OU POSTGAME NOTES

GENERAL NOTES

- Oklahoma won its 19th consecutive true road game, the longest active streak in the country.
- The Sooners improved to 27-3 overall as the No. 7 team in the AP poll.
- Redshirt sophomore S Jordan Parker made his first start of the season.
- This was Oklahoma's fifth game this season with at least 50 points. OU leads the nation since 2015 with 20 games in which it has scored 50 or more points.
- The Sooners tied the school record with a 99-yard drive (seven plays, 3:31 time of possession) to take a 28-24 lead in the second quarter.
- OU had a 100-yard rusher (Trey Sermon, career-high 206 yards) and a 100-yard receiver (Lee Morris, career-high 101 yards) for the third time this season.
- The Sooners had two 100-yard rushers (Sermon and QB Kyler Murray [100]) for the first time this season.
- Oklahoma totaled 683 offensive yards (360 passing, 323 rushing), compiling at least 650 yards for the third time this season (650 vs. FAU in season opener and 702 vs. Kansas State last week).
- The Sooners tied a season high with 32 first downs (also had 32 last week vs. Kansas State).
- Oklahoma scored at least 20 points in the first half for the 20th time in the last 23 games. OU has scored at least 28 first-half points in 13 of those contests.
- The Sooners have scored at least 30 points in 31 of their last 33 games, and have won 30 of those 33 contests.
- Oklahoma trailed at halftime (31-28) for just the second time this season (trailed 24-17 against Texas).
- OU has won 30 of its last 32 games against Big 12 opponents.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

QB KYLER MURRAY

- Finished 20 of 35 passing for 360 yards and three touchdowns, and rushed 11 times for an OU-career-high 100 yards (9.1 average) and a touchdown. He accounted for 460 yards of total offense and four touchdowns.
- Became the first player in school history to throw for at least 300 yards and rush for at least 100 yards in a game.
- Set school and Big 12 records with his eighth straight game of at least three touchdown passes. He surpassed the previous record of seven straight games by OU's Sam Bradford in his Heisman Trophy-winning season of 2008, and Texas Tech's Graham Harrell in 2007. Murray's streak is tied for the fifth-longest nationally since 1996.
- Has thrown for at least 300 yards six times this season.
- The first OU QB to pass for at least 350 yards in consecutive games since Landry Jones did so in 2012 (554 vs. West Virginia and 500 vs. Oklahoma State).
- He has accounted for 38 total touchdowns this season (31 passing, seven rushing).
- Has multiple passing touchdowns in each game this season (two vs. Florida Atlantic, three vs. UCLA, three at Iowa State, three vs. Army, six vs. Baylor, four vs. Texas, four at TCU, three vs. Kansas State and three at Texas Tech). He has 20 TD passes over the last five contests.
- Scored his seventh rushing touchdown of the season on a 12-yard run in the second quarter.

S ROBERT BARNES

- Intercepted a Texas Tech two-point conversion attempt and returned it 100 yards for an Oklahoma two-point conversion. The last time OU scored two points off of an opponent's PAT attempt was 2013 against TCU when Zack Sanchez returned a blocked PAT for a two-point conversion.
- Was credited with five tackles and one pass breakup in the game.

FB CARSON MEIER

- Picked up his third receiving touchdown of the season on a 5-yard pass from QB Kyler Murray in the second quarter.
- Finished with two catches for 35 yards and a touchdown.

WR LEE MORRIS

- Recorded a career-high 101 yards and two touchdowns on four receptions (25.3 average).
- Scored touchdowns on receptions of 16 and 46 yards. It was his third multiple-touchdown game this season.
- Now has 10 touchdowns on 18 career receptions, and eight TDs on 16 receptions this season.

LB KENNETH MURRAY

- Led the Sooners with 11 tackles (seven solo, four assists), his sixth game this season with double-digit tackles.
- Recorded 1.5 tackles for loss, raising his season total to 10.

DE RONNIE PERKINS

- Recorded a career-high five tackles (three solo, two assists) and 1.5 tackles for loss. He now has 5.5 TFLs this season.

K AUSTIN SEIBERT

- Set an NCAA record for career extra-point makes (281) and extra-point attempts (285), breaking the previous marks of 274 makes and 278 attempts held by Baylor's Aaron Jones (2010-13).
- Has made a school-record 149 consecutive extra-point attempts, connecting on seven in today's game.
- Scored seven points in the game to raise his career scoring total to 446 points. He moved into eighth place in NCAA career scoring among kickers, and sits in fourth place on the all-time Big 12 scoring list.

RB TREY SERMON

- Recorded career highs of 206 yards and three touchdowns on a career-high 26 carries (7.9 average).
 - Became OU's first 200-yard rusher this season, and first since Rodney Anderson ran for 201 yards against Georgia in the 2018 Rose Bowl. It was the most rushing yards by a Sooner since 2016 when Samaje Perine ran for 239 yards against Oklahoma State (12/3/16).
 - Notched his third 100-yard rushing game of the season and fourth of his career.
 - Scored at least two rushing touchdowns for the second time this season and third time in his career.
