First Serve...

The University of Oklahoma volleyball closes its 2017 season against TCU on Saturday, November 25. The Sooners' "Senior Day" match begins at 11 a.m. from McCasland Field House. Admission is free.

About the Sooners...

Oklahoma seeks a season sweep of TCU as it enters Saturday with a 7-21 overall record and 4-11 Big 12 mark. Junior outside hitter **Alyssa Enneking** leads the Sooner attack with 4.17 kills and the OU defense with 2.94 digs per set. Second on the attack for Oklahoma is junior outside hitter **Madison Drescher** with 2.92 kills per set. Guiding the offense is junior setter **Audrey Alford** with 9.36 assists to go with 1.98 digs per set. Playing their final match for the Sooners are middle blocker **Leslie Atherton**, defensive specialist **Emma Kelly** and libero **Rachel Manriquez**.

Scouting the Horned Frogs...

TCU came into the week at 11-16 overall and 3-12 in the Big 12. Four Horned Frogs averaged better than 2.50 kills per set with **Allie Beth Deaton** leading the way with 3.00. **Anna Walsh** is third at 2.83 on a team-best .307 hitting percentage. Setter **Lamprini Konstantinidou** gets the bulk of the sets in TCU's 6-2 offense, while averaging 6.20 assists per set to **Kaylee Smith's** 4.72.

On the Air...

Video of Saturday's match will be streamed on [SoonerSports.tv](#). Veteran OU broadcaster **Chris Plank** (play-by-play) and **Jen Robinson** (color commentary) will have the call.

Last Time They Met...

Oklahoma picked up a 3-0 sweep at TCU on October 18. The win marked the fourth sweep of the year for the Sooners and its first true road win since sweeping Texas Tech (Oct. 12, 2016). The Sooners won in straight sets by scores of 25-18, 25-16 and 25-21. OU came out strong and never looked back. **Alyssa Enneking** powered the Sooner attack with six kills on a .455 hitting percentage in the first set and finished the night with 11. **Audrey Alford** distributed the ball to four hitters that recorded three or more kills in the first set alone as OU hit a collective .394. She finished the match with 35 assists, while **Madison Drescher** and **Morgan Miller** matched Enneking with 11 kills.

All-Time vs. TCU...

Oklahoma leads the all-time series, 12-4. The Sooners have won the last five meetings in Norman against the Horned Frogs and from 2005-2014 OU won nine straight matches. Oklahoma leads the series, 8-3, since TCU joined the Big 12 in 2012. The two sides have split the season series in each of the three years as OU looks for the first season sweep in the series since claiming both matches back in 2013.

By The Numbers: OU vs. TCU...

Audrey Alford has made four starts and come off the bench once against the Horned Frogs. She has averaged 9.11 assists per set with a series best 43 assists in a five-set loss in Fort Worth last season. She has recorded two double-doubles; both in 2016. **Alyssa Enneking** is a .250 hitter against TCU, while averaging 3.00 kills and digs per set. She has recorded a double-double in each of the last two match-ups. **Madison Drescher** has started twice against TCU, including one start at middle blocker. She has averaged 2.33 kills per set by reaching double figures in three of five matches.

Five-Set Streak Snapped...

Oklahoma's 3-2, five-set win over West Virginia (Nov. 4) snapped a seven-match losing streak for the Sooners in five-set contests. OU last won in five against Mississippi State (Sept. 3, 2016) at the UALR Tournament. Since 2015, the Sooners are just 3-13 in five-set matches and last won more than one five-set match in a season in 2014 with a 3-6 record.

Enneking Climbs the Kill Chart...

Alyssa Enneking enters Wednesday with 430 kills on the season. She currently ranks fourth in kills in a single season during the 25-point, rally-scoring era (2008-pres.). Since 2001, Enneking's 416 kills this season are the eighth most by a Sooner. **Kierra Holst** holds the Sooner record for kills in a single season during the current era with 450 in 2014. Enneking's 18-kill effort against Kansas State (Nov. 18) moved her from fifth to fourth past **Suzy Boulavsky's** 407 kills in 2011. She is now chasing **Sallie McLaurin's** 438 kills in 2013 for third.

Three Ranked Opponents in a Row...

A match-up vs. No. 24 Baylor (Oct. 28) marked the third consecutive match against a ranked opponent for Oklahoma. This season marks the second year in a row that Oklahoma has faced three ranked opponents in a row. In 2016, the Sooners played No. 5 Washington, No. 8 Kansas and No. 4 Texas in back-to-back-to-back matches over a span of 11 days. In **Santiago Restrepo's** tenure, OU has faced three ranked opponents in a row on six occasions, including a five-match stretch in 2009, which was shortly followed by a three-match stretch.

Swinging Hard...

Over the last 11 matches, **Madison Drescher** is averaging 3.20 kills per set; reaching double figures in eight of 12. She began that stretch with a 13-kill effort by hitting .312 in a sweep of Texas Tech (Oct. 4). Against No. 3 Texas (Oct. 22), Drescher began the match with 10 kills on her first 10 swings and finished the day with 17 kills. She added 17 kills on a .316 hitting percentage against No. 11 Kansas (Oct. 25).

Big 12 Hitting Duos...

Junior outside hitters **Alyssa Enneking** and **Madison Drescher** are the second ranked duo of attackers in Big 12 matches this season. They make up one of three pairs of teammates in the league that rank in the Top-10 in kills per set in conference-only matches. Enneking, whose 243 kills lead the Big 12, ranks first in the league with 4.26 and Drescher is ninth at 3.28 kills per set to combine for a 7.54 average. Baylor's **Yossiana Pressley** (2nd, 4.25) and **Katie Staiger** (7th, 3.54) are the top ranked hitting duo as Pressley climbs the ranks with the bulk of the swings with Staiger injured.

