OU POSTGAME NOTES

GENERAL NOTES

- With the win, OU clinched a spot in the Big 12 Championship game on Dec. 2 in Arlington, Texas. It will be the Sooners' ninth appearance in a conference title game (7-1 record in such games).
- Oklahoma is 75-27-6 all-time against Kansas, including a 36-15-4 mark in Lawrence.
- Oklahoma has won 13 straight in the series with Kansas, its longest active win streak against another team. Each of the last 13 meetings in the series have been OU victories by at least 15 points. The Sooners have outscored the Jayhawks 548-146 in those contests (average of 42-11) and have outgained them 6,368 yards to 3,155 (average of 490-243). The last four games have seen OU win by a combined score of 203-20.
- The Sooners have held Kansas to seven or fewer points in five of the last six meetings.
- The OU defense held the Jayhawks to 155 total yards, including 32 rushing yards. The 155 total yards were the fewest allowed by the Sooners since holding Kansas State to 110 yards on Oct. 17, 2015.
- The Sooners have won their last seven games in Lawrence and have outscored the Jayhawks 276-72 (39-10 average) during the stretch. OU's last loss at Kansas came in 1997, the second year of the Big 12 Conference.
- Today's victory marks the Sooners' 14th straight road win in Big 12 play, which sets the outright league record (Texas won 13 consecutive Big 12 road games from 2003 to 2006). Oklahoma's 16-game true road winning streak is the longest active streak in the country and is the second longest in school history (OU won 24 in a row from 1953 to 1958).
- OU has won 23 of its last 24 Big 12 games dating back to the 2015 season. Its only loss came at the hands of Iowa State (ranked No. 24 in the AP Top 25 this week) on Oct. 7.
- With tonight's win, Lincoln Riley ties the Oklahoma record record for most wins in a debut season, joining Barry Switzer (1973) and Chuck Fairbanks (1967) with 10 wins apiece.
- The Sooners have won their last 12 games in the month of November.
- Oklahoma leads all FBS programs with its 38 seasons of at least 10 wins. Today's win also marks OU's nation-leading 15th season of double-digit wins since 2000.
- OU is 69-13-2 all-time as the No. 3 team in the AP Poll, 29-5 on the road and 46-6 as the No. 3 AP team against unranked opponents (23-3 on the road).
- LB Emmanuel Beal's interception was OU's seventh of the season and the Sooners have turned them into a total of 38 points (five touchdowns and a field goal). The lone interception that did not lead to points was Robert Barnes' pick on the final play of the Oklahoma State game.
- Ten Sooners made at least one reception in tonight's game, marking the fourth time this season OU has had 10-plus receivers catch a pass in a game.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

QB BAKER MAYFIELD

- Completed 20-of-30 passes for 257 yards and 3 touchdowns with no interceptions, and ran for 9 yards on four carries.
 - Has thrown a TD pass in 37 consecutive games (every contest of his OU career), setting the outright Big 12 record (was tied with Texas Tech's Graham Harrell at 36). Mayfield has also thrown at least two TD passes in a Big 12-record 24 straight contests (73 TDs to 13 interceptions during the span). It is believed to be the second-longest streak in FBS history (Boise State's Kellen Moore had a streak of 26 in 2010 and '11).
 - His three touchdown passes give him 128 total TDs as a Sooner, breaking the school record previously held by Landry Jones (126). Mayfield has 110 passing TDs at OU and 18 rushing.
 - Tonight marked the 15th time in his OU career that Mayfield threw at least three touchdowns with no interceptions.
 - Mayfield's three TD passes give him 122 in his collegiate career, passing the 121 mark of BYU's Ty Detmer (1988-91) and Georgia's Aaron Murray (2010-13) for seventh in FBS history.
 - His 30 pass attempts give him 1,422 to pass Iowa State's Bret Meyer (1,414) for eighth in Big 12 history.
 - His 266 total yards of offense give him 14,808 for his career, passing Hawaii's Colt Brennan (14,740) for eighth in FBS history.
 - His 257 passing yards give him 13,796 for his career, passing Oregon State's Sean Mannion (13,600) for 11th in NCAA history.

- Mayfield is 14-0 in true road games as a Sooner, completing 307-of-433 passes (70.9 percent) for 4,552 yards (325.1 per game) and 48 touchdowns against just eight interceptions (6-to-1 ratio) for a pass efficiency rating of 192.1. He has averaged 14.8 yards per completion and 10.5 yards per attempt. Mayfield has also rushed for 10 scores in those outings.
- Additionally, Mayfield is 12-0 in Big 12 road games at OU. He's completed 241-of-329 passes (73.3 percent) for 3,979 yards (331.6 per game) and 42 touchdowns against just six interceptions (7-to-1 ratio) for a pass efficiency rating of 201.1. He has averaged 16.5 yards per completion and 12.1 yards per attempt, and has added nine rushing scores.
- Today's start was the 37th of Mayfield's OU career, tying OU co-offensive coordinator Cale Gundy for second most in program history.
- Today's win ties Mayfield with Steve Davis for second place in Oklahoma history with 32.

RB RODNEY ANDERSON

- Collected 77 yards on 16 carries and tallied his third receiving touchdown of the season on the Sooners' first scoring drive of the game. It was his 12th TD of the season and 11th in the last six games.

TE MARK ANDREWS

- Caught 4 passes for 42 yards; now ranks 16th overall in OU history (third among tight ends) with 1,594 career receiving yards.
- Has 47 receptions this season to pass Trent Smith (46) for third in OU single-season history among tight ends.
- His third-quarter TD reception ties him with Juaquin Iglesias for eighth in OU history with 19.

WR MARQUISE BROWN

- Caught his fifth touchdown reception of the season with a 24-yard catch-and-run with 10 seconds left in the half. It was his fourth TD in the last five games.

TE GRANT CALCATERRA

- Set career-highs in receptions (4) and receiving yards (67).

WR CEEDEE LAMB

- Registered a career-long 21-yard punt return, the longest by a Sooner this season.

WR MARQUISE BROWN

- Caught his fifth touchdown reception of the season with a 24-yard catch-and-run with 10 seconds left in the half. It was his fourth TD in the last five games.

RB TREY SERMON

- Tallied his fifth rushing touchdown of the season (seventh total) on a 25-yard run to extend the Sooners lead to 38-3.

WR JORDAN SMALLWOOD

- Registered his second rushing touchdown of the season on his third score of the year with a 3-yard run to put OU up 14-3 midway through the second quarter.

LB EMMANUEL BEAL

- Recorded his first career interception at the Kansas 14-yard line, which led OU's second touchdown of the game.

LB CALEB KELLY

- Logged his first sack of the season, and his 1.5 TFLs represent a career high.

CB PARNELL MOTLEY

- Led the team with six tackles.

CB TRE NORWOOD

- Tallied a pair of pass breakups for the third consecutive game to give him a team-leading seven on the season.

LB OGBONNIA OKORONKWO

- Has recorded at least 1.0 tackle for loss in every game this season.

LB JON-MICHAEL TERRY

- Credited with his first fumble recovery of his career.

DE DJ WARD

- Registered his first pass breakup of the season.

K/P AUSTIN SEIBERT

- His 11 points give him 327 for his career, moving him past Tim Lashar (321) for fifth in OU history.
 - His two made field goals tie Scott Blanton for eighth in OU history with 41.
 - Has connected on his last 10 field goal attempts.
