OU POSTGAME NOTES

GENERAL NOTES

- Oklahoma is 75-19-4 all-time against Kansas State, including a 38-10-1 mark in Manhattan and 7-0 at KSU since 2000. The Sooners have won nine of the last 11 matchups in the series and 12 of the last 15.
- Tonight's victory is win No. 75 in the series for OU, its second highest win total against another school behind its 86 wins vs. Oklahoma State.
- The Sooners earned their 14th straight true road victory, which is the longest such streak in the country and ties for the second longest in school history (Oct. 27, 1973-Oct. 2, 1976). It is also the 12th straight true road win in Big 12 play for OU, extending its program record.
- Since 1999, the Sooners are 18-1 in the game after they play Texas.
- Oklahoma is 15-3 all-time as the No. 9 team in the AP Poll, including a perfect 4-0 in road games and 11-1 vs. unranked teams. Oklahoma is 5-0 against Kansas State when ranked ninth, outscoring the Wildcats 215-75.
- Oklahoma trailed 21-10 at halftime before prevailing 42-35. The last time OU trailed by double-digits at halftime and won was a 31-24 double-overtime victory at Tennessee in 2015 (trailed 17-3 at half).
- After giving up 316 yards in the first half (9.6 yards per play), the Sooners allowed 96 yards in the second half (4.2 per play). Additionally, the Wildcats rushed for 256 yards on 24 carries in the first half (10.7 average) but just 12 yards on 18 carries after halftime (0.7 per carry).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

QB BAKER MAYFIELD

- Threw for 410 yards on 32-of-41 passing with two touchdowns and one interception; also ran for 69 yards and two touchdowns on nine carries.
- Has thrown at least one touchdown pass in 33 straight games, or every game of his OU career, to extend his own school record and the longest active streak in FBS. He's also thrown at least two TD passes in 20 consecutive games (59 TDs to 10 INTs during the stretch), extending his own Big 12 record.
- Tallied 400-plus passing yards for the third time in his OU career. His 410-yard night gives him 10,012 for his Oklahoma career.
- Registered 479 yards of total offense, giving him 13,269 for his career and passing Missouri's Brad Smith (13,088) for fifth in Big 12 history.
- With his 32 completions tonight, Mayfield now has 672 in his OU career and moved ahead of Josh Heupel (654) for second in OU history.
- In three games vs. K-State as a Sooner, Mayfield has completed 77-of-99 passes (77.7%) for 1,038 yards, 11 TDs and just two interceptions. He's averaging 10.5 yards per attempt and 13.5 yards per completion with an efficiency rating of 198.5. He's also rushed 23 times for 127 yards and two TDs.
- In OU's 11 games away from Norman since the start of the 2016 season (seven true road contests, four at neutral sites), Mayfield has completed 238-of-329 passes (72.3 percent) for 3,706 yards (336.9 per game) and 32 touchdowns against just six interceptions (5.3-to-1 ratio) for a pass efficiency rating of 195.4. He has averaged 15.6 yards per completion and 11.3 yards per attempt. Mayfield has also rushed for six scores in those outings, helping OU to a 10-1 record.
- Tallied a season-high 69 rushing yards, including a season-long of 32.
- Registered his fourth career game with two rushing touchdowns. It was the fourth time in his career he's rushed for at least two scores and thrown for at least two in the same game.

RB RODNEY ANDERSON

- Turned in career highs in rushing yards (147), rushing attempts (19) and rushing long (36). His three rushing TDs on the season are tied for the team lead.
- Added a career high in receiving yards with 30, including a career-long of 16, on a career-best four receptions and scored his first career receiving touchdown.

TE MARK ANDREWS

- Tied a career high with seven receptions for 61 yards; now ranks 23rd overall in OU history (fifth among tight ends) with 1,327 career receiving yards.
- His seven catches also rank him 10th for catches in a season by an OU tight end (30).

WR JEFF BADET

- Tied a season high with five receptions and recorded 42 receiving yards.

WR MARQUISE BROWN

- Notched his second career 100-yard receiving game with 126 yards and tied his career high with six receptions.

FB DIMITRI FLOWERS

- His two receptions give him 47 for his career, passing Renaldo Works (46) for 10th all-time among OU running backs.
- Recorded his team-leading sixth touchdown of the season and third receiving score on the opening offensive drive.

WR MYKEL JONES

- Hauled in a career-high 76 receiving yards on three receptions.

DB ROBERT BARNES

- Tallied a career-high two tackles.

LB EMMANUEL BEAL

- Finished with a career-high 2.0 tackles for loss.

DB WILL JOHNSON

- Tied a career high with 10 tackles

LB OGBONNIA OKORONKWO

- Posted five tackles, including 2.0 for loss. He's recorded at least 1.0 TFL in every game this year and at least 2.0 in four contests. Through seven games this year he has 12.0 tackles for loss for -75 yards.

CB STEVEN PARKER

- Forced the first fumble of his career and was credited with his first fumble recovery of the season in the first quarter.

CB JORDAN THOMAS

- Recorded his second interception in as many games in Bill Snyder Family Stadium and the eighth overall of his career.
- His 216 career interception return yards is seventh most in OU history.

K/P AUSTIN SEIBERT

- His four made extra points give him 179 for his career, surpassing Trey DiCarlo and Tim Lashar (177) for fourth in OU history.
 - Connected on a pair of field goals, and is 5-for-5 over the last two games.
