to 9 INTs during the stretch), extending his own Big 12 record.
- His 27 pass attempts today now give him 914 pass attempts at OU to move ahead of Sam Bradford (893) for fourth in OU history and 1,227 for his career to move ahead of Colorado's Cody Hawkins (1,253) for 10th in Big 12 history.
- His 17 completions today give him 640 as a Sooner to move him ahead of Jason White (627) for third in OU history and 858 for his career to move ahead of Texas Tech's Patrick Mahomes (857) for seventh in Big 12 history.
- Tallied 329 yards of total offense today giving him 12,790 for his career to move ahead of TCU's Trevone Boykin (12,777) for sixth in Big 12 history.
- Today's win is his 27th of his OU career, tying Jason White for fourth in OU history.
- His 179 passing yards in the first 15 minutes were the most by an OU quarterback in the first quarter against Texas since 1999 (Josh Heupel, 181).
- Set the school record with 200 consecutive passing attempts without an interception, breaking the mark previously held by Jason White (198, all in 2004). Mayfield was intercepted on OU's final drive of the first half on a fourth-and-3 play from the Texas 31. Before today, his last interception was at West Virginia in the third-to-last game of the 2016 season.

#### RB RODNEY ANDERSON

- Tallied a career-high 48 rushing yards on a career-best 10 carries, including a career-long rush of 21 yards in the second quarter.
- Logged his second touchdown of the season and of his career on a 15-yard rush in the second quarter.

#### TE MARK ANDREWS

- Caught four passes for 104 yards and a touchdown. He now ranks 25th overall in OU history (fifth among tight ends) with 1,266 career receiving yards.
- His fourth-quarter score also ties him with Manuel Johnson and Travis Wilson for 10th place in OU history with 17.

#### WR JEFF BADET

- Recorded his second receiving touchdown of the season. The 54-yard score on OU's first possession was the ninth-longest completion and fifth-longest touchdown by OU against Texas.

#### WR CEEDEE LAMB

- His 74 receiving yards give him 381 for the season and move him into ninth all-time among OU freshmen, passing Joe Mixon in 2015 (356).

### **DL ARMANI BLEDSOE**

- Made first career start and logged a career-high three tackles, including his first career sack.

### **DL DU'VONTA LAMPKIN**

- Made first career start and posted two tackles.

### **LB OGBONNIA OKORONKWO**

- His sack in today's game ties him with Kelly Gregg (19.0) for 11th in OU history.
- Recorded his sixth straight game with at least 0.5 sacks (OU's longest streak since at least 2002) thanks to his strip sack in the first quarter. This marked his fifth game of the year with at least one full sack.

### **DL DJ WARD**

- Registered a career-high 2.0 tackles for loss.

### **K/P AUSTIN SEIBERT**

- Tied a career-high three field goals made, previously done against both West Virginia and TCU in 2015. It matched the WVU game in 2015 for his most attempts without a miss (was 3-4 against TCU in 2015).
  - His 11 points give him 277 for his career and move him ahead of Chris Brown (270) for 14th in OU history.
  - His three made field goals also give him 34 for his career and moved him ahead of Uwe von Schamann (33) for ninth in OU history.