Milestone Tracker...

Setter **Audrey Alford** recorded the 2,000th assist of her Sooner career against Kansas State (Sept. 20). She moved into ninth all-time at OU against Maryland (Sept. 15) as she recorded the 1,910th of her career to pass **Jessica Barney** (2001-02). Alford, who reached the 2,000-assist mark in her 61st match and now has 2,514 in her career, is now chasing **Julie Chester** (2004-07), who dished out 2,794 career assists, for eighth all-time at Oklahoma.

Vs. The Ranked...

The Sooners have dropped 23-consecutive matches to ranked opponents, including a 0-14 mark against Top-10 opponents. Under head coach **Santiago Restrepo**, Oklahoma owns a 21-94 (.183) record against ranked teams. Over a stretch of six NCAA Tournament seasons from 2009-14, the Sooners went 15-34 (.306) vs. ranked teams. After a 0-19 record in his first two seasons at Oklahoma, Restrepo and the Sooners are 21-71 (.228) against teams in the Top-25. OU's last win over a ranked opponent was at No. 2 Texas (Oct. 25, 2014).

Libero Tracker...

Freshman **Kira Morikawa** earned the bulk of the starts at libero with 13 early in her rookie campaign. As a starter she is averaging 3.37 digs per set. Redshirt-junior **Rachel Manriquez** has been called on to start the remaining 15 matches to push her career total to 57 starts at libero. In her career, Manriquez has averaged 3.39 digs per set and started 13 matches in 2015 and all 29 matches in 2016.

Double-Doubles...

The Sooners returned half of their 28 double-doubles from the 2016 season and matched that total in 2017 with two double-doubles in a three-set match vs. Iowa State (Nov. 15). **Audrey Alford** and **Alyssa Enneking** each collected seven double-doubles a year ago. Alford picked up her first of 2017 with a 23-assist, 11-dig effort in the first match of the season. Enneking leads the team with a career-best 16 so far in 2017. Enneking recorded the 20th double-double of her career in a five-set match at No. 11 Kansas (Oct. 25) with 22 kills and 16 digs. Alford and **Morgan Miller**, who has added a triple-double, have recorded seven and five double-doubles through 25 matches, respectively.

Sooner Youth Movement...

Oklahoma has regularly started three freshmen this season, including middle blocker **Paige Anderson**, who has started all 27 matches. **Kira Morikawa** has earned 13 starts at libero and outside hitter-turned-middle blocker **Sarah Maras** has started 11 of the Sooners' matches. Oklahoma last used three starters in its lineup early in the 2012 season with **Julia Doyle**, **Kierra Holst** and **Madison Ward** in the lineup. That OU trio combined to start 62 matches, including 33 by Doyle, 24 by Holst and five by Ward, who suffered a season-ending injury. The 2017 Sooner freshmen have combined for 51 starts. OU freshmen did not make a single start in 2016 and **Audrey Alford** was the only freshman in the lineup in 2015 as she started the final 11 matches of the season.

All-Tournament, All The Time...

Against No. 18 USC (Sept. 15), **Alyssa Enneking** recorded the 500th kill of her career on her way to earning All-Tournament honors at the Maryland Challenge. It marked the fourth All-Tournament award in as many weeks for Enneking as she added to her accolades from the NIKE Invitational, Bobcat Invitational and All-state Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic. Enneking previously earned the first All-Tournament honor of her career at the 2016 Pac-12 Challenge, hosted by USC.

New Kids on the Block...

OU has had an All-American middle blocker every year since 2011 in **Sallie McLaurin** (2011, '12, '13) and **Marion Hazelwood** (2014, '15, '16). Hazelwood, an early enrollee in the spring of 2014, graduated in just seven semesters and transferred to finish her collegiate career at Washington. The Sooners also move on without four-year starter **Micaela Spann**, who graduated after earning All-Big 12 Second Team in 2016. As a team, Oklahoma returned just four starts at middle blocker for 2017, including two by **Leslie Atherton** and two by outside hitter **Madison Drescher** in 2016. **Paige Anderson** has started at middle blocker as a freshman in all 27 matches and averaging 0.80 blocks per set. Fellow freshman **Sarah Maras** moved from outside to middle early in the season and is averaging 0.76 blocks per set.

Big 12 Openers...

OU opened conference play with a 3-2 loss to Kansas State (Sept. 20). The Sooners are now 10-12 in Big 12 openers dating back to the league's inaugural season in 1996. OU's 2015 loss at Texas Tech snapped a stretch of nine conference-opening wins. Under Restrepo, the Sooners are 9-5 in the first Big 12 match of the season. In home Big 12 openers, OU is 11-9; having won seven in a row until this season.

Restrepo, Files, Southern Miss Reunion...

When the Sooners took the floor against Southern Miss (Sept. 9) it marked the first time for OU head coach **Santiago Restrepo** and assistant coach **Kelly Files** against their former team. Restrepo was the Golden Eagles' head coach from 2001-03, while Files played four years at USM from 1998-01. Oklahoma earned the win in four sets in the first-ever match-up.

PLEDGE FOR A CURE The Oklahoma volleyball team continues the mission to honor the son of its head coach, Santiago Restrepo. When he was just one-and-a-half years old, Javier Restrepo was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL). In August 2008, he had a relapse and received a bone marrow transplant and then received a liver transplant but unfortunately relapsed again. Javi fought the disease like a true champion, nearly beating it on multiple occasions before it ultimately claimed his life on July 31, 2009.
