# OKLAHOMA BASKETBALL

**JAN. 10, 2018 • OKLAHOMA 73, TEXAS TECH 52 • POSTGAME NOTES**

## TEAM NOTES

- Senior center Vionise Pierre-Louis finished with 22 points and eight rebounds as Oklahoma used a strong defensive effort to defeat Texas Tech, 73-52, on Wednesday inside United Supermarkets Arena. The Sooners improved to 8-8 and 3-2 in Big 12 play, while Texas Tech fell to 6-10 and 0-5 against league competition.
- The Sooners improved to 35-22 all-time against Texas Tech. OU has won 14 straight meetings and 25 out of the last 26 games versus the Lady Raiders. OU's 14-game winning streak over Texas Tech is its longest active streak against a Division I opponent. OU has won seven straight games on the road at Texas Tech and is 15-13 all-time in the series in Lubbock.
- Oklahoma has had 15 different 20-point scoring performances from five different players through 16 games this season. During the 2016-17 season, the Sooners had just 15 20-point scoring performances in 33 games
- OU forced Texas Tech into a season-high 27 turnovers as the Sooners recorded a season-best 15 steals in the win. Maddie Manning led OU with a season-best eight steals, while Gabbi Ortiz recorded three.
- Pierre-Louis picked up her third 20-point scoring performance of the season and the seven of her career, finishing with 22 points on 10-of-13 shooting from the field and 2-of-3 shooting at the foul line. OU is 6-2 when Pierre-Louis finishes with 20-plus points during her career.
- Ana Llanusa finished in double figures for the 10th time this season, chipping in 12 points and four rebound in 26 minutes.
- Manning finished with a near triple-double, recording nine points, 10 rebounds and eight steals. Manning's eight steals are tied for the 10th-most in a single game in program history, while her 10 rebounds set a season high.
- Manning joins LaNeshia Caufield and Pam Pennon as the only players to have eight or more steals in multiple games during their OU career. The Ankeny, Iowa, native's career high in steals came against Portland State (10) on Dec. 21, 2016.
- Ortiz became the 35th player in OU history to reach the 1,000-point mark during Wednesday's game, knocking down two free throws in the second quarter to accomplish the feat. Ortiz also finished with a season-high five assists.
- Ten players have reached the 1,000-point mark for their OU careers in the last six seasons. Those players are: Whitney Hand (2012-13), Aaryn Ellenberg (2013-14), Morgan Hook (2013-14), Nicole Griffin (2013-14) and Sharane Campbell-Olds (2014-15), Kaylon Williams (2015-16), Peyton Little (2016-17), Maddie Manning (2017-18), Gabbi Ortiz (2017-18) and Vionise Pierre-Louis (2017-18).
- Mandy Simpson set a career high with four made field goals and scored eight points -- all in the first half.
- Texas Tech's .182 3-point shooting percentage and .480 free throw percentage marked opponent lows against the Sooners.
- OU has won six straight games and is 7-1 this season when leading at halftime.
- Oklahoma head coach Sherri Coale is 473-235 in her 22 seasons at Oklahoma. Coale is 228-125 all-time against Big 12 competition.
- Up next, the Sooners host No. 5 Baylor on Sunday at 1 p.m. CT on Fox Sports 1. OU is 26-25 all-time against the Lady Bears.
